I simply typed up on my computer what I wanted the label to say and printed it off All traced and ready for stitching! Trimmed off the excess interfacing And cut the "X" for turning behind the pumpkin where there would not be any embroidery. I used all 6 strands of my Aurifloss and a backstitch.
