Basking in Sunshine Problems Associated With Adopting Two Puppies at the Same Time Why experts warn against adopting two puppies at the same time - and what you can do for your dogs if you did not heed the warning. Think long and hard about getting two puppies at the same time. If you do get two puppies, make a firm commitment to spend social time and training time with them separately, to avoid having them super-bond with each other. Consider instead adopting one puppy now and another later, or better yet, one puppy now and an adult dog later. So, if one puppy is wonderful, two puppies must be twice as wonderful, right? Most training professionals strongly recommend against adopting two pups at the same time. The biggest challenge of adopting puppy pairs is their tendency to bond very closely with each other, often to the exclusion of a meaningful relationship with their humans. They can become inseparable. Also, owners often underestimate the time commitment required to properly care for and train two puppies; as a result the pups often end up untrained and undersocialized. You stand the best chance of raising well-trained and -socialized puppies one at a time. However, there are very good reasons to think long and hard about not getting two puppies at once, whether they are siblings or not. While the majority of new puppy owners seem to recognize that one puppy is enough of a responsibility for them, a certain number fall prey to one of a few common arguments about why two puppies might be better than one. I can rebut every one of them! Better solutions might include: A couple of weeks vacation time? Kids home for the summer? Since when do the kids get to make the rules? Seriously, most families I know have enough trouble getting their kids to fulfill their promise to feed, walk, and clean up after one family dog. Mom ends up doing most of it anyway. So now Mom gets to do double-puppy-duty? If you must adopt two puppies at the same time for the kids, see the second half of this article. When you raise two puppies together they usually do grow up to be inseparable best friends, often to the detriment of the dog-human relationship. Inevitably they spend far more time together than they do individually with you, with a likely result that they become very tightly bonded to each other and you are only secondary in their lives. Many owners of adopted-at-the-same-time puppies ultimately find themselves disappointed in their relationships with their dogs, even when they are committed to keeping them for life. This super-bonding also causes tremendous stress and stress-related behavior problems on those occasions when the dogs do have to be separated - and sooner or later, something will come up that requires them to be separated: Of course you want your dogs to get along. If you really want to save a life, adopt a grown-up dog instead of a puppy, or at least adopt your puppy now, and come back for an adult dog in a few months. A truly responsible breeder will, in most cases, refuse to sell two puppies to one home, except on the rare occasion that a prospective buyer can prove she has the skill, knowledge, time, ability, and monetary resources to provide an excellent environment for two pups at once. If you do take the bait and find yourself in double trouble, there are things you can do to minimize problems and maximize your success as the owner of a puppy pair: You can crate them near each other, but this is the perfect time to start habituating them to not always being in close contact with their sibling. When they are comfortable in their crates close to each other, you can gradually increase distance between crates until they can be crated out of sight of each other, perhaps even in another room. This is vitally important so someone hears them when they wake at night and have to go out. And by the way, you can bet if one puppy wakes up to go out, the other puppy in her nearby crate will wake up, too. Your training programs will be much more successful if you take the time to work with your pups individually. If you are using clicker training and I hope you are! Unless you train, walk, and socialize them separately, one sibling is likely to emerge as a leader - one whom the other sibling relies on for social cues and direction. Ideally, you want both siblings to become confident and independent. Training time is a perfect opportunity to give your pups a positive association with being separated. Eventually you can each work with them at the same time in the same room, and sometime in the future one person can have fun working with

