When to Make the Switch! April 16, On our Facebook group and on our Facebook page , we host a wide variety of questions but one that comes up a lot is: While each child and each situation is different, our minimum recommended age for booster seats is 5 years old. Wondering if your Little is ready to make this switch? There are a few things to consider in making this move. What is a Booster Seat? Britax Frontier 85 five point harness. If a child is wiggling out of position at the time of a crash, that leaves them vulnerable to serious injury. Let me tell you how this goes. For the first few minutes, maybe even a few weeks, things are going great. You think, gosh, my kid is so mature! And then, something shiny detracts his focus. What happens when immature kids try to ride in boosters! The right time to switch to a booster seat is different for every child. However, we draw a hard line on young children riding in booster seats. Despite the 3 year age minimum listed on some booster seats, there is not a 3 year old on the planet who is ready for the responsibility of sitting properly. Let their harnessed car seat do the work of keeping them in place. In our experience, the average child gains the maturity to sit properly in a booster seat somewhere between 5 and 7 years old. What about Height and Weight? Most booster seats have a lower weight threshold of 40 pounds, though some still have a 30 pound minimum weight. We advocate for waiting as long as possible to move a child to the next step in any child restraints. In this case, that means waiting until the child has outgrown their harnessed car seat before transitioning to a booster seat. For our Canadian neighbors, all booster seats have a 40 pound minimum weight. There is some concern that a smaller child may be able to submarine slide forward in the seat and slip out of the seat belt beneath the lap belt in a crash, however, currently available studies do not have conclusive information for this phenomenon. Not too long ago there were very few 5 point harnessed seats that could hold a child who weighs over 40 pounds. Check out our recommended seats list if you need help making a car seat selection! The key is the booster being properly used: NHTSA recommends utilizing a 5 point harness until the child outgrows it. High Back or Backless Booster? High back boosters also usually do a better job positioning the seat belt on smaller children than their backless counterparts. If your child likes to sleep in the car, a high back booster often makes it easier for a child to sleep comfortably without slumping out of position. When your child does move to a backless booster, be sure that they have a vehicle head restraint behind their head, at least up to the tips of their ears. To ride without a booster, a child needs to be able to pass the 5 Step Test: Sits all the way back against the vehicle seat. Knees bent at the edge of the vehicle seat and feet on the floor. Shoulder belt fits evenly across the collarbone and sits flush with the torso. Lap belt is low on the hips, touching the tops of the thighs. Can stay comfortably seated this way the entire ride. The Bottom Line Before moving to a booster seat, your child should: Be at least 5 years old. Have a safe belt fit. A WiFi repeater could be the solution for you. A WiFi repeater or extender is used to extend the coverage area of your WiFi network. It works by receiving your existing WiFi signal, amplifying it and then transmitting the boosted signal. With a WiFi repeater you can effectively double the coverage area of your WiFi network - reaching far corners of your home or office, different floors, or even extend coverage to your yard. WiFi boosters, repeaters, and extenders are mostly the same thing - devices to improve WiFi coverage. However, not all WiFi extenders work in the exact same way. There are several different kinds of devices available and below we aim to explain what those differences are and how they work, so that you can choose the best WiFi repeater for your circumstances. I have trouble getting WiFi signal in some corners of my house. What should I try first? There are a couple of solutions to try before opting for a WiFi extender. The simplest is to try moving the location of your WiFi router. It should be in the most central location possible. This technology allows the routers to concentrate the WiFi signal towards your WiFi devices. My WiFi is in the best location possible! My router is up-to-date! But my coverage is still unreliable! Okay, a WiFi extender could be the solution for you! There are a couple of different options. The kit allows you to send your internet signal over the electrical circuit in your home or office. It comes with 2 adapters; one plugs into a power socket near your current router, and the other in the location where you need signal. Connect the first one to your router using an ethernet cable, and connect the second to an ethernet device e. The second adapter could also be connected to a WiFi router for a second WiFi network. The great advantage to this solution is that it is fast. You plug and go. An extender that uses WiFi will usually see some speed loss. There are ways to get around this see below! By using the existing electrical circuit in your house, you create a link from your WiFi router to your device that is faster than WiFi and can be set up in just a few minutes. The distance between power outlets can have an impact on performance, and so can the kind of wiring you have in your house. A WiFi Repeater effectively contains two wireless routers, similar to the wireless router you already have in your home or office. One of these wireless routers picks up the existing WiFi network. It then transfers the signal to the other wireless router, which transmits the boosted signal. WiFi Repeaters are very easy to install. All you have to do is place the repeater in a location that can receive your existing WiFi network, and then attach the power supply. You can then log into the WiFi repeater via your computer, and input the login details and password of your existing WiFi network, to allow the WiFi repeater to connect and extend. Got a tricky situation like a pool house in your garden? This kit is very flexible and can be moved easily. For example, if you are RVing and the campsite has weak WiFi signal, this repeater can be fixed to the roof of your RV to boost the signal inside. Only if you go entirely out of range of the first network. A WiFi repeater creates a second network. If your first network is not available, your device will connect to the second. But in some parts of your house, your device will be able to detect both networks at the same time. This means that if you wish to change from the original network to the boosted network you will have to disconnect and then reconnect. Will the repeated network be secure? What about that speed loss we talked about earlier? All WiFi repeaters have some speed loss, but some are much worse than others. WiFi repeaters work by receiving wireless signal and rebroadcasting it, but single band repeaters have to receive, then retransmit each packet of data using the same radio on the same channel. Dual band repeaters get around this by connecting to the router on one band and outputting a WiFi signal on the other. One final feature that helps reduce speed loss is dual radios. If the device has dual radios, it can speak to the main router on lower channels, and then rebroadcast on higher channels. One Wi-Fi radio receives the signal and the other radio rebroadcasts the boosted signal. This clever design allows the boosted signal to utilize a different WiFi channel, which greatly increases performance compared to single radio repeaters. The Smart Repeater Pro also has a very powerful high gain antenna that can pick up even very weak WiFi signals, and it rebroadcasts that signal on two powerful 3dBi
