

1: Adding Sounds | Working with Interactive and Multimedia in Adobe InDesign CS6 | Peachpit

Sounds, Narration and Music You can add sound files to your presentations from a variety of sources. For example, you can add sound files you download from the Internet or special sound effects CDs. However, PowerPoint does not recognize all sound file types. PowerPoint also lets you attach sounds to different objects on a slide. However, the objects must be animated before you can attach a sound file to them. See section on animation for more details.

Adding sound from a file If you wish to use a new sound, make sure you download and save the file on your computer, preferably in the same folder with your PowerPoint presentation. In the file list, click the sound file you want, then click OK. PowerPoint may ask you whether you want the sound to play automatically or on mouse-click. If you choose mouse click, you will need to click the icon during the presentation to start it playing. The following steps show you how to record a narration for a slide.

In Normal or Slide View, click on the slide you want to add a recording to. When the Record Sound dialog box appears, type a name for your recording in the Name box. Use the Play, Stop, and Record buttons to record your narration. If you want to change your recording, you need to delete it and start over. Hit the Cancel button from the Record Sound dialog, or select the icon on the slide and hit Delete. The Record Sound dialog box will close, and a speaker icon will appear in the middle of your slide. You can resize this icon or move it to other parts of the slide. However, you can only add the music tracks to slides. The track will not attach to objects, animations, or transitions. If you want to play just the first 30 seconds of the track, type When you are finished, click OK. The CD icon will appear in the middle of your slide. Make sure the CD is in the drive during your presentation.

Adding continuous music to a group of slides Changing to a new musical piece after some number of slides back to top Go to the the slide where you want the sound to begin playing. Say yes when asked if you want the sound to play automatically. The Custom Animation pane will open and your sound file should be listed. Click the arrow directly to the right of the sound icon to pull down the various options. Put in the box so the track will play throughout all your slides, even if you go back and forth among slides. PPT considers each transition a "slide," so you want to put a large number in there. Now check the settings in the Timing tab. To play automatically, the timing should be set to Start After Previous with a 0-second delay. Click OK to close the dialog box.

Type in a name for your audio file, select Record, and then speak. Your device must have a microphone enabled in order to record audio. To review your recording, select Stop and then select Play. To move your clip, select and drag the audio icon to where you want it on the slide. Change playback options Select the audio icon and then select the Audio Tools Playback tab. To trim the audio, select Trim and then use the red and green sliders to trim the audio file accordingly. To fade in or fade out audio, change the number in the Fade Duration boxes. To adjust volume, select Volume and select the setting you prefer. To choose how the audio file starts, select the dropdown arrow and select an option: Plays the audio file automatically with a click. Plays automatically once you advance to the slide that the audio file is on. Plays audio only when the icon is clicked on. To choose how the audio plays in your presentation, select an option: Plays one audio file across all slides. To have the audio play continuously across all slides in the background, select Play in Background. Delete audio To delete an audio clip, select the audio icon on the slide and press Delete. What would you like to do? In Normal view, click the slide that you want to add a sound to. On the Insert tab, in the Media group, click the arrow under Audio. In the list, click Audio from file or Clip Art audio, locate and select the audio clip that you want, and then click Insert. The audio icon and controls appear on the slide. In Normal view or Slide Show view, click the icon and click Play to play the music or other sound. In the list, click Record Sound. The Record Sound dialog box opens. In the Record Sound dialog box, click Record , and begin speaking or playing your own audio. Assign a name to the recording. Click Play to listen to the recording. The audio icon and controls appear on the slide: On the slide, select the audio clip icon. To start the audio clip automatically when you show the slide, in the Start list, click Automatically. To manually start the audio clip when you click it on the slide, in the Start list, click On Click. To play an audio clip as you click through the slides in your presentation, in the Start list, click Play across slides. To play an audio clip continuously until you stop it, select the Loop until Stopped check box. When you loop a sound, it plays continuously until you advance to the next slide.

In Hollywood, everything is magic and make-believe, even sounds. When you watch a film that immerses you completely in its world, you're probably hearing the work of sound artists.

