Levan; and I presented an example of some of my favorite paragraphs of the Writings that I formatted into poetry myself. The Meaning of Miracles I. Principles of Miracles 1 There is no order of difficulty in miracles. One is not "harder" or "bigger" than another. They are all the same. All expressions of love are maximal. The only thing that matters is their Source, which is far beyond evaluation. The real miracle is the love that inspires them. In this sense everything that comes from love is a miracle. His Voice will direct you very specifically. You will be told all you need to know. They should not be under conscious control. Consciously selected miracles can be misguided. When they do not occur something has gone wrong. Like all expressions of love, which are always miraculous in the true sense, the exchange reverses the physical laws. They bring more love both to the giver and the receiver. It is a means of communication of the created with the Creator. Through prayer love is received, and through miracles love is expressed. Thoughts can represent the lower or bodily level of experience, or the higher or spiritual level of experience. One makes the physical, and the other creates the spiritual. They are always affirmations of rebirth, which seem to go back but really go forward. They undo the past in the present, and thus release the future. They are convincing because they arise from conviction. Without conviction they deteriorate into magic, which is mindless and therefore destructive; or rather, the uncreative use of mind. The purpose of time is to enable you to learn how to use time constructively. It is thus a teaching device and a means to an end. Time will cease when it is no longer useful in facilitating learning. They simultaneously increase the strength of the giver and supply strength to the receiver. They are sudden shifts into invisibility, away from the bodily level. That is why they heal. It is the maximal service you can render to another. It is a way of loving your neighbor as yourself. They depend on cooperation, because the Sonship is the sum of all that God created. Miracles therefore reflect the laws of eternity, not of time. This is the recognition that leads to the healing power of the miracle. You believe that what your physical eyes cannot see does not exist. This leads to a denial of spiritual sight. This is healing because sickness comes from confusing the levels. You are a miracle, capable of creating in the likeness of your Creator. Everything else is your own nightmare, and does not exist. Only the creations of light are real. Atonement works all the time and in all the dimensions of time. It is the privilege of the forgiven to forgive. Revelation induces a state in which fear has already been abolished. Miracles are thus a means and revelation is an end. They praise Him by honoring His creations, affirming their perfection. They heal because they deny body-identification and affirm spirit-identification. This places spirit at the center, where it can communicate directly. You should thank God for what you really are. The children of God are holy and the miracle honors their holiness, which can be hidden but never lost. They intercede for your holiness and make your perceptions holy. By placing you beyond the physical laws they raise you into the sphere of celestial order. In this order you are perfect. They dispel illusions about yourself and perceive the light in you. They thus atone for your errors by freeing you from your nightmares. By releasing your mind from the imprisonment of your illusions, they restore your sanity. By atoning for lack they establish perfect protection. It acts as a catalyst, breaking up erroneous perception and reorganising it properly. This places you under the Atonement principle, where perception is healed. Until this has occurred, knowledge of the Divine Order is impossible. He separates the true from the false by His ability to perceive totally rather than selectively. This is the same as saying that by perceiving light, darkness automatically disappears. It is a way of perceiving the universal mark of God. They thus correct, or atone for, the faulty perception of lack. It may touch many people you have not even met, and produce undreamed of changes in situations of which you are not even aware. Miracles do not involve this type of communication, because they are temporary communication devices. When you return to your original form of communication with God by direct revelation, the need for miracles is over. It establishes an out-of-pattern time interval not under the usual laws of time. In this sense it is timeless. Only revelation

transcends it, having nothing to do with time at all. It is a device for perception correction, effective quite apart from either the degree or the direction of the error. This is its true indiscriminateness.

