In order to do this, our life must be like that of Simeon. We must wait for the consolation of Israel. We must look for his coming. Then death to us, like death to Simeon, will have no terror; we shall depart in peace, and in heaven see the salvation of God, 2 Peter 3: Children, as well as the hoary-headed Simeon, may look for the coming of Christ. By Moses and the prophets, a light of revelation was given to the Jews, in the blessedness of which the Gentiles did not partake. By Christ and his apostles, a luminous revelation is about to be given unto the Gentiles, from the blessedness of which the Jews in general, by their obstinacy and unbelief, shall be long excluded. But to all true Israelites it shall be a glory, an evident fulfillment of all the predictions of the prophets, relative to the salvation of a lost world; and the first offers of it shall be made to the Jewish people, who may see in it the truth of their own Scriptures indisputably evinced.

A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. The world is in great spiritual darkness. Impenitent sinners are universally ignorant of the true God. Many of them may have a correct theory in some respects. But after all they know not God. To know God and Jesus Christ, is to have eternal life. And while in their sins, they have no correct apprehension of the true God. They are in great darkness in respect to the spirituality of his law. If they understood the spirituality of his law, they would understand something of his character and of their own. What, they say, law is law. And why should you mystify and speak of its spirituality as if it had some occult meaning which none but the initiated can understand? To this I reply: That to be sure, law is law. That every law has its letter and its spirit: Now the world are in total darkness in respect to the true meaning of the law of God. The first commandment is, "Thou shalt have no other gods before me. And so has every commandment of God. Its letter prohibits all idolatrous worship. Its spirit requires supreme, disinterested, universal, perpetual love to God, with every holy affection carried out in every holy action. As a farther illustration, take the commandment, "Thou shalt not steal. But the spirit of this commandment forbids all covetousness and requires us to love our neighbor as ourselves. It prohibits every form of fraud, speculation, and taking any advantage in business, that is inconsistent with the royal rule, "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. Sinners are ignorant of themselves. They know very little of their own constitution, and in most cases still less of their character. This ignorance of their own character is a natural consequence of their ignorance of the law of God. Being ignorant of the true intent and meaning of the standard with which they are to compare themselves, they are of course utterly mistaken in regard to their true character. Judging of themselves only in the light of the letter, and overlooking the breadth of the spirit of the law, they of course form an estimate of their character altogether different from the true one. Sinners are altogether ignorant of their true desert. Being ignorant of the spirituality of the law, they know not either the number or the exceeding demerit of their sins. Sinners know not their own helplessness, nor do they understand the remedy which God has provided for healing their souls. They neither care for, nor know but little about the remedy, because they are ignorant of their disease. Sinners are ignorant of what is really good for them, and what will in the highest manner promote their own well being, both in time and eternity. Consequently they are pursuing exactly the course, that must eventually and necessarily result in their everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and the glory of his power. Christians, under God, are to enlighten the world. Because they have the true light. They understand the spirituality of his law. They know the character of man. They know his guilt, desert, helplessness, and necessities. They have seen their own ignorance, and know that the world is in darkness and lieth in wickedness. They have the most certain knowledge of this, and the best of all knowledge, that of their own experience. They also know the remedy for sinners. They have been enlightened by the true light. True christians have all been taught of God. They know God and Jesus Christ, whom to know is life eternal. They are conscious of so knowing him as to have eternal life abiding in them. They can truly say, from their own consciousness, "Where as I was blind, now I see. It is in vain for unconverted philosophers or statesmen, or any unconverted persons whatever to talk of enlightening the world. The light that is in them is great darkness. And when they talk of enlightening the world, they know not what they say, nor whereof they affirm. They speak at random, and deceive their followers. They are blind leaders of the blind, and they all stumble on together upon the dark mountains, till teachers and disciples fall into the pit of destruction together. The world must be enlightened through human instrumentality. Constituted as men are, truth must address them through the medium of the senses. Consequently God found it necessary to unite Himself with human nature in order to enlighten men. Taking to Himself human nature, He lived, and conversed, and ate, and drank, and held conversation with men through the medium of his human nature. And

