Harrow from the fixture of a harrow on the tavern sign board. The inn building dates from around , the first innkeeper was probably John Wilson, grandson of trader Ralph Wilson. Nicholas Buck, whose father arrived from Germany around , was a wheelwright by trade. He settled in Nockamixon in , purchasing 64 acres including the site of Bucksville. It became a thriving German community with a blacksmith shop and a large stone house, which today is a bed and breakfast known as the Bucksville House. Local history has it that the hotel was a speakeasy during Prohibition. He sold the inn to his brother John around , who replaced the log inn with a substantial stone structure. George had purchased acres in the area in . The original building burned in , was rebuilt with the store by William Rufe, destroyed by fire in . Jacob Black was the landlord at the time, and Harry Kiefer was the owner of the store. It was later rebuilt; the hotel being then known as the Hotel Paul Revere. Fire destroyed that building in and was not rebuilt. The present day Ferndale Inn building dates back to pre, as it was listed then as part of the Michael Meisser estate. Michael Meisser was a settler, and owned land on the hill above Ferndale prior to . The Center Hill Schoolhouse, now a private residence on Center Hill Road near the township building, was part of that tract. Jacob Froelich of Bethlehem was the first owner of land in the village. He purchased acres in from Thomas and Richard Penn. After serving in the Revolutionary War he entered the pottery business. He sold supplies to the Durham Iron Furnace until it blew up in , after which he left the area. His son Jacob moved back to Bucks County in . Jacob purchased the property where Kintnersville now sits from Jacob Froelich Jr. Kintnersville was the site of the first gas station in Upper Bucks County and the first telephone was installed in . The village of Kintnersville was named for the prominent German family of Kintner, a race of fighters and politicians. Although probably coming from the same province in Germany, the immigrant Kintners seem to have entered this country through different ports. The name was spelled several ways, commonly Gunter, Guntar, Gunther, and Gunther, changed by some of the family branches to Kintner after arrival in this country. The narrowsville Hotel was established in , and was a stagecoach stop on the Easton-Morrisville Line. It was also a stop for canal barges in the mid to late s, and had a blacksmith shop and stables alongside. The hotel, now known as the Indian Rock Inn, is sheltered at the base of the Palisades cliffs. The Palisades cliffs are home to rare species of alpine plants and have been studied by many eminent botanists.

When and where should I report? On the first day of your placement, report on time and to the location directed by the Student Intern Coordinator. The Student Intern Coordinator will establish an ongoing schedule introducing you to a variety of the day-to-day activities of the Probation Officer. The Student Intern Coordinator is responsible for providing an overview of the Department and its process. What will be my work hours? The normal workday is from 9: At times, the officer to whom you are assigned may work other than normal work hours. These changes may be unexpected, particularly in an emergency or crisis. The student must be flexible for it may not be feasible to transport the student back to the office or meeting location at the planned time. How should I dress? Projecting a professional image is essential. While in the office, males are expected to wear a coat and tie, while females should be neatly attired in a skirt and blouse, dress, or slacks. Extremes should be avoided. In the field, casual attire is permitted but should be neat, clean, and in good repair. Shorts are not appropriate for office or field. What should I do if I am sick or unable to report? If unable to contact the Officer, the student should contact the office. Failure to do this can result in a great deal of wasted time for an officer who is waiting for a student to appear before proceeding with scheduled activities. Should I have transportation available? All students accepted for placement should have transportation available because it may be necessary for the student to meet the officer at predetermined locations away from the office. The Student Intern Coordinator should be consulted regarding specific expectations in this regard. What about conducting research and studies while on placement? The Department welcomes the objective examination of its efforts and is continually trying to find ways to improve its operations. The student is asked to follow Departmental policy and procedure in doing projects. The Student Intern Coordinator should be consulted before the initiation of any research or study. The Department normally may assign a research project to a student during the internship. Such projects will be governed by the needs of the Department and capabilities of the student. While case files and other client-related records are available for review by the student, they are to be used only for educational purposes. The Department is bound by strict rules of confidentiality and no information, written or verbal, may leave the Department without the specific approval of the Mentor or Coordinator. Additionally, the student should not discuss specific cases and identifying data with anyone outside the Department, for such discussion could be damaging to the client. The Student Intern Coordinator and the Mentor will be responsible for completing all evaluations on your performance as required by your school. What if there are problems, complaints or grievances? If problems are encountered in a particular placement, which cannot be resolved with the Student Intern Coordinator, these matters should be brought to the attention of the Chief or Deputy Chief Probation Officer. A department or college inquiry shall not be necessary. The department reserves the right to terminate the placement as deemed necessary. At no time may the student inter refuse to do or complete assigned work without approval of the mentor or student intern coordinator.

Your adoption may have been facilitated through an intermediary agency. Home studies and background checks need to be completed. Whatever steps you have gone through, our office will do our best to help you complete the process, but please keep in mind that we are bound by the law and by confidentiality. We will not be able to assist you with all issues. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has developed forms for Foreign Adoptions and for requesting access to a closed file which we have posted here. Please contact the office with further questions. The types of adoptions include: Many of those cases are brought before the Judge for Audit by filing an accounting with the court to ensure all financial duties were properly met. An Audit date is assigned based on when the accounting was filed. All filings are presented to the Judge who will review the matter and issue the Adjudication of the Estate or set a hearing if needed to resolve any issues. A hearing date is assigned and citation issued. If Petition is granted a final decree is signed appointing a guardian by a Judge and is entered into court record. File Access - Please note that due to the sensitive nature of the information in the file, these records have been sealed and impounded by the court. Only an attorney of record, the guardian or the person themselves may access the file. Anyone else must submit a request for access. A hearing date is assigned. If the Petition is granted a final decree is signed and guardian is appointed by a Judge. The Bucks County Law Library have resources available if you have questions on these procedures. These include but are not limited to Petitions to Amend Birth Certificates, petitions regarding gestational carriers, or registering a Power of Attorney.
