And it gave me the chills. In , he said: There were great catch-phrases and driving pulse rhythms I knew that when I got into folk music, it was more of a serious type of thing. The songs are filled with more despair, more sadness, more triumph, more faith in the supernatural, much deeper feelings. I mean, that happens. You call yourself what you want to call yourself. This is the land of the free. The album sold only 5, in its first year, just enough to break even. Wilson went on to produce the next three albums Dylan recorded. The song was widely recorded by other artists and became a hit for Peter, Paul and Mary. With veiled references to an impending apocalypse, the song gained more resonance when the Cuban Missile Crisis developed a few weeks after Dylan began performing it. George Harrison said of the album, "We just played it, just wore it out. The content of the song lyrics and just the attitude—it was incredibly original and wonderful. Novelist Joyce Carol Oates wrote: Most attempted a pop feel and rhythm, while Dylan and Baez performed them mostly as sparse folk songs. In contrast to the mostly solo acoustic performances on the album, the single showed a willingness to experiment with a rockabilly sound. Cameron Crowe described it as "a fascinating look at a folk artist with his mind wandering towards Elvis Presley and Sun Records ". I wanted to write a big song, some kind of theme song, with short concise verses that piled up on each other in a hypnotic way. The civil rights movement and the folk music movement were pretty close and allied together at that time. Rather than comply with censorship, Dylan refused to appear. His jeans and work shirts were replaced by a Carnaby Street wardrobe, sunglasses day or night, and pointed " Beatle boots ". A London reporter wrote: A loud shirt that would dim the neon lights of Leicester Square. He looks like an undernourished cockatoo. Appearing on the Les Crane television show and asked about a movie he planned, he told Crane it would be a cowboy horror movie. Asked if he played the cowboy, Dylan replied, "No, I play my mother. Tambourine Man " became one of his best-known songs when the Byrds recorded an electric version that reached number one in the US and UK. One version has it that the boos were from folk fans whom Dylan had alienated by appearing, unexpectedly, with an electric guitar. Murray Lerner, who filmed the performance, said: Only a completely non-critical audience, nourished on the watery pap of pop music, could have fallen for such tenth-rate drivel. In , it was chosen as the greatest song of all time by Rolling Stone magazine. At over six minutes, the song altered what a pop single could convey. On July 29, , Dylan crashed his cc Triumph Tiger motorcycle near his home in Woodstock, New York, and was thrown to the ground. Though the extent of his injuries was never disclosed, Dylan said that he broke several vertebrae in his neck. Truth was that I wanted to get out of the rat race. five-CD set titled *The Genuine Basement Tapes*, containing songs and alternative takes. In October and November, Dylan returned to Nashville. The song was later recorded by Jimi Hendrix, whose version Dylan acknowledged as definitive. Somehow he has managed to add an octave to his range. Rolling Stone writer Greil Marcus asked "What is this shit? For many, the single was a surprising return to protest material, mourning the killing of Black Panther George Jackson in San Quentin State Prison that year. A member of the Baldwin family, he is the oldest of the four Baldwin brothers, all actors. He has since played both leading and supporting roles in films such as the horror comedy fantasy film *Beetlejuice*, as Jack Ryan in the action thriller *The Hunt for Red October*, the romantic comedy *The Marrying Man*, the superhero film *The Shadow*, and two films directed by Martin Scorsese: Baldwin co-starred in *Mission: Impossible - Rogue Nation*, the fifth installment of the *Mission: Impossible* series, released on July 31, He is also a columnist for *The Huffington Post*. Since , he has been the host of *Match Game*. He has received worldwide attention and acclaim for his portrayal of President Donald Trump on the long-running sketch series *Saturday Night Live*, both during the U. He has three younger brothers, Daniel, William, and Stephen, who also became actors. He also has two sisters, Beth and Jane. Alec and his siblings were raised as Roman Catholics. Through his father, Baldwin is descended from Mayflower passenger John Howland, and through this line, is the 13th generation of his family born in North America and the 14th generation to live in North America. Baldwin attended Alfred G. This production closed after three months. Baldwin also received an Emmy nomination for the television