With simple to use video editing programs like Windows Movie Maker and iMovie, just about everyone knows how to create short movie from video clips. I have thousands of videos taken from my digital camera and smartphone and using WMM or iMovie, I can create titles, add sound tracks, put in transitions, overlays, and lots more! Luckily, there are a lot of sites out there that have sounds you can download for free. If you just need sounds for your home movie, the free sites will work just fine. For home or personal use, you can pretty much use any sound on the site. You can search sounds or browse by tags, geotags, or packs. I really like the packs feature because you can find a bunch of similar sounds quickly because they are all grouped into a pack. You can preview the sounds, but have to login in order to download. They have a lot of other sound effects, but you have to pay for those. You do have to login in order to download the original sound file. Unfortunately, the search box on the site produces an error, so you can really only browse via the categories. If you want to use a sound effect that will be for commercial purposes, you can click on royalty-free sounds. This is one of the few websites where you can download the sounds without having to create an account or login. They have a couple of interesting categories like machines, mechanical, and interfaces. On this site, you have to right-click on the link and choose Save Link As in order to download the audio file. Luckily, anyone can download them without needing to register or login. Also, on this site, you have to right-click on the download link and choose Save Link As in order to download the MP3 file. GRSites GRSites has a couple of hundred simple sound effects that you can download for free and without registration. All sounds are free for personal use. If you need any sounds effects for commercial use, you have to purchase the commercial license. SoundJay SoundJay has few hundred sounds that are completely free and can be downloaded without any need to login. The files are good quality also, mostly bit stereo SoundGator SoundGator is another site with a decent number of good quality free sounds. You do have to register and login in order to download the files. The site probably has a couple of hundred sounds. The collections are quite large and the audio quality is superb. Those are 10 sites I have used in my own work that will get your just about any sound you will need. Of course, if you are willing to pay, there are lots of sites with a lot more sound effects of better quality. In this post, I wanted to only focus on the free sites. 5: iMovie for Mac: Add background music and sound clips

Locate the audio file on your computer hard drive and double click the file to import it into the Collections folder in Windows Movie Maker. Confirm that the file is visible in the Collections folder, located above the editing timelines in between the Preview display and the Tasks menu.

You can import video files in Flash Video format. You can import audio files in MP3 format. Media file types such as QuickTime. Keep track of the media files you add to an InDesign document during the production cycle. If you move a linked media clip after adding it to the document, use the Links panel to relink it. If you send the InDesign document to another person, include any media files you add. Click where you want the movie to appear. If you drag to create the media frame, the movie boundary may appear cropped or skewed. When you place a movie or sound file, a media object appears in a frame. This media object links to the media file. You can resize the media object to determine the size of the play area. If the center point of the movie appears outside the page, the movie is not exported. See *Create interactive documents for PDF*. Change movie settings Use the Media panel to change movie settings. Select the movie object in the document. In the Media panel, do any of the following: **Play On Page Load** Play the movie when someone turns to the page on which the movie is located. If other page items are set to play on page load, use the Timing panel to determine the order. **Loop** Play the movie repeatedly. **Poster** Specify the type of image that you want to appear in the play area. If you select **Show Controller On Rollover**, the controls appear when the mouse pointer hovers over the media object. Use the Preview panel to preview the selected controller skin. If the movie file is a legacy file such as MPEG, you can choose **None** or **Show Controller**, which displays a basic controller that lets users pause, start, and stop the movie. SWF files you place may have their own controller skins. Use the Preview panel to test the controller options. **Navigation Points** To create a navigation point, advance the video to a specific frame, and then click the plus sign icon. Navigation points are useful when you want to play a video at a different starting point. When you create a button that plays a video, you can use the **Play From Navigation Point** option to play the video starting at any navigation point you add. Change sound settings Use the Media panel to change sound settings. Select the sound object in the document. **Play On Page Load** Play the sound file when someone turns to the page on which the sound object is located. If the audio file is a non-MP3 file, this option is dimmed. **Loop** Play the MP3 sound repeatedly. If the source file is a non-MP3 file, this option is dimmed. **Poster options** A poster is the image that represents a media clip. Each movie or sound can appear with or without a poster. Specify any of the following types of poster images in the Media panel: **None** Shows no poster for the movie or sound clip. This option is useful if you want the movie or sound clip to not be visible on the page. For example, you may want the media to be played only when you turn the page, or you may want a more complex design beneath the movie to show instead of the poster. To use a different standard poster, save an image as **StandardMoviePoster**. **From Current Frame** Select this option to use the current frame displayed in the preview area of the Media panel. To select a different frame, advanced the preview slider and click the icon to the right of the Poster menu. **Choose Image** Lets you select an image to use as the poster. Double-click the image you want to use. You can select bitmap graphics, not vector graphics, for posters. **From Video** This option is selected for converted CS4 documents that have media clips set to a specific frame. Specify the following options, and click OK. **Description** Type a description that appears if the media file cannot be played in Acrobat. This description also acts as alternative text for visually impaired users. If you select this option, specify the size ratio and position on the screen. Increasing the size of the floating window may reduce image quality. The floating window scale is based on the size of the original movie, not the size of the scaled movie in the document layout. This option is not available for SWF files or audio files. Select an empty frame or a video object containing a video you want to replace. **Resize movie objects, posters, or frames** When you add a movie to the InDesign document, the movie object and poster appear in a frame. For best results, keep the poster size and dimension the same as the movie. If you apply a clipping path or resize the image, the exported PDF document may not include these changes. Movies are displayed in the topmost layer of the PDF document. If you overlay a movie with another object in InDesign, that object appears beneath the

