Building the Right Foundation 1 Corinthians 3: The purpose of this study is to build a foundation IN you so that you can live the rest of your life pursuing God! Knowing God is the greatest and most privileged pursuit that human beings can attain to. The MORE time you spend building your foundation correctly, the MORE likely that anything you build on that foundation will not crumble, fall, or lean in the long run! Believe it or not, most new believers in traditional American denominations are never taught how to develop depth in their foundation with God. All of these are actually worthy subjects to spend time studyingâ€ but each of these pursuits of knowledge have to be BUILT on top of some kind of foundation. What happens when time is not spent properly developing a foundation? If you build a foundation with wrong materials or even build it skewed, disastrous results can occur! You have not come to a religion, a church, a minister, or a set of beliefs. You have come to the living God that created the universe. He is the ONLY true foundation that you can have or should ever need. If you want to reach your destination in God, you must dig deep into the person of Godâ€who He is, what He thinks, what He is like, what His ways are, what His personality is like, and what He thinks and feels about you as His child. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock. And the ruin of that house was great. Do you think the order is important for these steps? Why or why not? What do you think happens when people are taught to read the Bible and obey the Bible without first being taught they have to come to the one who wrote the Bible? People approach the Bible for many different reasons and with many different motives. The Bible, like some other books, is a collection of words from different authors that are spread over hundreds of pages. However, unlike any other book, the words on the pages of the Bible were inspired by God and are without error in terms of truth. The problem with many Christians and theologians is that they approach Bible study as an end in itselfâ€ whereas God has given us the Bible as the primary and only error-free tool with which we can COME to Him and discover Him. In Luke 6, what does Jesus liken a person to who hears and does what He says? Did you know that becoming a believer and follower of Jesus does not preclude you from experiencing pain, trouble, or storms in life? Did you notice that when Jesus talked about those who build a foundation that He made sure to let us know that streams and torrents and storms will come against BOTH those who hear and obey His words and those who do not hear or obey as well? That is the beginning of the foundation. Obviously, part of being Christian involves turning from our sin, changing our minds about how we view the world and how we view God, and then obeying God and obeying what the Bible commands. This process, however, does not come overnight! One of the greatest battles you are going to face as you grow in maturity in the Lord is the sense of condemnation from your failures and your sins. Developing the right foundation in the Lord will hopefully prevent this condemnation from causing you to turn from following the Lord or from giving up in the race. Do you think that the ordering of these two foundation elements is important? It is important for you to understand that a solid foundation comes from the fact that the LORD the creator of the universe, the one who made everything KNOWS who you are! Whose were you before you were His? Human beings ultimately live our lives for our own desires and our own purposes. Your faith in Jesus and what He has done for you has given you access into the very family of God! Even though we have known [the Messiah] according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. It is important for you to realize that in order to depart from iniquity over the long term of your life, you must first know who you are and who you belong to. You might actually find it easy right now to make decisions for God regarding turning from sin because as new believers there is normally a fiery zeal in your heart for Jesus that is given by the Holy Spirit. This is normal and almost all believers testify to a similar experience in the first seasons of their new life with the Lord. That is why coming to know WHO you are in God is the greatest part of the foundation you need to build right now. This foundation series is designed to form a Biblically based image of

what God looks like to you and what you look like to God in truth. Unless you take time and effort to develop this foundation of love, your efforts to turn from iniquity will eventually fail in the long term. When it does, you will need to know who you are to God and how God views you in truth. Why do you think God wants us to depart from iniquity stop sinning so much? I have come that they [you] may have life, and that they [you] may have it more abundantly. For the end of those things is death. You should be aware of this fact: Spiritually, emotionally, and physically sin which is any type of disobedience or lack of obedience toward God has great detrimental impact on human life. It ruins us, ruins our relationships, and ruins our purpose for being created! The disobedience of man concerned God so much that He was willing to become a man and die in our place to deliver us from sin. The reason God wants us to depart from iniquity is because iniquity brings death, suffering, and loss! He does not want to see our lives destroyed or for us to suffer loss. Your iniquity separates you from God as well. Some sins will kill you faster [physically] than others, but in the end, all sin brings death and separation from God. He is indeed concerned that we represent the Kingdom of God well so that lost people can find the knowledge of salvation in Jesus through us. Many Christians, however, believe that God is more concerned about how we make Him look. As a result, we focus on cleaning up ourselves so that God will like us, love us, and accept us. What condition were we all in when we asked Jesus to be our Lord? This foundational truth must remain in your minds as you mature in the Lord: God loved us in spite of our imperfections and while we were yet still in our sins with no power to save ourselves. Do not be deceived. