Backed by a band full of talent, Tasjan uses his body as an additional instrument, and his live performing presence is something to behold. Mike Harris on lead guitar comes out of nowhere with shocking riffs that leave everyone wanting to know his name. Cobb and his band are the kinds of live musicians that can sell a pop fan on country music for a lifetime. They are sweet enough to give you a cavity, yet hard enough to cut your teeth on. With her throwback voice and bold presence, Price brings a hipster band full of modern talent. Though she has a tough girl, edgy attitude, her live singing voice is clean, making for an interesting combination against her distorted rock instrumentals. She is a non-conforming, leader who pushes her music forward in her own way. When Jamey Johnson takes the stage, some people in the crowd are already chanting his name. There are those who have camped out all afternoon to be close to the stage for Willie Nelson and are hearing Johnson for the first time tonight. Completely elated, the crowd begins to close in tighter, anticipating Nelson. We are informed that he will be shooting a scene from his self-directed movie, which also stars himself. The idea of watching an A-list actor lip sing in between two of the most profound country acts of our time leaves us with the same feeling we have about thunderstorms; sometimes they can be cool and sexy, but when they happen in the middle of a great World Series game, its best to go get a hot dog and wait it out. Some people seemed excited to be an extra in a crowd shot on their own dime, but others chose the hot dog. When Nelson finally appears, his voice is as pure as ever. Neil Young even joins him for an incredible harmonica solo. The Palomino is overflowing from every side with fans trying to get a peek at history in the making. While the stand-up bass by Charles R. Fiddle virtuoso, Nicky Sanders, who has also played with Wide Spread Panic, is a scene-stealer when the Spirit gets ahold of him. These sneaky snakes had the lucky crowd dancing, laughing and playing together until their last note. It was Travis Tritt in his all black get-up, who rode in and robbed Stagecoach. The veteran performer and certified platinum artist knows how to sell country music with hit after hit of superior, generous, stadium-like showmanship. He never stops smiling and that energy is contagious all the way through the crowd. Tritt has filled the Palomino with euphoric, happy people, including some of the other acts that performed that day. Those who came somewhat ambivalent of him, leave his performance Travis Tritt lifers. In three days with over 70 acts to choose from, Stagecoach offers something for all kinds of country music lovers. Description[edit] The stagecoach was a closed four-wheeled vehicle drawn by horses or hard-going mules. It was used as a public conveyance on an established route usually to a regular schedule. Spent horses were replaced with fresh horses at stage stations , posts, or relays. Wells Fargo mud-coach A simplified and lightened form of stagecoach, known as a stage wagon , mud-coach, or mud-wagon, was used in the United States under difficult conditions. In addition to the stage driver or coachman who guided the vehicle, a shotgun messenger armed with a coach gun might travel as a guard beside him. A stagecoach traveled at an average speed of about 5 miles per hour 8. Origins[edit] The first crude depiction of a coach was in an English manuscript from the 13th century. This was followed by a steady proliferation of other routes around the island. The stagecoach would depart every Monday and Thursday and took roughly ten days to make the journey during the summer months. Stagecoaches also became widely adopted for travel in and around London by mid-century and generally travelled at a few miles per hour. By the end of the 17th century stagecoach routes ran up and down the three main roads in England. One pamphleteer denounced the stagecoach as a "great evil [Reforms of the turnpike trusts , new methods of road building and the improved construction of coaches led to a sustained rise in the comfort and speed of the average journey - from an average journey length of 2 days for the Cambridge -London route in to a length of under 7 hours in It was advertised with the following announcement - "However incredible it may appear, this coach will actually barring accidents arrive in London in four days and a half after leaving Manchester. This coach took an unprecedented three days to reach London with an average speed of eight miles per hour. The postal delivery service in Britain had existed in the same form for about yearsâ€”from its introduction in , mounted carriers had ridden between "posts" where the postmaster would remove the letters for the local area before handing the remaining letters and any additions to the next rider. The riders were frequent targets for robbers, and the system was inefficient. It occurred to him that this stagecoach service could be developed into a national mail delivery service, so in he suggested to the Post Office in London that they take up the idea. He met resistance from officials who believed that the existing system could not be improved, but eventually the Chancellor of the Exchequer , William Pitt , allowed him to carry out an experimental run between Bristol and London. Under the old system the journey had taken up to 38 hours. Within the month the service had been extended from London to Norwich , Nottingham , Liverpool and Manchester , and by the end of services to the following major towns and cities of England and Wales had also been linked: A service to Edinburgh was added