*Carn Brea is a civil parish and hilltop site in Cornwall, England, United Kingdom. The population of Carn Brea including Bosleake and Church Coombe was 8, at the census. The hilltop site is situated approximately one mile southwest of Redruth. The settlements of Bosleake, Brea, Broad Lane, Carn Arthen, Carn Brea Village, Carnkie, Four Lanes, Grillis, Illogan Highway, Pencoys, Penhallick, Piece, Pool, Tolskithy, Tregajorran, Treskillard, Tuckingmill and West Tolgus are in the parish.*

The Councillors work for the Parish in a voluntary capacity and are supported by a team of paid staff headed by the Parish Clerk. See Councillors for information about our Councillors. The Parish Council conducts its business through a committee system. The Full Council meets monthly on the third Thursday of the month. All meetings start at 7pm and the public are invited to attend. The Planning Committee meets monthly on the last Thursday of the month, again at 7pm and the public are invited to attend. All these meetings are general held on Thursdays and at 7pm. The public are invited to attend these meetings. Meetings do not take place during August, except for the Planning Committee. At most meetings the public are invited to attend and an opportunity is provided for Registered Electors of the Parish to speak on agenda items. There may be times in a meeting where the business is conducted in private with the public and press excluded. The public speaking part of a meeting is generally limited to 20 minutes. The remainder of a meeting is discussion by the Councillors only. Please refer to the Meetings, Agendas and Minutes webpage for a list of dates of meetings. Agendas are published usually three days before a meeting. The main source of income and funding for the Parish Council is derived from the Council Precept. This is a charge levied with the Council Tax. Council Tax is charged and kept by Cornwall Council. The Council owns approximately 22 acres of land. It is open to the public Monday to Friday from 9am to 12 noon. The Hall is available for use for private bookings made via the Council Office.