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God. The paradox lies in the fact that God by His righteousness has to judge sin but yet in His great love He has burning passion and desire for those who are sinners—people like you and me! This is exactly how God is. He knows sin destroys us and separates us from Him! He knows that sin breaks us inside and out. Because of His great passion for us, it is only natural that He would hate the very thing that brings about and causes our destruction. Never ever confuse His hatred of sin, however, with His feelings toward you. These terms all have to do with how God sees you through the eyes of His Son Jesus and your gradual growth in looking more like Jesus over time. Each of these ideas are covered more in depth as we progress through the foundations study! but the starting point of your life in God is that you have already been declared righteous, pure, and clean! Your response which will take the rest of your life is to allow God to possess you so that you become in practice what He says you already are! What did Paul use as a wise master builder in laying the foundation for new believers? But let each one take heed how he builds on it. Jesus the Messiah was and is the express image of the invisible God and is therefore the BEST object of study you can pursue initially. That means that when you read and study about Jesus, you are seeing and hearing and observing the very heart of the invisible God in action. Many new believers are taught that works of service will establish them in God.. However, works of service must flow out of a heart of love for God. Paul says that we must take heed as to HOW we build on our foundation in God. This is where we must all start and continually come back to. You must learn to BE before you can learn to DO. That is the essence of building a strong and sure foundation in the Lord Jesus. You are already accepted and loved by God through the work of Jesus on the cross: The Bible teaches that we must be perfect first in order for God to love us and accept us Romans 5:

Bucknell Basic Discipleship, An Introduction Basic discipleship is the place that immature Christians are established in their faith by developing their awareness of what it means to follow Christ. It is here that older Christians help train new or very young Christians. Like small children, new Christians are unstable and need security. Who would labor nine months to have a child only to neglect him after he is born? But this is precisely what many churches have done. Let me share another illustration. My wife recently planted seeds in the garden. We know from experience that when the beans start growing, birds come by and snatch the top of the sprout, virtually destroying the plant. So we expend extra effort to cover them. In the same way, we watch over a new Christian. Basic discipleship training materials provide the opportunity and guided teaching to pass on this kind of needed nurturing. The strong Christian culture in many places has disguised the need for this training for a long time. The members would receive much of their Bible and character training at home. This is not the case anymore. Being deliberate on discipleship People can sing the lyrics of many ungodly songs more than quote the Holy Scriptures. The church needs to quickly jump back into the race of equipping their people. As the church takes on its task to disciple train her people, families will again renew their task of training at home. This brings about a stable society. Every church should make sure every professing Christian has gone through a form of basic discipleship. We should train them in such a way that these disciples should be equipped and burdened to train others at this basic level. The training is simple and helps the Christian fulfill his or her obligation to make disciples. Jesus said, "Go and make disciples. About thirty people raised their hand. This was exciting, but not anywhere as special as the thirty people from the congregation that is a big number for that church who got up and counseled them. Notice that these thirty have not only been trained but trained to serve. We must train the Christian to participate in the training from the start. Those who have been a Christian a longer time but have not received basic discipleship training need special attention. If at all possible, they should start afresh here at the foundational truths and move on quickly to the next stage. Unless the foundation is firm, one cannot safely build upon it. One can almost guarantee that these same individuals have already picked up a number of wrong thought patterns and bad spiritual habits. More mature Christians need to disciple these individuals. If these Christians want to grow, they will easily adjust and grow. If they have a dull heart, much patience is needed. Certain bad concepts have to be taken down before a new building is erected. This takes a Christian from the start to the finish. We never stop growing in our life and service. We even have a diagram that shows the flow of discipleship and how this training can be integrated into the church. BFF has several sets of basic discipleship materials, many of which are free on the web. There are other discipleship material out there, but they are largely designed for student groups and not centered around the church as they should. My heart aches to see students who have been active in their Christian groups only to later never to become active in the local church after they move away. There are a number of problems. Transition is not easy. They have not been trained to adapt to a traditional church setting. They get lost in a big church. But the biggest problems is that they have never been trained to be Christ and other centered. They are self-centered without even knowing it in many cases. Read on to get a better understanding on how these basic discipleship materials work. Even better, download one series, become familiar with it and start using it!
