Dangerous if you have a helper. Only dangerous in large vehicles. Use extra caution when backing up. You should slow down and move to the right lane. Stay in the right lane if you are driving more slowly than other traffic. Slower traffic must exit on the right. This sign means that drivers should allow the left lane to remain open, when possible, for passing and for faster traffic. Traffic lanes on one-way streets. Traffic moving in opposite directions on two-way roads. All carpool lanes from regular traffic lanes. A solid yellow centerline indicates that drivers may not cross the line to pass. A broken yellow centerline indicates that drivers may cross the line to pass, but only if passing would not interfere with traffic. Drivers must use their seat belt: Unless they are driving a vehicle built before Unless they are driving a limousine. And failure to do so will result in a traffic ticket. When passing on the left of a vehicle, it is safe to move back into the right lane: After about three seconds. When you can no longer see the vehicle over your right shoulder. When you can see the front of the vehicle in your rearview mirror. Always signal before changing lanes. You must stop at the intersection ahead. Just before the intersection, you have to cross railroad tracks. You should stop before crossing the railroad tracks when: The crossing is located in a city or town with frequent train traffic. You are transporting two or more children in a passenger vehicle. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

A broken yellow line next to your driving lane means that you may pass. You must notify the DMV within five days if you: Are cited for a traffic violation. Sell or transfer your vehicle. Paint your vehicle a different color. They must be notified of every title transfer. If a road is slippery, maintain a following distance that is: No different than normal. Farther from the car ahead than normal. Closer to the car ahead than normal. Maintain an increased following distance when driving on slippery roads. Animals may be transported in the back of a pickup truck only if: The sides of the truck bed are at least 18 inches high. They are properly secured. The tailgate of the truck is closed. Flash your brake lights or turn on your emergency flashers if you: Need to warn other drivers of a collision ahead. Are temporarily parked in a traffic lane to make delivery. Are backing out of a parking space. Allow extra space in front of your vehicle when following a: Motorcycles can stop more quickly than other vehicles can and you must have adequate room to stop if the motorcyclist brakes or falls off. Also, remember that motorcycles are difficult to see at night because they only have one tail light. When planning to pass another vehicle, you should: Not count on other drivers to make room for you. Assume the driver will let you pass if you use your turn signal. Assume the driver will maintain a constant speed. When you can see both headlights of the passed vehicle in your rearview mirror, you may have enough room to return to your driving lane. Often to see how traffic is moving behind you. To see if a vehicle is in your blind spot. Only when you are slowing down. Frequently check your rearview mirrors so you know the positions of vehicles near you.
