

## 1: Break | Definition of Break by Merriam-Webster

*It's when those bad habits sneak into our professional lives, that we need to be proactive in altering them. Small business owners are an amazing breed. They are confident, natural salespeople, have a keen business sense, and are comfortable with calculated risks.*

What can other Oregon employers learn from this situation to avoid a similar fate? Give Me A Break! Starting in , the state agency received a series of complaints from Legacy employees alleging that they did not get their mandated meals and breaks. Over a two-year span, workers lodged about a dozen complaints alleging violations of state wage and hour laws. In one complaint filed in September , an employee asserted they had only been granted two or three minute breaks in 18 years of work for the organization. In an April complaint, a nurse alleged she was forced to eat during her active shifts because she was not getting time off. Can be stuck without breaks for 8 hours. The problems spanned several departments; for example, the agency found over 1, violations in the surgery department, over 2, in the housekeeping department, and about in the family birthing center. The state concluded that the alleged violations caused problems for the employees and could have also impacted the services provided by the employer. According to a statement by the agency commissioner, the breaks were also important for wellbeing of the patients served by the workers in question. The hospital originally announced its intent to fight the charges, but reversed course in an announced November 2 settlement. Oregon meal and rest break law is deceptively simple, but violations can lead to drastic consequences. The law requires employers to provide a minute rest break for every segment of four hours, or major part thereof, worked. For example, once an employee works more than two hours, they are entitled to one paid break. If they work more than six hours, they need to receive two such breaks. During this break time, employees should be relieved of all work. It is up to the employer to ensure that they are giving the breaks and to show that employees are actually taking the breaks. There is a similar system in place for meal periods. Anyone who works a shift of more than six hours is entitled to an uninterrupted minute unpaid meal period. If the employee is interrupted during that time, the entire meal period becomes a paid period of work. Again, you as the employer have an obligation to ensure your workers are taking their full lunch breaks and will be expected to monitor and enforce the situation. What Can You Do? As you can probably figure out from the large fine levied against Legacy, violations can be costly. The problems can quickly accumulate and lead to significant liability. So how you can avoid a similar fate? You should start with a clear written policy requiring meal and rest breaks to be taken, specifically spelling out for all workers the amount of break time to which they are all entitled. You should next supervise workers closely to ensure the breaks and meals are being taken, training managers to stay vigilant in the enforcement of your policy. Consistent enforcement of your policy is crucial. If the problem persists, you should issue them discipline such as a written warning for failing to abide by the policy.

Your break-even points provide important benchmarks for long-term planning. Knowing your break-even for areas such as sales, production, operations and investment payback can help you with pricing, debt service and other functions of operating your business. Break Even A break-even point occurs when your revenues cover your expenses. This does not cover your overhead costs, which are indirect expenses such as rent, insurance, marketing and phones. Variable Costs Some costs increase as your sales increase, such as materials, production labor and shipping. These are variable costs. These are fixed costs. If you sell 2, widgets, your rent contribution is 50 cents per unit. Knowing your fixed and variable costs per unit, based on the number of units you estimate you will sell, will help you determine your break-even point and pricing needs. Price-Setting Implications Once you know your various break-even points, you can set your long-term pricing strategies. For example, once you have paid off your initial investment, you can keep your prices the same, making more profits per widget, or you can lower your prices, since you no longer have to pay off your investment debt. Lowering prices might result in more sales, bringing you more total, or gross, profits, even though your profit per widget is lower. Marketing Considerations Each time you consider a sale or discount, calculate your break-even points to determine if you can still make money at that price. Or, you can divide the cost of the promotion by the additional number of units the promotion generated in sales and apply that cost to your overhead cost per unit for those additional units. Financial Strategies There is more than one way to reach break-even. You might increase your sales, raise your prices to increase your profit margins, lower your profits to generate more gross profits or reduce expenses. You can reduce expenses through cost-cutting measures, depreciating assets, reducing interest-bearing debt or investing excess cash to generate capital gains on that money. Knowing your break-even points will let you see the effects these different strategies have. Investment Implications Potential investors not only want to know the potential return on their investments, they also want to know when they will see that return. Some companies take years before they are profitable. In some scenarios, the business might lose money during the first year or several years before breaking even from operations. However, even after it is profitable from operations, the company might still carry significant investment money it needs to pay back using its profits after operations. Therefore, the company has not made a profit for its investors. Investors will want your break-even points in your business plan to determine if they are interested in your opportunity.

One of these errors is the introduction of bad breaks. Bad breaks occur when a word is broken in a place that makes it hard to read or hard for the eye to follow. First, know how to spot a bad break. A good way to find them quickly is to scan the right margin of the page for hyphenated words and check each word to be sure it is hyphenated correctly. Watch for the two-letter break. This occurs when a word is broken so only two letters fall on the next line. Be on the lookout for the double-hyphen break. This occurs when a hyphenated word is broken again. Beware the dictionary break. You would only know it is a bad break if you know how the word is broken in the dictionary. This break is often stotted, but if you see a word broken in an odd spot, it may be worth checking. Often, hyphens get introduced when URLs are broken. It is always important to check URLs to see whether or not the hyphen belongs there. Additionally, URLs should only be broken between words, before a period and after a dash or slash. Heed the page-turn break. In some cases, you may not want a word to break at the end of a page. This is often true for right-hand pages recto pages , because a break here forces the reader to turn the page to finish reading the word. Tips It is up to the editor to decide how strict to be about bad breaks. He may choose to mark all of them, some of them or none at all.