this possessed their minds of the true idea of who and what He is. He exhibited in his own life, and in all his deportment, the spirit of his own law. By his teachings, but more especially by his life, He called the attention of men away from the letter to the spirit of his law, and when He gave them precepts, He gave them illustrations of their meaning in his own example, and thus possessed their minds of the nature of true religion, and what it was to love their neighbor as themselves. None have had the true light but those who have received it through the instrumentality of the saints of God. Sometimes He has had but few representatives on earth. And gross darkness has covered the whole face of the earth, except here and there a little spot has been lighted up, by some pulpit and saint of God. Noah was a light to the old world in its worst estate. Daniel was a light in the idolatrous court of Nebuchadnezzar. Prophets and holy men have been scattered up and down in the earth enough to preserve the true knowledge of God, to a greater or less extent, through these representatives. The Lord Jesus Christ, first in his forerunner John, next in his own person, afterwards in his apostles, and now in all his saints, is enlightening the world. His people are now the medium through which He discovers Himself to mankind. His spirit dwells in them "working in them to will and to do of his good pleasure. How Christians can enlighten the world. It is not simply his creed. Not simply his profession. Nor is it his profession and creed together. Not his sanctimonious appearance on the Sabbath. Nor his sitting at the communion table. Nor does his light consist in all these together. His light consists in his temper and spirit. In his good works in a most strict regard to the universal law of love. By conforming to whatever is wrong in their tempers, views or practices--not by any direct or indirect connivance at their sins, worldly mindedness, or whatever is the result of their darkness. Not by any compromise of principle or by conciliating their favor, by keeping out of view the points of difference between themselves and sinners. Some professors of religion seem disposed to avoid all controversy with impenitent men, to lessen as far as possible the differences of opinion, and views, and practices between themselves and sinners. Now this is as far as possible from the true philosophy of enlightening the world. It is as if you attempted to clear the eye-sight of your neighbor by putting out your own eyes. If you wish to convince a man that he is in the dark, you must hold up your own light, in contrast with his darkness. If he can see your light, it will discover his own darkness. Christians can never enlighten the world by any thing that will imply that they lay but little practical stress upon the points of difference between them and sinners. It is in vain to attempt to enlighten the world by any course of conduct that is calculated to make the impression that the real difference between saints and sinners lies merely or mostly in opinion, if after all the practices of Christians are such as demonstrate that their opinions have very little to do with practice. Christians can enlighten the world by holding up the light of their own example on all subjects in strong and constant contrast with the example of the ungodly. They can enlighten the world by a patient and firm perseverance in well doing, in spite of all the opposition of earth and hell. To what a wonderful extent did the Apostles and primitive Christians succeed in enlightening the world. This was a thing of course. Their lives were a perpetual light, dissipating the moral darkness around them. They did not hold forth a flickering, waving, and uncertain light. It was clear, steady, pure, and had well nigh banished darkness from the earth.

3: CHRISTIANS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

God is light, says Saint John, and in him there is no darkness at al. These passages from the works of early Cistercian monks and nuns reflect on the mystery of that divine light.