version of the production, in which both he and Jessica Lange reprised their roles, alongside John Goodman and Diane Lane. Since season 3, Baldwin was credited as one of 30 *Rock* producers. He won again in In, he appeared in a series of commercials for Hulu that premiered during the Super Bowl broadcast. Baldwin co-hosted the 82nd Academy Awards with Steve Martin in He has hosted *Saturday Night Live* 17 times as of February 11, , and holds the record for most times hosting the show. Beginning in, Baldwin appeared in a television campaign for Capital One as their spokesperson. Following his confrontation with a videographer reported by TMZ see below, his contract was not renewed, and he was succeeded in the campaign by Jennifer Garner. He later hosted the second show on February 2, It was set to run on Friday at 10 p. On November 26, , the program was cancelled after only five episodes, due in part to a street tirade captured on video. Baldwin, who denied that he used the word "fag", later cited this incident as a major turning point in his public life. Film Baldwin made his film debut with a minor role in the film *Forever, Lulu*. In, he appeared in *Beetlejuice* and *Working Girl*. Later that year, he starred in *Prelude to a Kiss* with Meg Ryan, which was based on the Broadway play. Also, in, Baldwin made a foray into pulp fiction-based movies with the role of the title character in *The Shadow*. Baldwin shifted towards character acting, beginning with Pearl Harbor in *James Doolittle* in the film. The then-unreleased film became an asset in a federal bank fraud trial when investor Jed Barron was convicted of bank fraud while the movie was in production. In, the Yari Film Group announced that it would give the film, now titled *Shortcut to Happiness*, a theatrical release in the spring, and cable film network Starz! *Shortcut to Happiness* was finally released in Baldwin, displeased with the way the film had been cut in post-production, demanded that his directorial credit be changed to the pseudonym "Harry Kirkpatrick". He has recorded two nationally distributed public service radio announcements on behalf of the Save the Manatee Club. The first two episodes featured actor Michael Douglas and political consultant Ed Rollins. They married in and had a daughter, Ireland, in They separated in, and finalized a divorce in *A Journey Through Fatherhood and Divorce*. Baldwin contends that after their separation in December, his former wife, Kim Basinger, endeavored to deny him access to his daughter by refusing to discuss parenting, blocking visitation, not providing telephone

access, not following court orders, not dropping their daughter off for reasons of convenience, and directly lobbying the child. Baldwin called this parental alienation syndrome. He has faulted them more than Basinger, and writes, "In fact, I blame my ex-wife least of all for what has transpired. She is a person, like many of us, doing the best she can with what she has. She is a litigant, and therefore, one who walks into a courtroom and is never offered anything other than what is served there. Nothing off the menu, ever. Baldwin contended that after seven years of these issues, he hit a breaking point, and on April 11, , left an angry voicemail message in response to another unanswered arranged call, in which Baldwin called his daughter a "rude, thoughtless little pig". He contends that the tape was sold to TMZ which released the recording, despite laws against publishing media related to a minor without the permission of both parents. Baldwin admitted that he made a mistake, but asked not to be judged as a parent based on a bad moment. He later admitted to Playboy in June that he contemplated suicide over the voicemail that leaked to the public. Of the incident, he said, "I spoke to a lot of professionals, who helped me. Destroying me was their avowed goal. The couple became engaged in April and married on June 30, , at St. They have three children together, daughter Carmen born August 23, , son Rafael born June 17, , and son Leonardo Angel Charles, born in September The couple was returning from the hospital and were confronted by the photographer outside their Los Angeles home. Whoopi Goldberg praised Baldwin for his actions during her opening monologue while hosting the 68th Academy Awards. When instructed to put away the "electronic device" by the flight attendant, he reportedly became belligerent and was eventually removed from the plane. He later publicly apologized to the passengers who were delayed. A commercial for Capital One credit cards, for which Baldwin was a spokesperson, made a humorous reference to the event: In the commercial, Words With Friends co-creators Paul Bettner and David Bettner are on a plane, and are interrupted by a flight who loudly