I was so captivated that I started coming every few days to Beis Chayeinu to see the king. I had not received a Torah-based education, and I was repelled by the whole concept. I told this bachur that I appreciated his desire to help, but the Lubavitcher Rebbe was not for me. Yet, I felt somehow that there might be something to all this, so I decided to give myself a sign. If I met these three young men again, then this was apparently no coincidence but a clear sign from Heaven. I felt as if the entire room was illuminated with a brilliant light, the likes of which I had never seen before. The Rebbe gave me a bracha while speaking in Hebrew with a heavy Yiddish accent. No more than a day or two passed without my coming to Beis Chayeinu, and I was always thrilled when I saw the Rebbe. Naturally, I became stronger each day in my fulfillment of Torah and mitzvos. I became acquainted with some fine Jewish families, who hosted me for Shabbos and Yom Tov, and I learned a great deal from them. I began wearing a yarmulke. This was soon followed by a pair of tzitzis and a beard. I had tried my luck in finding a suitable match, but none of the proposed shidduchim materialized, and I was still single. Earth Sun If we consider the Earth as the size of a marble, and the distance between it and the Sun as meters feet , then the star Alpha Centauri should be placed 78, kilometers 48, miles away! The Milky Way itself covers a relatively minute area within the universe, when we consider there are approximately billion other such galaxies besides it, and that the distances between them are millions of times greater than between our Sun and Alpha Centauri. The diffusion of heavenly objects throughout the universe and the spaces between them are necessary conditions for life on Earth. The distances between stars are arranged by cosmic forces in such a way as to make possible life on Earth. Had they been any farther, the distribution of heavier elements, shooting into space from supernovas, would have never reached the density required to form planets like our solid Earth. The existing distances between stars are just right to permit the existence of solar systems like ours. The distances between supernovae and indeed between all stars is critical for other reasons. The distance between stars in our galaxy is about 30 million miles. If this distance was much less, planetary orbits would be destabilized. If it was much more, then the debris thrown out by a supernova would be so diffusely distributed that planetary systems like our own would in all probability never form. If the cosmos is to be a home for life, then the flickering of the supernovae must occur at a very precise rate and the average distance between them, and indeed between all stars, must be very close to the actual observed figure. Had the stars been somewhat closer, astrophysics would not have been so very different. The fundamental physical processes occurring within stars, nebulas, and the like would have proceeded unchanged. The appearance of our galaxy as seen from some fardistant vantage point would have been the same. About the only difference would have been the view of the night time sky from 27 A Chain of Miracles In the vast depths of space, our Earth occupies no more room than a grain of sand on a beach. The universe is too large for human minds to comprehend. And oh, yes-one more small change: There would have been no me to do the viewing! All that waster space! On the other hand, in this very waste lies our safety. In short, the distribution of stars in the universe is exactly as they must be for human existence on Earth. The vast empty 28 Miracles in the Creation of the Universe Bodies in space have been created at the ideal distances from one another. In our galaxy, the slightest increase or reduction in the average distances between heavenly bodies would mean that no planet would exist that is suitable for life. We did not create the heavens and Earth and everything between them, except with truth. The Hour is certainly coming, so turn away graciously. We did not create them except with truth but most of them do not know it. If there were no such reactions, there would not be carbon or any other elements in the universe and therefore, no life. Carbon atoms are produced in the core of huge stars by a two-tier process. First, two helium atoms fuse to produce a transitional element with four protons and four neutrons called beryllium. When a third helium atom fuses with beryllium, they produce a carbon atom with six protons and neutrons. The beryllium atom produced in the first stage of this process is different from the beryllium atoms found on Earth, since the element beryllium listed in our periodic table boasts one additional neutron. The unusual beryllium isotope found in red giants has long puzzled scientists, since it is extremely unstable, so much so that it disintegrates 0. So how can this beryllium isotope become carbon, if it is effectively destroyed in the same instant it is formed? Do the helium atoms that fuse with the beryllium isotope do so by chance? Most certainly not, as this is more improbable than two bricks blown apart within the space of 0. Paul Davies describes this miraculous process as follows: While investigating the nuclear reactions that lead to the formation of carbon in the stellar cores, [Fred] Hoyle was struck by the 30 Miracles in the Creation of the Universe fact that the key reaction proceeds only because of a lucky fluke. Carbon nuclei are made by a rather tricky process involving the simultaneous encounter of three high-speed helium nuclei, which then stick together. By good fortune, one of these resonances is positioned just about right to correspond to the sort of energies that helium nuclei have inside large stars. Inside red giants another miracle called double-resonance takes place. First, two helium atoms fuse to create beryllium, then within the space of 0. George Greenstein