them both at the same time. Play with them separately. If you watch closely, you may even see the more assertive one do a little body language warning if the other tries to get the toy - a hard stare and stiffened body, perhaps. The less assertive one defers to her sibling by letting go of the toy and looking away. Unless you make the effort to give her positive reinforcement for fetching toys when you play with her alone, you might find it difficult to get her to retrieve later on in her training. Walk and socialize them separately. All the activities you would normally do with one pup, you need to do with each pup individually. Signing up for puppy training class? Set aside two nights, not one, and take them to separate classes. Going to the groomer? Time for that next set of puppy shots? Make two appointments, not one. Everything you would do with one puppy you need to do with each puppy separately. Of course you can also do things with them together, but you must be sure they are completely relaxed and comfortable about being apart. Inevitably, at some time in their lives super-bonded dogs will have to be separated. Most of the time, one will die before the other. I know of cases where the surviving dog of a super-bonded pair has had to be euthanized after the partner died, as he was too stressed by himself to be able to function. This is not a situation any loving dog owner wants to face. Not surprisingly, it costs twice as much for routine feeding and care for two puppies as it does for one. One pup produces more than enough waste for any sane human to deal with, and with two pups you naturally double the production. One pup is likely to learn to eliminate in a corner of the pen reasonably quickly, and will hopefully avoid tromping through it. Two puppies may select two different corners of the pen as designated bathroom spots, which doubles the chances of poop tromping. Picture yourself coming home from a long, hard day at work, tired, looking forward to a little loving puppy cuddling, to find a pair of poo-covered pups in a pen plastered with the stuff from one side to the other. We normally recommend the umbilical cord approach to housetraining: Which pup did it? I see teeth marks on the corner of the antique loveseat! With two pups, you have to increase management and supervision on both of them, and may never know for sure which one is having accidents. Others say get two boys. Some might specifically warn against getting two girls, stating that two female adult dogs in the same family will fight. Plenty of same-sex puppy pairs get along just fine throughout their lives. Plenty of mixed-sex pairs do the same. There are same sex pairs that end up with conflicts, and there are mixed-sex pairs that end up fighting with each other despite super-bonding. It does seem to be true and there are some studies that indicate that intra-pack conflicts involving two females tend to be more intense than intra-pack issues between two males, or opposite sex pairs. Think About It Is the extra fun of having two puppies at one time worth all the extra time, energy, cost, and headaches? But if you decide to do it anyway, and are ready to do all it takes to make it work, then you have my sincere blessings and best wishes. But please, be honest and realistic about whether you and your other human family members really have the resources and commitment to give both pups what they need to ensure their lifelong loving home with you. And there is a good chance that the store you end up at will be Home Depot. So you park your car and walk into the warehouse size store. What are you looking for? There are all kinds of locks all over the store. Some look very different than others. Do you just need to find your same type of lock you already have and be on your way? In this post, we will be talking about what you need to look for in your Home Depot lock purchase. Keep in mind that some of the finer points of selection may vary depending on the specific store. To combat that, we have some general information, and some slightly more specific general information.

General Purchasing Knowledge

You want a good lock. No, you want the best lock you can get. Well, not the best lock, because that one is too expensive. But you do care and you do want a lock, so you go down to your local Home Depot. When you are at the store making your decision, there are going to be several things you need to do. Read the fine print, and read between the lines. Some locks will advertise as having a numbered security rating. These types of ratings are ultimately meaningless to the average consumer.

Price Matters

When it comes to security, you get what you pay for. A larger initial purchase will almost always ensure a higher level of security. The biggest exception to this trend is when a lock has a bypass that the company refuses to invest in finding a solution for. This could be for many reasons, but the most common is money. A high price can also be deceptive if the product includes electronics. Smart locks are going to be very expensive, but they are not necessarily more secure than a standard manually operated lock. You need to understand what cost is being passed down to you. Ideally, you want to be paying for security pins, solid construction, and stronger materials, because that will decide your level of protection. Unfortunately, brand awareness does not always transfer over to quality. Schlage is one of the few exceptions to this trend. They are not the best locks, but they offer better hardware construction and picking resistance than a company like Kwikset. If it is not a name you recognize it is for one of two reasons: If it is cheap, then it is most likely made in China with shoddy craftsmanship and weak construction. If it is expensive, look up the brand, but chances are it is a brand whose price makes the locks too exclusive to build brand awareness. Mul-T-Lock you may have heard of or, at least, seen the logo, but none of that matters. As we will discuss, it is not about the name, it is about how the particular lock fits your need.

