Nearly all of the input energy ends up as heat that, in warm climates, must then be removed from the building by ventilation or air conditioning , often resulting in more energy consumption. In colder climates where heating and lighting is required during the cold and dark winter months, the heat byproduct has at least some value. For this reason, most have a bulb of fused silica quartz , but sometimes aluminosilicate glass. This is often sealed inside an additional layer of glass. The outer glass is a safety precaution, reducing UV emission and because halogen bulbs can occasionally explode during operation. One reason is if the quartz bulb has oily residue from fingerprints. The risk of burns or fire is also greater with bare bulbs, leading to their prohibition in some places unless enclosed by the luminaire. Those designed for 12 or 24 volt operation have compact filaments, useful for good optical control, also they have higher efficiencies lumens per watt and better lives than non-halogen types. The light output remains almost constant throughout their life. Fluorescent lamp Top, two compact fluorescent lamps. Bottom, two fluorescent tube lamps. A matchstick, left, is shown for scale. Fluorescent lamps consist of a glass tube that contains mercury vapour or argon under low pressure. Electricity flowing through the tube causes the gases to give off ultraviolet energy. The inside of the tubes are coated with phosphors that give off visible light when struck by ultraviolet energy. For the same amount of light generated, they typically use around one-quarter to one-third the power of an incandescent. The typical luminous efficacy of fluorescent lighting systems is 50 lumens per watt, several times the efficacy of incandescent bulbs with comparable light output. Fluorescent lamp fixtures are more costly than incandescent lamps because they require a ballast to regulate the current through the lamp, but the lower energy cost typically offsets the higher initial cost. Compact fluorescent lamps are now available in the same popular sizes as incandescents and are used as an energy-saving alternative in homes. Because they contain mercury, many fluorescent lamps are classified as hazardous waste. The United States Environmental Protection Agency recommends that fluorescent lamps be segregated from general waste for recycling or safe disposal, and some jurisdictions require recycling of them.

Some say that a lampstand is for shining and that in this dark age today, the church shines as a golden lampstand. Although it is right to say this, the golden lampstand is not so simple. We need to read the Bible and find the entire history of the golden lampstand so that we may understand its significance. We know that the revelation in the Bible develops progressively. The seeds of the divine revelation are sown mostly in the first few books of the Bible, and then they are gradually developed in the succeeding books until Revelation, where the harvest is reaped. The revelation concerning the golden lampstand is no exception. The seed of the revelation concerning the golden lampstand is sown in Exodus Then in 1 Kings 7 it sprouts; in Zechariah 4 it is developed; and finally in Revelation it is harvested. The Golden Lampstand Being the Solid Expression of the Triune God Exodus 25 mentions that the golden lampstand is beaten out of one piece of pure gold. It has a shaft with six branches going out from its sides, three branches on the right side and three branches on the left side. On the branches there are three layers—the cups, the calyxes, and the blossoming buds; in addition, there are the lamps. This picture first shows us that the substance of the golden lampstand is pure gold; second, that the one piece of gold is beaten into a golden lampstand with a form; and third, that the golden lampstand has seven lamps. The meaning is this: First, according to biblical typology, gold signifies the nature of God. Therefore, the emphasis here is that the pure gold as the substance of the lampstand signifies the Father as the nature of the golden lampstand. Second, the form of the lampstand signifies Christ. Christ is also the only begotten Son in the bosom of the Father who declared God John 1: John 14 even tells us that when we see the Son, we also see the Father because the Son is the solid expression of the Father. Hence, the lampstand here signifies the Son who declared the Father. Third, the golden lampstand has seven lamps. Concerning this, we cannot find the answer in Exodus. We need to look at Zechariah and Revelation together to understand the significance of the seven lamps. Zechariah 4 says that there are two olive trees beside the golden lampstand. Here, therefore, the revelation of the Spirit is implied. Exodus only mentions the golden lampstand which signifies Christ; it does not mention the olive oil which typifies the Spirit. It is not until Zechariah 4 that there is a further revelation—a revelation concerning the Spirit. Furthermore, it shows us that the seven lamps are the seven eyes of Jehovah. By putting together these passages, we can see that the seven lamps of the golden lampstand in the book of Zechariah are the seven Spirits of God in Revelation. Hence, the seven lamps signify the expression and shining of the Spirit. Thus, this golden lampstand not only has the substance of the Father, the form of the Son, but even more the expression of the Spirit. In other words, the testimony of the church is the solid expression of the Triune God. According to the record in Revelation 1, we see that where the church is, there is the golden lampstand. When people come to the church, they can sense that God is here, Christ is here, and the Spirit is here. This is the Father, the Son, and the Spirit operating, shining, and being manifested and expressed here. Such a church is the golden lampstand.

Some suffering we certainly must acknowledge as actual suffering. But ascribing a certain meaning to life and then feeling we have failed to achieve that is a suffering created by our own mind. Another person could be in an identical position, but have a totally different attitude, experience, and state of mind. If we go to another country, we can see clearly that people are quite happy without having all that we strive to attain. This helps us to see that happiness and suffering have to do with how we set our minds, and how we see ourselves in relation to others—as either ahead or behind in this imaginary race. To improve our capacity and develop confidence in changing this deluded perspective, we can begin by regarding our given work, family, social interactions, and everything else in our lives as field trips. Instead, we can use our circumstances as tools for increasing our wisdom and our skill in working with our mind, rather than falling asleep to those situations. Success and failure are secondary compared to the growth we can achieve from staying awake and engaged in those experiences. Not even two people will agree about them. So give up the neurosis of seeing things as if they exist outside of you and unrelated to your mind. For me, this is a very helpful way to look at things, because it gives me the liberty to not turn things into problems from viewing them as outside my mind. People prefer to see their problems as outside themselves, so they can blame something else rather than take responsibility. Everything is in place, just where it should be. You may think your problem is something out there, something objective. There would be no point in doing that. So now you can help many others, starting with your family. First you can help them by your example; then, if they are open, with verbal communication; and if they are even more open, with guidance. We can succeed in knowing the wisdom of Dharma, but even more effectively, we can become lamps that light many others. A hundred lamps may all have the potential to be lit, but if none are lit, then none can light the others. If just one is lit, it can light the other ninety-nine. In this way, we can serve as a lamp in our immediate situation, which is where it matters most. Some people think they should be like the sun, illuminating the entire earth. With this level of ambition, they think lighting a small area has little meaning. Again, this is the attitude of seeing oneself in a race, as needing to be bigger or better than the rest. You see, it is said in 1John 1: This is not just a compliment. To be identified with God in this way is an enormous responsibility as well. Because whatever light is and does, the disciple is to be and to do. We will look at this passage with these 2 questions in mind. You are the light of the world. What does that mean? What this light means, Jesus defines it in v. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, your light. The light that people see is the good works that we do. The good works are the works that are done in obedience to the living God. That includes our character, our conduct, our actions, and our spoken testimony. It is when we live a life characterized by righteousness that we shine like stars in the darkness of this world. Paul says in Philippians 2: You will appear as light in the world when you live a blameless life, a righteous life. Notice the contrast between darkness and light. You have become a little bit more ethical, more polite. He said that they were darkness. Paul is talking about what is happening inside of the person. Once, inside of you, you were darkness. Your whole character was darkness. But now, you are light in the Lord. Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children; The Bible tells us that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all 1John 1: A believer must be morally pure. We are saved by grace through faith. Salvation is not of works. Because the works that you do prove what you are, whether it is darkness or light. Now we see clearly the connection between the light of the world and a city set upon a hill. Jesus is comparing the church to a city that shines forth the glory of God.