explains why this double-resonance process is so extraordinary: There are three quite separate structures in this story—helium, beryllium, and carbon—and two quite separate resonances. It is hard to see why these nuclei should work together so smoothly! Other nuclear reactions do not proceed by such a remarkable chain of lucky breaks! It is like discovering deep and complex resonances between a car, a bicycle, and a truck. Why should such disparate structures mesh together so perfectly? Upon this our ex-

31 A Chain of Miracles Nuclear reactions that form carbon atoms take place in the heart of giant stars. As a result of these stars exploding as novae, masses of carbon and other elements were hurled into space, subsequently reaching other stars and planets, of which our Earth is one. The miraculous thing, however, is how the beryllium atom, which normally decomposes in as little as 0. Exactly because this is an impossibly unlikely thing to happen by chance, Greenstein makes the analogy of a very complex and crucial resonance between a car, a bicycle and a truck. He fails to call this a miracle because of his materialist credentials. Further, some other elements like oxygen were formed by such extraordinary processes of resonance. Fred Hoyle discovered these extraordinary processes, and in his book *Galaxies, Nuclei and Quasars*, he concluded that such precisely structured processes could not have arisen through the work of coincidences. Despite being a sworn materialist, he conceded that such double resonances had to be the result of design. If you wanted to produce carbon and oxygen in roughly equal quantities by stellar nucleosynthesis, these are the two levels you would have to fix, and your fixing would have to be just about where these levels are actually found to be! A commonsense interpretation of the facts suggests that a super intellect has monkeyed with physics, as well as chemistry and biology, and that there are no blind forces worth speaking about in nature. The numbers one calculates from the facts seem to me so overwhelming as to put this conclusion almost beyond question. I do not believe that any scientist who examined the evidence would fail to draw the inference that the laws of nuclear physics have been deliberately designed with regard to the consequences they produce inside the stars. The organic molecules composing the bodies of living things—proteins, fats and carbohydrates—are all formed from different carbon compounds. The atoms of carbon in your body as you read this book are actually leftovers from a supernova explosion, billions of years ago in the depths of space. The values of each of the four have been fine-tuned to perfection for the universe as we know it to exist, and for human life. Newton declared that this force was responsible not only for apples falling to the ground but also that this mysterious force kept the stars in their orbits. Einstein introduced a new and deeper perspective to this phenomenon, theorizing about how it forced huge stars to collapse and turn into One of the most important forces that affect the order of the universe is gravity. Newton declared this was an extraordinary force that not only caused apples to fall from trees, but also served to maintain the planets in their orbits. Gravity also controls the expansion rate of the universe. The force of gravity has a constant mathematical value that enabled the formation of the universe we live in. Had this constant been a fraction greater than it is, the formation of stars in the universe would have accelerated to the point that where even the smallest stars would have reached a mass 1. They would have then burned up so quickly and unpredictably that the necessary conditions for life on any planets orbiting them could not have developed. Life depends on stars as small as our own Sun. Had the constant of gravity been a little greater than its current value, all stars of the universe would have already collapsed into black holes. Furthermore, gravitational forces acting on even the smallest planets would have been so great that no life forms larger than insects could have survived. At the other extreme, had the force of gravity been a fraction weaker, the largest stars in the universe could never have exceeded 0. These smaller stars would have burned long enough and been stable enough to support life on the planets orbiting them, but the heavy elements essential for the formation of planets and life could