movie in the exported PDF. If you want the PDF document to include a play area with feathering or other effects that may not export well when applied to a poster, consider using a placed image for the play area, and then place a movie without a poster on top of the placed image. Resizing movie object A. Frame Do any of the following: To resize the movie object, poster, and frame, use the Scale tool and drag one of the corner handles hold down Shift to maintain proportions. To resize only the frame, use the Selection tool to drag a corner handle. To resize the poster or media object, use the Direct Selection tool to select the poster. Switch to the Selection tool, and then drag a corner handle. Adobe Media Encoder does not convert audio file formats to MP3, but you can use an application such as Apple iTunes to do so. For more information, see Adobe Media Encoder Help. Do any of the following actions: Place the media file in an InDesign document. See Add movies and sound files to documents. If the video files have already been placed in an InDesign document, use the Links panel to relink the files to their new versions. See Update, restore, and replace links.

You can add sound effects and music to your movies. In addition, you can add background music to your movie using any audio clip. Audio placed as background music is edited separately in its own area of the timeline and is unaffected by edits made to other clips in your movie. Add background music Select Audio above the browser. The contents of the selected item appear as a list in the browser. To filter what appears, click the pop-up menu in the upper-left corner of the browser and choose a category. Browse to find the clip you want to add to your project. Drag the clip to the background music well, located below the timeline. You can position, trim, and edit the background audio independently of clips in the timeline. For more information, see Customize project settings. Add a sound clip Select Audio above the browser. In the browser, select an audio clip you want to add to your movie. Do one of the following: Add the entire audio clip: Drag the clip from the list to the timeline. Add part of the audio clip: Select a range in the waveform at the top of the browser, and drag the range to the timeline. The audio clip is now attached to a clip in the timeline. If you move the clip the audio clip is attached to, the audio clip moves as well.

What You Will Need Depending on the soundtrack quality you want to http: It can be a microphone in your PC headset, an inbuilt laptop microphone, a smartphone, a tablet, a standalone microphone for karaoke. It may be a voice recording app, professional software, or a digital voice recorder hardware. It can be a feature of a voice recording program or a separate audio tool. Unlike desktop microphones modern smartphones like iPhone 6 or Samsung Galaxy 5 are equipped with smart noise cancellation thanks to inbuilt high-pass filter and additional microphones. So even outside at a noisy place, your phone is likely to record your voice instead of wind or passersby. But if you own an old Nokia, it will record all surrounding noises. Obviously, if you have a professional karaoke microphone, the quality of your soundtrack will be much better. If you purchase a digital audio recorder like one of Sony ICD family, no extra microphones are required. Before you jump to our list of best free voice recorders for all platforms, you have to know several things about audio recording. First of all, it all depends on the level of professional performance you want to set for your video production. Especially, if you plan to record an instrumental track, an average home-use microphone will fail to record all nuances of your playing. Microsoft Voice Recorder Actually, Microsoft provides us with default free voice recorder which is already installed on your PC. To use Microsoft Voice Recorder follow these steps: Click on the search result. Voice Recorder will launch in a new window. To begin the process click on the blue microphone sign and speak into your microphone. To finish the tape click on the microphone sign again. Use the Music app to download songs from iTunes in the Cloud, or use iTunes on your computer to sync songs from your iTunes library. Background music clips are colored green in the timeline. With your project open, tap Audio at the bottom of the media library. If the media library is not visible, tap the Add Media button in the upper-right corner, then tap Audio at the bottom of the media library. To find music previously synced to your device from your computer, tap Theme Music or any one of the listed categories. To listen to the music before adding it, tap the item. To add the music to your movie project, tap the item, then tap Use. If the music is shorter than 1 minute, you must add video to the project before you add the music. By default, iMovie automatically loops background music to fit the length of your movie. You can add multiple songs as background music, but iMovie automatically arranges them to play one song at a time. You can also manually adjust the length if you want. If the playhead is resting over an existing clip, the new clip is added either before or after the existing clip, whichever is closest to the playhead. Tap iCloud Drive in the list of categories.
