Each team takes it in turn to mount an attack.. One player from each team must stay in the end zone. This player stands in the attacking end zone. The aim of the game is to make a pass into the target man and then receive a lay off pass in order to shoot at goal. The team in possession must find make a pass to the player in the end zone. The attacking team must then run into the end zone to receive a return pass. The team in possession must figure out a way to get the ball into the end zone. A white player is faced with a 1 v 1 against the sweeper. The game is played for a set time 3. The sweeper makes the tackle.