never have emerged in the first place. Iron and the other heavier elements can be created only in the cores of huge stars. Only stars of huge mass can produce and scatter beryllium—and other elements, necessary for the formation of planets and life—into interstellar space. As you can see, even very small fluctuations in gravitational forces would have prevented the formation of life—and therefore, humans. Fluctuation of a slightly higher magnitude in 37 A Chain of Miracles Were the force of gravity any weaker, our Earth would escape the gravitational pull of the Sun and drift off into space. Were it just a little stronger, we would plunge into the Sun and be destroyed. Obviously, since we do exist on Earth, none of these negative possibilities has taken place. Every detail of the universe has been designed and

created according to a flawless plan, and in perfect order. Almighty God has created the universe we live in a series of extraordinary miracles and in unequalled harmony: He Who created the seven heavens in layers. You will not find any flaw in the creation of the All-Merciful. Look again—do you see any gaps? Then look again and again. Your sight will return to you dazzled and exhausted! Electromagnetic Forces As we all know, all living and non-living things are formed of the building blocks called atoms, which in turn are composed of protons and neutrons in their nuclei, and electrons that orbit the nucleus at high speed. For instance, an atom with only one proton is hydrogen; an atom with two is helium, and one with 26 protons is called iron. The same is true for all other elements. The protons in the atomic nucleus have a positive electrical charge, whereas the electrons orbiting it have a negative charge. Electromagnetic force joins together the protons and electrons in the atom. As a result, molecules essential to life could never form. This opposing electrical charge creates an attraction between protons and electrons, keeping the electrons in their orbit around the nucleus. The force that binds the protons and electrons of opposing electrical charge is called the electromagnetic force. Had the value of the electromagnetic force been a fraction smaller, fewer electrons could have been retained in orbit around atomic nuclei. Had it been slightly greater, no atom could bond with any other. Either way, the molecules necessary for life could never have been assembled. As already mentioned, protons are particles with a positive electrical charge. According to the laws of electromagnetism, particles of opposing electrical charge attract one another, and those of the same charge repel each other. In other words, protons and electrons attract one another, while protons repel other protons—and electrons repel other electrons. In the nuclei of many larger atoms, tens of protons are found clustered together. Under normal circumstances, any protons brought together should have repelled one another into space with great force. Protons stay clustered together with great consistency, because an even greater force acts on them than of electromagnetism, which would have them repel one another.

Being tethered to her home via an electrical cord when the batteries are not in use is bad enough. Then there are the life-altering changes that come from the pump and batteries – the momentous life-style changes most people take for granted – like the ability to take a bath or just hop in the shower. For Kyla, taking a shower is a process requiring lots of prep time to prevent the hole in her rib cage where the wires enter her body from becoming infected. But beyond that, being unable to be the mother she wants to be to her three children is almost unbearable. As it was that birth was in itself a miracle. It all began innocuous enough with Kyla finding herself completely out of breath just trying to carry on a conversation. Then there was her size. Kyla, a petite woman had swollen to huge proportions. Doctors and Davis family members alike wrote it off as the fact that Reagan was such a large baby – two pounds heavier at birth than either of the other children. It did not feel like normal labor. Not just one, but multiple miracles had to happen for the family to be together this holiday season and for that the family is truly thankful. As the heart fails fluid builds up in the body, usually beginning in the feet. With Kyla, her body moved that fluid to her uterus and encased her unborn son in more fluid than normal. It was still a difficult birth for Kyla and it sapped much of her strength. She went home a few days after the birth and instead of recovering things began to get worse. Walking would cause me to hurt. I could hear a crackling in my ears and I was nauseous all the time. For weeks one doctor after another wrote off the symptoms as post-partum anxiety as Kyla suffered what seemed like anxiety attacks but were instead moments of her heart going into arrest trying to keep the blood flowing to her organs. Finally, came a Friday and a third doctor who ordered a new battery of blood tests. She was so weak she had to be wheeled over in a wheelchair. What came next pushed the boundaries of survival as Kyla sat in the hospital for 24 hours while doctors