the next year, and Palmer was rewarded by being made Surveyor and Comptroller General of the Post Office. His coach had a greatly improved turning capacity and braking system , and a novel feature that prevented the wheels from falling off while the coach was in motion. Besant, with his partner John Vidler, enjoyed a monopoly on the supply of stagecoaches to the Royal Mail and a virtual monopoly on their upkeep and servicing for the following few decades. His patent lasted 14 years delaying development because Elliott allowed no others to license and use his patent. Elliott mounted each wheel with two durable elliptic steel leaf springs on each side and the body of the carriage was fixed directly to the springs attached to the axles. After the expiry of his patent most British horse carriages were equipped with elliptic springs; wooden springs in the case of light one-horse vehicles to avoid taxation, and steel springs in larger vehicles. These roads allowed stagecoaches to travel at much greater speeds. Steady improvements in road construction were also made at this time, most importantly the widespread implementation of Macadam roads up and down the country. The speed of coaches in this period rose from around 6 miles per hour including stops for provisioning to 8 miles per hour [14] and greatly increased the level of mobility in the country, both for people and for mail. Each route had an average of four coaches operating on it at one time - two for both directions and a further two spares in case of a breakdown en route. Joseph Ballard described the stagecoach industry in This is caused by the strong opposition, as there are eight or ten coaches continually running between those places. Should the

passenger refuse to pay the accustomed tribute he would inevitably be insulted. You must pay also, at the inns, the chambermaid sixpence a night, the "boots" the person who cleans them two pence a day, and the head waiter one shilling a day. The porter who takes your portmanteau up stairs moves his hat with "pray remember the porter, Sir. Three put their shoulders to the back. The beds at the inns are surprisingly neat and clean. In many of the inns in a large town, the chambermaids furnish the chambers and depend upon their fees for remuneration. The stagecoaches are very convenient and easy. No baggage is permitted to be taken inside, it being stowed away in the boot places before and behind the carriage for that purpose. Here it rides perfectly safe, not being liable to be rubbed, as they ride upon the same springs that the passengers do. A person can always calculate upon being at the place he takes the coach for barring accidents at a certain time, as the coachman is allowed a given time to go his stage. The guard always has a chronometer with him locked up so that he cannot move the hands as a guide with regard to time. The first rail delivery between Liverpool and Manchester took place on 11 November. By the early s most London-based coaches had been withdrawn from service. They came to be known as road coaches and were used by their enterprising or nostalgic owners to provide scheduled passenger services where rail had not yet reached and also on certain routes at certain times of the year for the pleasure of an often amateur coachman and his daring passengers. Competitive display and sport[edit] Carriage driving, New coaches often known as Park Drags began to be built to order. Some owners would parade their vehicles and magnificently dressed passengers in fashionable locations. Other owners would take more enthusiastic suitably-dressed passengers and indulge in competitive driving. Very similar in design to stagecoaches their vehicles were lighter and sportier. These owners were often very expert amateur gentlemen-coachmen, occasionally gentlewomen. They only appeared in summer. A dedicated luggage deck is on the roof The diligence dilly for short , a solidly built coach with four or more horses, was the French analogue for public conveyance, especially in France, with minor varieties in Germany such as the Stellwagen and Eilwagen. The diligence from Le Havre to Paris was described by a fastidious English visitor of with a thoroughness that distinguished it from its English contemporary, the stage coach. A more uncouth clumsy machine can scarcely be imagined. In the front is a cabriolet fixed to the body of the coach, for the accommodation of three passengers, who are protected from the rain above, by the projecting roof of the coach, and in front by two heavy curtains of leather, well oiled, and smelling somewhat offensively, fastened to the roof. The inside, which is capacious, and lofty, and will hold six people in great comfort is lined with leather padded, and surrounded with little pockets, in which travellers deposit their bread, snuff, night caps, and pocket handkerchiefs, which generally enjoy each others company, in the same delicate depository. From the roof depends a large net work which is generally crowded with hats, swords, and band boxes, the whole is convenient, and when all parties are seated and arranged, the accommodations are by no means unpleasant. Upon the roof, on the outside, is the imperial, which is generally filled with six or seven persons more, and a heap of luggage, which latter also occupies the basket, and generally presents a pile, half as high again as the coach, which is secured by ropes and chains, tightened by a large iron windlass, which also constitutes another appendage of this moving mass. The body of the carriage rests upon large thongs of leather, fastened to heavy blocks of wood, instead of springs, and the whole is drawn by seven horses.
