Although commonly used anti-inflammatory medications such as aspirin, Motrin or Tylenol, can reduce fever and pain, there are many studies that the long-term use of anti-inflammatory medications actually slows the healing process and can lead to other serious problems. IF there is an inflammatory problem in the body, the doctor should actively search for what is causing the inflammation in the first place and treat that. There is no reason to doubt that anti-inflammatory medications like Ilaris would result in adverse effects. This syndrome was described by Nobert Ortner, an Austrian physician, in 1. Initially it was thought to be due to the enlargement of the left atrium as a result of severe mitral stenosis in rheumatic heart disease. However, it was found, later, to be caused by other conditions rather than rheumatic heart disease 2. The accepted mechanism of this syndrome is the compression of the recurrent laryngeal nerve from the enlargement of the pulmonary artery in the window area between the aorta and ligamentum arteriosum. This condition was quite common at the beginning of last century due to a high incidence of untreated rheumatic heart disease. Although, it is very rare to see it nowadays, it still poses a treatment challenge. A year-old man was admitted to hospital with a history of progressive hoarseness of voice developed over three months. He also experienced progressive shortness of breath, general fatigue and lack of appetites for a three-year period. He had a history of atrial fibrillation and stroke. The first heart sound was muffled while the second heart sound was normal. There was a pan-systolic murmur in the mitral area radiating to the axilla. His chest was dull to percussion on the right base and there were bilateral basal crepitations. Abdominal examination revealed moderate hepatomegaly. Examination by direct laryngoscope showed evidence of left recurrent laryngeal nerve palsy. Basic blood tests were normal. Chest X-ray shows cardiomegaly and bilateral pleural effusion. Pleural fluid analysis was consistent with heart failure. Echocardiogram showed severe enlargement of left and right atriums at 6. Left ventricle was of normal size while both right ventricle and ventricular septum were moderately enlarged. There was moderate-to-severe tricuspid regurgitation and the right ventricular pressure was 55 mm Hg Figs.