tried to determine the cause of her symptoms. Doctors finally ordered a BNP brain natriuretic peptide blood test that measures the levels of a certain protein produced by the brain that can indicate heart failure is happening. By chance or by way of another miracle, there just happened to be traveling cardiologist at the hospital that day, a retired doctor from Pennsylvania who had seen PPCM before. Kyle was immediately flown to UMC hospital in Lubbock. There were talks of installing the LVAD unit in her chest immediately because her heart was already down to 10 percent function. However, her low platelet levels and the insurance company stepped in the way. It was frustrating and frightening. Kyla hovered on the edge of death and began a slow recovery, but the road was longer than they could imagine. It meant a major life change and it was as scary as the heart condition itself in its own way. The LVAD, a pump that bypasses the left ventricle of the heart, allows the heart to rest and serves as the heart. Doctors eventually installed the LVAD and then began weeks of training for the couple on how to live with the device as they waited for Kyla to improve enough to go home. Separated from her children and her newborn, Kyla reached a point where it was breaking her sanity and her faith. Her family was huge supporters but so was her church and they gave her the support to keep fighting. But in the darkest hours faith and friendship seem to fade to a flicker when the darkness closes in. It was in those moments that Kyla found a message from on high delivered to her by one of the male nurses caring for her in the hospital. It is very much trial and error. Because what you are going through is real. It is not fair. For Kyla those words were an epiphany. It was then she began to see the LVAD in a new light. They were her saviors. I have had to learn to feel OK about looking different, about living a different life. It is OK to be emotional to have a bad day. But you find a way to find the good. You find a way to see the small victories. Find a way to keep moving forward. The big thing that has helped me is learning to process it and pour back out and make good come from it. Hope that it is going to get better. Hope that I am going to use this for the good. Hope that I am going to help other people. Hope that I am going to get to see my kids grow up and hope for a good life. We know it is going to be a different life, but we hope we can make it a good life.

A gifted nineteen-year old rabbinical student at the famed Slobodka Yeshiva at the time of the German invasion of Lithuania, young Meyer Juzint and his fellow students, following the advice of their rosh yeshiva, fled when news of the proximity of the invading German armies made it dangerous for them to stay behind. Guiding his hand for four interminable years, The Almighty provided Meyer with bits and pieces of discarded paper on which to record the miracle of his survival in what we now call "real time". Rabbi Juzint was both witness and victim of the ghastly determination with which the Nazis and their Lithuanian collaborators afflicted him along with hundreds of other terrorized, homeless Jews caught between the deadly danger of returning to Nazi-occupied Slobodka and the countryside controlled by armed and alcohol-crazed Jew-hating Lithuanian partisans. His short chapters are exceedingly powerful accounts of mankind at its worst and best. How could the land which bore so many cultural giants in the Age of Enlightenment become a nation of murderers abetted by their silent accomplices? It seems to be, even now some sixty-seven years after the end of World War II, an unanswerable question, a real conundrum. However, one can answer it satisfactorily but by first acknowledging that nearly every human being is capable of such gratuitous violence and murder. Whether children including infants, the elderly and sick, women and men makes little or no difference. His candor stunned me. Did the Nazis behave inhumanly? No, they did not. Did they behave inhumanely as an expression of their free will? Yes, but only to someone whose moral code derives from knowledge of right and wrong or has been exposed to such teachings in his earlier years. Additionally, their innate sense of right and wrong had been erased by SS training for which heavy alcohol consumption served as both quieter and enabler. Although sadistic cruelty terrorizes victims into a state of frozen passivity, it cannot but have a psychological effect upon the perpetrator as well. Rabbi Juzint arrived in Chicago after the war. Over the course of the next fifty years, he devoted himself to thousands of Chicago area students at the Hebrew Theological College and Ida Crown Jewish Academy as their beloved rebbe and spiritual mentor. Spared an ignominious death innumerable times by the kindness of the Almighty and steeled in the fiery furnace of "Hitlerite" murder, Meyer Juzint survived a reign of terror which in its breadth and depth far exceeded the mayhem and murder of the Chliemnicki pogroms of Kesser Maariv Press has done the world of primary source Holocaust literature an invaluable service by providing readers with this sturdy, hard-bound edition.