clears her throat to indicate to them to put their phones away. She was released without bail and told not to contact Baldwin. Prosecutors said she and Baldwin had met on a film set more than ten years earlier, and that, beginning in , she began sending him multiple unwanted emails and texts. In , Manhattan prosecutors filed nearly two dozen harassment and stalking charges against her, saying she had continued her unwanted advances. On April 8, she rejected a plea bargain, and a trial date was set for May On November 8, at the end of a non-jury trial, Manhattan Criminal Court Judge Robert Mandelbaum found Sabourin, by then 41, guilty on all counts and sentenced her to days in jail for stalking, attempted aggravated harassment, and harassment, plus 30 days for attempted contempt of court. Political views Baldwin is a Democrat and endorsed Barack Obama in his two presidential campaigns. He serves on the board of People for the American Way. He is an animal rights activist and a strong supporter of PETA, for which he has done work that includes narrating the video entitled Meet Your Meat. Baldwin also lent his support to the Save the Manatee Club by donating his time to record several public service announcements for the group, which had contacted him following his role in "The Bonfire of the Manatees", an episode of The Simpsons in which he was the voice of a biologist working to save the endangered mammals. Baldwin said in a interview with The New York Times that if he did become involved in electoral politics, he would prefer to run for Governor of New York. When asked if he was qualified for the office, Baldwin responded that he considered himself more qualified than California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger. However, on December 21, , Baldwin said he was abandoning plans to run for the office and would instead continue in his role on 30 Rock. During the 63rd Primetime Emmy Awards, Baldwin was slated to appear in a taped skit. However, the producers of the show cut a portion of the skit containing a reference to Rupert Murdoch and the News International phone hacking scandal. Baldwin subsequently boycotted the Emmy Awards and requested that his entire appearance be removed from the broadcast. Producers complied and he was replaced with Leonard Nimoy.

We will explore the history of the medium, from 19th century daguerreotypes and wet plate to digital imaging; the relationship between photography and American history, especially in relation to popular culture, social depiction, and war. We will be especially interested in photographic works that attempt to represent the essential nature of America and American life. In addition to considering how others have photographed American life, students will have the opportunity to make their own photographs. Any camera or cell phone with the capacity to take pictures will do for equipment. We will have an exhibit of this work on the final day of class. Berets and black turtlenecks may be worn. Friends may be invited. Some Possible Reading Selections: Assignments and Requirements Periodic short, page papers on readings and class discussions. Photographic essay, images and text, to be shared with class as a final assignment. Unfailing attendance and participation in seminar meetings. This course will concentrate on the Holocaust and its catastrophic effects on the two groups—Jews and Roma and Sinti—the Nazis specifically slated for extermination as part of Nazi racial ideology. Of the nine million Jews of Europe, about 6 million or about two-thirds perished at the hands of the Nazis. Of the approximately one million Roma and Sinti referred to pejoratively by others collectively as Gypsies living in Germany and lands occupied by the Nazis, about , or half were murdered. This course will explore the history and cultures of these groups, their status in Europe over hundreds of years, and the rise of racial arguments and understandings of race difference that culminated in the Holocaust. It will compare the fate of Jews, Roma, and Sinti to that of other Nazi victim groups as well as to other brands of race ideology prevalent in Europe and the United States. The goals of the course involve reconstructing the nature of European Jewish, Roma, and Sinti life, their relation to neighboring majority cultures, and the ways in which ideas of race spelled doom for them in the fateful decades of the s and s. Assignments and Grading Criteria: Required ungraded weekly journal entries on readings and class discussions. The grading scale is: Any average score below 60 would result in the assignment of an F. A mixture of readings supplied on Canvas in. It has been especially unusual in the role that psychotherapy and psychotherapeutic ideas have played in modern American spiritual quests.
