October 17, Subscribers: He was incredibly gifted, dramatic and controversial. His childhood was one of growing up in poverty and plain hard work as was common in those days. His father was known to be a chronic alcoholic, and his mother was said to be living in sin with other men. He was ordained in as an AOG minister and launched out in his life of preaching. Revivalism during those times of depression was tough on an evangelist. In he settled into pastoring a small church in Corpus Christi, Texas and left the field. Two years later Allen attended an Oral Roberts tent meeting in Dallas. That meeting exposed Brother Allen to miracle after miracle and he was convinced that the Spirit of God was moving across the land with displays of great power. It was at this point that Allen started his Healing Revival Campaigns. Asa was desperate to sum up what people were hungering after. He came to a realisation after witnessing the great crowds being drawn to the gigantic tent of Oral Roberts. In Brother Allen made a bold move of faith and purchased a tent for 8, that was way beyond his natural abilities to pay for, although he knew that God was the giver. This was the turning point for this determined man of God. Allen was know as a man that the poor and desperate responded to. Like David of old, who drew those in debt, in distress and discontentment. There was something about his ability to relate to their needs and give them the gospel hope, and they responded to him by the thousands. During his crusades he was known as the revivalist who never ran from the hard cases. More to the point - he thrived on them! If there was someone blind, no problem. Brother Allen would pray. On one occasion, a man came to his meetings who was an ex-mine worker. This man had his eyes blown right out of their sockets in a terrible explosion. When prayed for, God instantly replaced those empty sockets of flesh with brand new brown eyes in front of the people! If there were the lame, no problem. The person was healed. Even the retarded would come with their faces all deformed. Many of the travelling evangelist had their own styles and Brother Allen was no different.

Early life[edit] Asa A. Having been born to a white and an Indian parent, his family was very poor, and his father was an alcoholic. He soon felt the call to preach and affiliated himself with the Assemblies of God , subsequently obtaining ordination from them in He then began to pastor a small church in Colorado. He asked his church board to allow him to start a radio program. Allen soon resigned from his church and began holding healing revival meetings. By the late s, however, music formed an increasingly dominant part of his programs, with that music generally being performed by African-American singer and choir leader Gene Martin. Allen resigned from the Assemblies of God shortly afterward. At his peak, he appeared on fifty-eight radio stations daily, as well as forty-three TV stations. At that time, A. The circulation of "Miracle Magazine," published monthly by the Allen ministry, was , at the time of his death. But when the evangelist got to them and pulled them up out of the wheelchair, some in the audience thought they were walking for the first time or that they had come to the revival in that wheelchair. The far more mainstream revivalist Billy Graham , while not always consistent, had desegregated many of his revivals as early as in Chattanooga, Tennessee , and integrated all his revivals following the Brown v. About the Author: Asa A. Allen (March 27, June 11,), better known as A.A. Allen, was a Pentecostal evangelist and healing minister. He was a major figure in the 's healing revival in North America.

