

1: 10 Most Controversial Nobel Peace Prize Winners

Linus Pauling, the Nobel Peace Prize laureate in 1962, is the only person to have been awarded two unshared Nobel Prizes; he won the Nobel Prize in Chemistry in 1954. At 17 years of age, Malala Yousafzai, the recipient, is the youngest to be awarded the Peace Prize.

While meant to recognize those whose work has greatly benefited or contributed to the advancement and unity of mankind, the Nobel Peace Prize has sometimes been given to those with violent pasts, those whose award-winning work contains factual errors, or those whose accomplishments do not quiet bear up under close examination. Here are the ten most controversial Nobel Peace Prize winners of all time. There were two reasons for this controversy. His win was also called premature since North Vietnam invaded South Vietnam two years after the prize was awarded, voiding his work. Cordell Hull Nominated several times throughout the s, Cordell finally won the Nobel Peace Prize in for his prominent role in the creation of the United Nations, his peace efforts, and his trade agreements. But many felt he was undeserving of the award because his callous anti-immigration stance only years earlier meant almost 1, Jewish refugees were denied asylum. In , the SS St. Louis attempted to carry Jewish refugees from Hamburg to America in order to avoid the impending Holocaust. Although President Franklin D. Criticism has been heaped on the committee for this award not only because of the failure of the Oslo accords but because of Arafat himself. His life has been majorly scrutinized, including his role in overseeing military groups responsible for bombings, hijackings, assassinations, and his aversion to compromise, a quality that hurt the future of the Oslo accords all the more. Many have since argued that the invention of the prefrontal lobotomy has caused more harm than good. He derived intellectual pleasure from literature, while science built the foundation for his own activities as a technological researcher and inventor. He decided to send Alfred abroad to study and become a chemical engineer. Nobel received his first patent at age . Ten years later, he would establish factories in several countries and was the first person in the world to create an international holding company. This prize, which Alfred valued highly, was awarded for "important discoveries of practical value to humanity. When his will was opened it came as a surprise that his fortune was to be used for Prizes in Physics, Chemistry, Physiology or Medicine, Literature and Peace. Nobel declared that his estate should be used to endow "prizes to those who, during the preceding year, shall have conferred the greatest benefit to mankind. The back of the medal shows a tunnel blasted by dynamite and a detonator or blasting cap. On the front of the medal is a portrait of Nobel, with the Latin inscription *Creavit et promovit*, which can be translated "He created and promoted.