James Smith, "A light to enlighten the Gentiles. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, and God gave them up. Then they went on in darkness, until at length they sat down in darkness, and in the shadow of death. That was their condition for ages. It was called "the times of their ignorance. They personified lust" and worshiped it. They imprisoned truth" and lost it. Ignorance, guilt, misery, and cruelty, were the representatives of their condition. They were without hope, and without God in the world. Being godless" they were hopeless; being hopeless" they were miserable; being miserable" they were cruel. They have become filled with every kind of wickedness, evil, greed and depravity. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit and malice. They are gossips, slanderers, God-haters, insolent, arrogant and boastful; they invent ways of doing evil; they disobey their parents; they are senseless, faithless, heartless, ruthless. God looked down from heaven men, to see if there were any who sought after God; but they were all gone out of the way; they were together become abominable; there were none that did good"no, not one! First, he separated the Jews for himself, as his chosen and privileged people. He redeemed them from Egypt, led them through the wilderness, and settled them in the land of Canaan. He adopted them as his children; placed the Shechinah, his glory-cloud, among them; gave them his covenants and his law, the sanctuary and the temple and their services, with his exceeding great and precious promises. One of these promises was, that of a Savior, a Divine Savior. One who should be "a light to enlighten the Gentiles," while he was "the glory of his people Israel. When all was darkness, gross darkness, then the Sun of Righteousness arose, with healing in his wings. Then Jesus came, as "a light to enlighten the Gentiles;" then the Son of God appeared, and his glory was, that he was "full of grace and truth. In his light alone"can we see how God can be just, and yet the justifier of the ungodly. In his light alone"can we discover how the filthy sinner can be made clean, the guilty pronounced righteous, and the degraded be raised to glory, honor, and immortality. This light shines in every direction, it reveals to us heaven with all its glories, hell with all its horrors, time and the design of its trials, eternity and the results of free grace. May the light of truth shine more and more into my heart"to humble me; on the sacred page"to encourage me; in my trying path"to stimulate me; in my heavenly home"to attract me. In the light of Jesus may I see light, and so rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory. Jesus is the true light. Darkness is sin and guilt, light is pardon and peace. In the light of Jesus I see the horrid nature of sin"and abhor it; the terrible consequences of guilt"and seek to be delivered from it. Lemon The acidic property of lemon works as a natural bleaching agent for dark skin. The high vitamin C content also encourages new cell growth and is very good for your skin complexion. **Advertisements** Apply lemon juice to your dark inner thigh using a cotton ball. Leave it on for 20 minutes, then rinse it off with cold water. Repeat 2 or 3 times per week. Those who have sensitive skin must dilute the lemon juice with water. Alternatively, combine 1 tablespoon each of lemon juice and glycerin. Add 1 teaspoon of rose water and mix well. Apply this pack on your inner thighs before going to bed. Oatmeal To lighten the complexion of your dark thighs, regular exfoliation of dead skin cells is necessary. For exfoliation, oatmeal is one of the best ingredients you can use at home. Exfoliating also leaves the skin supple and soft. **Advertisements** Mix 2 tablespoons of oatmeal with enough tomato juice to make a thick paste. Apply this paste on the thighs, allow it to sit for 20 minutes and then rub it gently using a little water to scrub off the dead skin. Finally, rinse it off with cold water. Repeat once or twice daily. Alternatively, mix equal amounts of cucumber juice and lemon juice. Stir in a little turmeric and sandalwood powder. Apply it on your thighs for 20 minutes, then rinse it off with lukewarm water.

Coconut Oil Coconut oil also helps lighten hyperpigmentation and revitalizes the skin. Plus, its antioxidant and moisturizing properties helps you maintain soft and younger-looking skin. Mix 3 tablespoons of coconut oil and 1 tablespoon of lemon juice. Apply this solution on your inner thighs and massage gently for 10 to 15 minutes. Wait another 5 minutes, then rinse it off with warm water. Use this treatment every other day.

Turmeric **Advertisements** Turmeric inhibits melanin production, so you can use it to treat skin discoloration and maintain an even skin tone. Mix a little turmeric powder with 1 teaspoon of milk cream. Rub it gently on your inner thighs. Allow it to dry before rinsing it off with lukewarm water. Use