He had a deeply unhappy childhood. His parents were alcoholic, his mother a Cherokee Native American was unfaithful and he grew up in dire poverty. His mother would put him to bed, as a baby, with alcohol in his bottle to keep him quiet. As a young boy AA would make some extra money by singing on the street corners. At the age of 14, feeling desperate to leave the misery of home behind, he ran away. He bummed rides, hopped freight trains, and did odd jobs. Curious he went into the meeting. A woman evangelist was preaching. He went to the meeting again the next night and committed his life to Christ. He began to turn his life around. There was no work where he was so he moved to Colorado to work on a ranch. He met a young woman named Lexie Scriven, and they were married in . He also came into contact with Pentecostalism through a home meeting and became filled with the Spirit. Allen had a desire to preach the gospel that had changed him. He decided to become a minister and affiliated with the relatively new Assembly of God denomination. Allen would chop wood to make money and then travel to small towns to preach the gospel. This was the depression and offerings came in amounts of pennies at a time. In he took a pastorate in Holly, Colorado a small town near the Kansas border. His first child had been born. Allen was officially ordained as an Assembly of God minister during his time there. During this pastorate, Allen fasted and prayed and God met him. He was given a list of thirteen things that would cause him to see the power of God in his ministry. Many of these items focused on total consecration to God and laying down sin. God told him if he did all of these things he would see healings and miracles. He left the pastorate and began to hold meetings as a singing healing evangelist. In Missouri a coal miner who had been blind for several years was healed. Allen held meetings and was constantly on the road. This was a strain for Lexie and their four children. Income was not stable and the responsibility was wearing on her. In Allen accepted a call to pastor a church in Corpus Christi, Texas. He wanted to settle down and have a family life. Allen had a vision for reaching more people. He wanted to start a radio ministry. The church turned him down and he was devastated. He realized, over time, the enemy had taken advantage of his hurt and attacked him. In the healing revival, notably led by William Branham, was making news. He was incredulous at first, but felt stirred to look into what was happening. He went to an Oral Roberts tent revival meeting. He realized as he watched what was happening that this was the ministry God had called him to. He had been unwilling to pay the price to see it, however. He resigned his pastorate, in , and once again began holding evangelistic meetings. People would be healed in their seats as he preached. He also had his first article in the influential "Voice of Healing" magazine put out by Gordon Lindsay. He became a regular contributor to the magazine for the next few years. In he bought his first tent. Allen was pulled over for drunk driving in Knoxville, Tennessee in . Allen always said that someone had put something in his drink at the local restaurant to make him woozy and set him up. Rather than fight it Allen paid the fine so he could continue to his next meeting. The Assembly of God organization asked him to pull out of ministry for a while to clear up the issue. He felt that it was a play on their part to save their reputation. He resigned and continued the ministry. He also resigned from the "Voice of Healing" association. Allen continued as an independent minister. He started his own magazine called "Miracle Magazine", which by the end of had over , subscribers. He began the Miracle Revival Fellowship aimed at ordaining ministers and supporting missions. He came under intense pressure and attack as other healing ministers began to pull back. His style, which was always aggressive, became increasingly flamboyant. As the healing movement became increasingly segmented he began to attack "denominationalism". In , Allen felt called to build a Bible school in Arizona. Someone donated acres of land near Palominos, which he dubbed Miracle Valley. He also began shifting from healing to a prosperity message. In he built a seat church on the land. Still he pressed on with his ministry taking young evangelists with him to train them. Allen died on June 11, after flying to California to redo radio contracts and see a doctor about knee pain. He was using pain killers for the arthritis and there was alcohol in his blood. Paul Cunningham, who also traveled with Allen the last few years of his life steadfastly declared

that suggestions that Allen was an alcoholic are lies and wrote a statement to that fact which he had certified in El Paso County Colorado Springs , Colorado. Names showing up in blue are other people who have biographies on this web site.

Whom God called He qualified and if God called you He put within you the ability to attain to the ministry of your calling. To make it possible for you to have this preparation, I have made available seven Preministerial Courses. Your health, your healing, even your very life may depend upon the manner in which you grasp the instructions given in the lessons of this course. Yet not all people are well and prosperous, any more than all people are righteous. There is a reason. It is the purpose of this course to help you to find and know and understand that reason or reasons as they apply first to your own case, and then to your family, your friends, and to the entire world. From time to time, authenticated testimonies will be given as confirmation of the manner in which God has promised to deal with certain situations, and has kept His promise. You are encouraged to examine the occurrences in your own life and in the lives of those you know well in the light of these amazing scriptural truths. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive anything of the Lord. Do you need healing? Then you are in need of faith. Jesus would say to you, as to the woman who touched the hem of His garment: Do you feel that you DO have faith, and yet the desired healing does not come? Then you need to re-examine your faith, and do something about your faith! This may be paraphrased without changing its meaning: Your faith can only grow and be kept alive as you heed the admonition of I Pet. Real faith is not a matter of simply taking the benefits God offers through believing that they will come, nor even through believing His promises. Real faith is believing everything God says - His commands and His warnings as well as His promises! Or better still, to fulfill his days of service for the Lord in a state of perfect health, and will at the same time acquire a strong and abiding faith in order to be able to bring health and healing to others. Laymen, exhorters and ministers will find the lessons of this course to be an untold blessing. Without this knowledge, you may plead with Him to heal you, and you may hope that He will consent to do it. That is not enough. If He is able but not willing, that will do you no good. That means little to you. But when you know that He is not only able but also willing to heal YOU, then you can pray with absolute assurance. Then we shall show from the Scriptures why, under these circumstances, there are some who are not healed. Be sure that you have been born again. If you are not sure of this, we shall be happy to help you to make sure. Do this before you proceed any further. Fourth, provide yourself with a good Bible, not too large to carry but large enough to be easily read. Select a study Bible with type that can be easily read. Avoid unnecessary notes and helps, which only serve to detract the reader into the pre-cut channels of interpretation. Only the Word of God itself can measure up to that. You cannot have effective faith unless you are ready to believe that God means exactly what He says! Quotations in the lessons will be taken from the King James Version of the Bible. If possible, choose a clear type Bible with only center column or marginal references and possibly a concordance. Many feel that

