From such humble beginnings, The New Yorker has become a famous and widely circulated magazine. Almost everything great had a small beginning. Our chapter is about a new beginning with God. So they wept while the younger men rejoiced. But God used this new beginning to reestablish His people in their worship to Him amidst the rubble of what once had been Jerusalem. It was to this temple that the Lord Jesus Himself would come and bring the greater glory. There are times in all of our lives when we need a new beginning with God. Maybe you have failed the Lord terribly through deliberate rebellion and sin. Perhaps you have drifted carelessly into the world and its ways, neglecting the things of God. A disappointment or trial may have caused you to drift from the close fellowship with God and His people that you once enjoyed. You need a new beginning. And if it is, where do you start? But you get there and discover that the land is just a pile of rubble. How do you begin again with God? Our chapter shows us four things: New beginnings with God are possible no matter how spiritually low we have gone. The nation of Israel was about as spiritually low as you can go. The northern kingdom had fallen to the Assyrians in B. The southern kingdom of Judah fell in B. Almost 50, Jews responded. They gave up their lives in Babylon, risked the dangerous and difficult journey across the desert, and now were back in the land. It was a land devastated by war, suffering from 50 years of neglect. The hostile people that had moved in viewed these returning Jews with suspicion. There was nothing happening spiritually. And yet God had promised a new beginning in this desolate ghost town see Jer. Whether it is to His people corporately or to individual believers who have fallen into sin, our God is a God of new beginnings! To the weeping and broken Peter, the risen Savior appeared privately to restore him. Have you failed the Lord miserably? God graciously offers you a new beginning! But, where do you start? New beginnings with God must focus on the cross of Jesus Christ. The first thing that the leaders, Jeshua and Zerubbabel, did when they saw the pile of rubble where the Temple once stood was to rebuild the altar Ezra 3: From verse 6 we learn that they had done this prior to the first day of the seventh month, when the returned remnant gathered in Jerusalem. So when the people got to the devastated city, rising out of the rubble they saw a restored altar. Even though the foundation of the temple had not been laid, the sight of that altar filled them with hope! Why did they begin with the altar? Because our fundamental need if we want to draw near to God is forgiveness of our sins. If you have never begun with God, you must begin at the cross, where Jesus the Lamb of God shed His blood to atone for sinners. The Bible says that without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness Heb. Either you put your trust in the perfect substitute God provided, the Lord Jesus Christ; or you must pay for your own sins with eternal separation from God in the lake of fire Rev. If you are a believer, but have strayed from the Lord, the cross is still the place for a new beginning. Live daily at the foot of the cross. New beginnings with God must focus on obedience to His Word. How did they know to set up the altar? Maybe the younger generation wanted a more contemporary way of meeting with God! Why not throw out the old and bring in some innovation to liven things up? They went back to the Word of God and they obeyed it. There is nothing wrong with contemporary music and forms of worship, as long as they do not violate Scripture. Some of the old hymns contain great theology, and the younger generation should learn them and pass them on. Some of the old hymns are shallow and corny and should be forgotten! The same can be said of the newer music: Some songs are solid and edifying; some are theologically shallow and silly. The standard we need to evaluate everything is, does it line up with Scripture and properly glorify God as He is revealed in His Word? Begin at the cross and then walk in obedience to His Word. New beginnings with God must focus on building His house. Verse 6 implies that while their new beginning of rebuilding the altar was good, something major was still missing: They had not yet laid the foundation for the temple. Quantum equation predicts universe has no beginning February 9, by Lisa Zyga, Phys. Note on the left the dramatic expansion not to scale occurring in the inflationary epoch, and at the center the expansion acceleration. The scheme is decorated with WMAP images on the left and with the representation of stars at the appropriate level of development. The model may also account for dark matter and dark energy, resolving multiple problems at once. The widely accepted age of the universe, as estimated by general relativity, is 13.8 billion years. In the beginning, everything in existence is thought to have occupied a single infinitely dense point, or singularity. Only after this point began to expand in a "Big Bang" did the universe officially begin. Although the Big Bang singularity arises directly and unavoidably from the mathematics of general relativity, some scientists see it as problematic because the math can explain only what happened immediately after—not before—the singularity. Ali and coauthor Saurya Das at the University of Lethbridge in Alberta, Canada, have shown in a paper published in *Physics Letters B* that the Big Bang singularity can be resolved by their new model in which the universe has no beginning and no end. Old ideas revisited The physicists emphasize that their quantum correction terms are not applied ad hoc in an attempt to specifically eliminate the Big Bang singularity. Their work is based on ideas by the theoretical physicist David Bohm, who is also known for his contributions to the philosophy of physics. Starting in the 1950s, Bohm explored replacing classical geodesics the shortest path between two points on a curved surface with quantum trajectories. Using the quantum-corrected Raychaudhuri equation, Ali and Das derived quantum-corrected Friedmann equations, which describe the expansion and evolution of universe including the Big Bang within the context of general relativity. Ali and Das also expect their results to hold even if and when a full theory of quantum gravity is formulated. No singularities nor dark stuff In addition to not predicting a Big Bang singularity, the new model does not predict a "big crunch" singularity, either. In general relativity, one possible fate of the universe is that it starts to shrink