this remedy once daily. Alternatively, mix 1 to 2 teaspoons of turmeric powder with enough orange juice to make a paste. Apply it on your dark inner thighs and leave it on for 15 to 20 minutes. Use warm water to remove the paste. Baking Soda Baking soda can also improve the dark complexion of your inner thighs. It works as an exfoliating agent to remove sun-damaged skin cells that have darkened. Mix 1 tablespoon each of baking soda and milk or water to make a paste. Add a little honey and mix well. Rinse it off with lukewarm water. Repeat every other day. Almonds The vitamin E in almonds helps brighten your skin tone. You can use both almonds and almond oil to maintain an even tone and keep your skin healthy. Prepare a paste with 1 to 2 tablespoons of coarsely powdered almonds and 1 tablespoon each of milk powder and honey. Apply it on the darkened thighs. Allow it to dry, then rub off the paste with wet fingers using circular motions. Rinse your skin with cold water. Do this 2 to 4 times a week. Alternatively, soak a few almonds in water overnight. The next morning, grind the almonds into a paste. Add a little honey to the paste and apply it on your thighs. Wait 10 to 15 minutes, then gently scrub off the paste using wet hands. Rinse your thighs with cold water. Do this once or twice a week. Also, massage your thighs with warm almond oil for about 5 minutes daily before going to bed. Orange Peels Orange peels contain vitamin C that works as a natural bleaching agent. They also contain exfoliating properties that help get rid of dead or damaged skin cells. Put 1 cup of orange peels in the sun for a few days to dry out. Grind the dried peels into a powder. Put 2 teaspoons of the powder in a bowl and add enough rose water to make a thick paste. Mix in some honey. Apply this paste on your inner thighs and wait 15 to 20 minutes. Gently scrub off the paste with your wet hands, then rinse the area with cold water. Repeat 2 or 3 times a week. Use a chemical-free soap and soft sponge to wash your thighs. Avoid wearing rough jeans that can irritate the skin when the material rubs against your thighs. Wear comfortable clothes made from breathable materials to prevent skin irritation.

Western understanding[edit] In the Western world the concept of enlightenment in a religious context acquired a romantic meaning. It has become synonymous with self-realization and the true self , which is being regarded as a substantial essence which is covered over by social conditioning. As a matter of fact there are more resemblances with Romanticism than with the Enlightenment: Historical period of renewed interest in religion[edit] The equivalent term "awakening" has also been used in a Christian context, [3] namely the Great Awakenings , several periods of religious revival in American religious history. Historians and theologians identify three or four waves of increased religious enthusiasm occurring between the early 18th century and the late 19th century. Each of these "Great Awakenings" was characterized by widespread revivals led by evangelical Protestant ministers, a sharp increase of interest in religion, a profound sense of conviction and redemption on the part of those affected, an increase in evangelical church membership, and the formation of new religious movements and denominations. Divine illumination Another equivalent term is Illuminism , which was also used by Paul Demieville in his work The Mirror of the Mind, in which he made a distinction between "illumination subie" and "illumination graduelle". It is the oldest and most influential alternative to naturalism in the theory of mind and epistemology. Augustine was an important proponent of Illuminism, stating that everything we know is taught to us by God as He casts His light over the world, [web 3] saying that "The mind needs to be enlightened by light from outside itself, so that it can participate in truth, because it is not itself the nature of truth. Romanticism and transcendentalism[edit] See also: Buddhist modernism , Transcendentalism , and Perennial philosophy This romantic idea of enlightenment as insight into a timeless, transcendent reality has been popularized especially by D. Religious experience A common reference in Western culture is the notion of "enlightenment experience". This notion can be traced back to William James , who used the term "religious experience" in his book, The Varieties of Religious Experience. The notion of "religious experience" was used by Schleiermacher to defend religion against the growing scientific and secular critique. It is fundamentally a variety of diverse sources such as Hindu texts like the Vedas , the Upanishads and the Bhagavad Gita , [17] various religions, and German idealism. Enlightenment in Buddhism The English term "enlightenment" has commonly been used to translate several Sanskrit, Pali, [web 10] Chinese and Japanese terms and concepts, especially bodhi , prajna , kensho , satori and buddhahood. Bodhi is a Theravada term. It literally means "awakening" and "understanding". Someone who is awakened has gained insight into the workings of the mind which keeps us imprisoned in craving, suffering and rebirth , [web 1] and has also gained insight into the way that leads to nirvana , the liberation of oneself from this imprisonment. Prajna is a Mahayana term. It refers to insight into our true nature, which according to Madhyamaka is empty of a personal essence in the stream of experience. According to the Tibetan Thubten Yeshe , [web 11] enlightenment full awakening; buddhahood. It is a state characterized by infinite compassion, wisdom and skill. Advaita literally, non-duality is a system of thought where "Advaita" refers to the identity of the Self Atman and the Whole Brahman. Attaining this liberation takes a long preparation and training under the guidance of a guru. Philosophical system[edit] Shankara systematized the works of preceding philosophers. This style was adopted by all the later Vedanta schools.