even these helps are crutches, and that one knows his Bible better who can find his Scriptures without the use of such helps. Fifth, set apart a time for study, as definitely as if you were attending a class, sitting with other pupils and listening to a teacher. Some will prefer to set this study time early in the morning; others may prefer to choose a later hour. Choose the time in which you are least likely to meet with distractions or necessary breaks in your schedule; then stick with it! Sixth, start each class session with prayer. Your Bible and the lesson sheets are your textbooks. Mark portions that you feel are of particular interest to you, and which you feel you particularly desire to study deeply. Re-read the lesson more slowly, making an outline consisting of the leading thoughts and contributing thoughts of each lesson. Such an outline will prove useful now in helping you to organize your thinking and understand thoroughly the subject matter. Later, you may find it an excellent basic sermon outline. You will note that quotations from Scripture are set off by quotation marks, so that you will realize it is Scripture when you make your first hasty reading. But do not be satisfied with merely reading the quotations from the lesson sheet. Keep your open Bible beside you. Find each quotation in the Bible. Read the entire verse and the context. Discover for yourself that there has been no wresting of the meaning of the Scripture. See II Peter 3: Be sure for yourself that the meaning attributed to the quotation in the lesson is the same as that intended by its author. Make this a practice in ALL your study of religious writings. If you will do this, you will not be led astray by false doctrines. Effective faith is faith which has a broad and deep foundation of Scripture hidden away in the heart. Power filled preaching is preaching that comes out of a reservoir of Scripture, well learned, well understood, and firmly believed. Study hard, pray earnestly, and do your best. Purpose in your heart not only to learn the subject matter, but to put into practice EVERY DAY the new truths which you have learned, and to use them not only for your own blessing but to bring blessing to others. Lesson 1 will be a short lesson, since so much time has been spent in introduction and directions for study. But the truths presented in Lesson 1 will be the basic fundamentals upon which the entire course revolves. Start your memorization program with the quotations listed in the introduction. Millions who are sick today could be perfectly well. God laid the plan and purchased healing for them at great cost, and made it available to all His people for the asking. Yet many of these sick people pray a great deal. Many of them have prayed for healing, and have passed through healing lines again and again in some of the most successful healing revivals of our time. They pray much but receive little. Thus, practical experience and observation tell us that there is something more needed. Prayer alone is not enough to bring deliverance. But every petition in the entire prayer is a positive request. Let it be remembered that Christ was not praying to change anything. He had known from the foundation of the world that He must drink this cup. He had chosen before He came into the world to drink it. He was compelled by His love for lost humanity to pass through this bitter agony. Nevertheless, He declared that He could yet have been spared. But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be? You cannot even be assured that God hears your prayer unless you know that you have prayed in His will. So then, all that is necessary in order to receive healing -- or any other petition that we might ask of God -- is to be assured that our prayer has been heard. It is that simple.