Doorknobs and Deadbolts

These are the types of locks that will be on the front of your home. Your doorknob at least on the front door will be keyed. In addition to a keyed in knob cylinder, you should also have a deadbolt. A deadbolt can either be double sided or single sided. For a front door, it will make sense to have a single sided deadbolt with a thumb turn, this will help increase the effectiveness of your front door security. If you have glass or windows on the door, or in close proximity to it, the best option will be a double sided. Once you have installed a double sided deadbolt you must consider that door a wall. In an emergency situation, it will require the time-consuming task of retrieving a key, preventing any type of quick escape. You can take care of this yourself or seek the help of a professional. A professional locksmith is always available to help with new lock installations and they will also give you some handy security tips. If you choose to do it yourself, or would simply like to remain informed about the service you are purchasing, take some measurements from you door and locks. If you currently have a mortise lock on your front door, then you will most likely want another mortise. If you plan to change from one lock type to another, be sure that you understand the work that is required. To keep with the mortise example, if you want to change to a keyed in knob cylinder you will need to fill in the pocket of drilled out wood. Product comparison will help get to the root of why a particular lock is more expensive than another. Beyond product comparison, find out what you really need. If the bolt work is functioning perfectly, then you may only need a new cylinder. A new cylinder will be cheaper than buying all new hardware. This also goes for installing the product yourself. Self-installation is a good way to save money if you have the time and skills necessary for the job. When it comes to hardware, the metal should be strong,

and the construction should be solid. The heaviness of the device will be a good indication of both those factors the heavier the better. That goes for the lock as well as the strike plate that your bolts will extend into. You do not want your lock being defeated by a single well-placed kick. Look for video documentation. If you can see the product being used in real time, then that is a good sign. Better yet, if the lock is taken apart, you can trust that the review is accurate. This is often used for describing the process of taking apart the lock, and may be used in conjunction with a picking attempt. Try and find a video of the product being installed as well, to gauge how difficult it may be. This mindset will ensure that you are not getting the best lock for your home. It is fine to try and save money, but this should not be the end goal. The end goal should be to have effective security protocols in place. The price point is a plus, and may be a factor, but it is not a good deciding factor. Choosing your application is very important because picking the lock or attempting to over and over will weaken the mechanism. If the employee that is selling you the product, cannot answer a question without looking at the box, then chances are they are not the expert you need. If they are only referring to the box for specific information, then this is not a red flag. Knowing a bit of information ahead of time will help you determine who is misleading you. When you are being lead astray, it may be the result of an honest attempt to help, and the person may not understand that they are misinformed. Bad information is not always malicious.

Padlocks A padlock is historically defined by its ability to be removed from what it is securing. Nowadays a padlock can be recognized by a shackle and a lock body. They may have a dial, a wheel combination, or keyway, but a padlock is a padlock. If you can take the lock with you after you open it, then you have a padlock. The type you want will depend on what it is you are securing. There are all kinds of things to consider based on your personal needs. Measure the distance you have to reach in order to secure the lock. You want the closed shackle to be tight around whatever type of hasp, or similar securing point, the lock will be placed on. A weak support system for your padlock will undercut the effectiveness of your lock. Also, take a look at what your chain or hasp is secured to. The anchor points, whether they are posts or gates, must also be secure. The packaging might also mention if the product has ball bearings. Ball bearings afford you protection against shimmying, which is a bypass method that anyone can perform with an aluminum can and a pair of scissors. The bare minimum protection is hardened steel. This steel can be used on an anti drill plate, or pins in the lock. Better than that is some form of alloy. And still better than that is an alloy with ceramic inserts. This type of protection should be used in the shackle as well as the lock body. Using a shroud will also help to protect the shackle. A shroud can be located protruding from the lock body to cover the sides of the shackle. This may come in the form of a plastic casing, drain holes, etc. If there is the danger of dust and dirt being kicked up into the lock you may also want something with keyway shielding. Nonspecific plans will get you a lock that leaves you unprepared. A shackle that is too short will not close, and will therefore not secure your possession.