until it collapses in on itself in a big crunch and becomes an infinitely dense point once again. Ali and Das explain in their paper that their model avoids singularities because of a key difference between classical geodesics and Bohmian trajectories. Classical geodesics eventually cross each other, and the points at which they converge are singularities. In contrast, Bohmian trajectories never cross each other, so singularities do not appear in the equations. In cosmological terms, the scientists explain that the quantum corrections can be thought of as a cosmological constant term without the need for dark energy and a radiation term. These terms keep the universe at a finite size, and therefore give it an infinite age. The terms also make predictions that agree closely with current observations of the cosmological constant and density of the universe. New gravity particle In physical terms, the model describes the universe as being filled with a quantum fluid. The scientists propose that this fluid might be composed of gravitons—hypothetical massless particles that mediate the force of gravity. If they exist, gravitons are thought to play a key role in a theory of quantum gravity. In a related paper, Das and another collaborator, Rajat Bhaduri of McMaster University, Canada, have lent further credence to this model. They show that gravitons can form a Bose-Einstein condensate named after Einstein and another Indian physicist, Satyendranath Bose at temperatures that were present in the universe at all epochs. Their future work includes redoing their study while taking into account small inhomogeneous and anisotropic perturbations, but they do not expect small perturbations to significantly affect the results. This expression, "the fear of the Lord," occurs thirteen times in the Proverbs, and plays a prominent part throughout the Old Testament. Men had to be taught how hateful sin was to God, and the lesson was for the most part instilled into them by the fear of immediate punishment. And with this new message a new motive to obedience was preached. The "fear of the Lord" was now superseded by the higher duty of the "love of God," and of man, for His sake. Now, it was seen that, although the "fear of the Lord" may be the "beginning of wisdom," yet something better still may be aimed at: John, the last New Testament writer, is summed up in the words, "If God so loved us, we ought also to love one another" 1John 4: Pulpit Commentary Verse 7-ch. The first main section of the book begins here and ends at Proverbs 9: It consists of a series of fifteen admonitory discourses addressed to youth by the Teacher and Wisdom personified, with the view to exhibit the excellence of wisdom, and generally to illustrate the motto, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge," or wisdom. It urges strong encouragements to virtue, and equally strong dissuasives from vice, and shows that the attainment of wisdom in its true sense is the aim of all moral effort. This proposition is by some commentators regarded as the motto, symbol, or device of the book Delitzsch, Umbreit, Zockler, Plumptre. Others, following the Masoretic arrangement of the Hebrew text, consider it as forming part of the superscription Ewald, Bertheau, Elster, Keil. As a general proposition expressing the essence of the philosophy of the Israelites, and from its relation to the rest of the contents of this book, it seems rightly to occupy a special and individual position. The proposition occurs again in the Proverbs in Proverbs 9: With this maxim we may compare "The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom" Proverbs The expression describes that reverential attitude or holy fear which man, when his heart is set aright, observes towards God. Servile or abject fear as Jerome, Beda, Estius is not to be understood, but filial fear as Gejerus, Mercerus, Cornelius a Lapide, Cartwright, by which we fear to offend God - that fear of Jehovah which is elsewhere described as "to hate evil" Proverbs 8: Wardlaw remarks that the "fear of the Lord" is in invariable union with love and in invariable proportion to it. We truly fear God just in proportion as we truly love him. The fear of the Lord also carries with it the whole worship of God. This word has been understood in three different senses: This sense is adopted in the marginal reading comp. Wisdom has its origin in God, and whoever fears him receives it if he prays in faith cf. That the first sense, viz. All previous knowledge to "the fear of the Lord" is comparative folly. He who would advance in knowledge must first be imbued with a reverence or holy fear of God. But fools despise wisdom and instruction; or, according to the inverted order of the words in the original, wisdom and instruction fools despise, the association of ideas in the three words, "knowledge," "wisdom," and "instruction," thus being more continuously sustained. Delitzsch understands it as "thick, hard, stupid," from the root *aval*, *coalescere*, *incrassari*. Dunn takes it in the same sense as "gross or dull of understanding. The radical meaning is most probably contemptuous trampling under the feet Geseuius. Wisdom and instruction see ver. The latter clause of this verse is antithetical to the former, but the antithesis is obscurely expressed. In the Authorized Version it is marked by the adversative conjunction "but," which, however, is not in the original. Compare the Arabic Version, which has the same interpolation: *Et intellectus bonus onmibus facientibus eam. Sana religio in Deum est initium prudentiae.* Matthew Henry Commentary 1: Children are reasonable creatures, and when we tell them what they must do, we must tell them why. For Ball 1 to be destroyed, there would need to be something greater. But nothing is greater than Ball 1, nor ever could be. It exists without need of anything else. It therefore cannot be changed by any external forces. It can have no end, for It has no beginning. It is the way it is and that cannot change. In that sense, it is untouchable. What we see is this: The Something exists on its own. Something Else, however, needs Something to exist. Therefore, Something Else has needs. It is therefore inferior to Something, and will always be so, for the Eternal Something has no need of another. The Something might be able to produce Something Else that is like It in some ways, but -- no matter what -- Something Else will always be unlike It in other ways. The Eternal Something will always be greater with respect to time and power. Thus, the Eternal Something cannot produce an exact equal to Itself. It alone has always existed.
