

## 1: Charles Camilleri - M3P

*Charles Camilleri (7 September - 3 January ) was a Maltese composer.. Camilleri was born in Ā'amrun and, as a teenager, composed a number of works based on folk music and legends of his native Malta.*

At the age of eighteen, he abandoned a career in law for that of music. He had already, at only fourteen, experienced the fact that some of his marches played at local feasts. Two years later, in Australia he realised his ambition of being totally devoted to music, first as a student and later as a teacher. He subsequently visited Japan, Hong Kong and Korea. He moved from his early influences by Maltese folk music to a musical form "in which nothing is fixed and his compositions evolve from themselves with a sense of fluency and inevitability". He composed over works for orchestra, chamber ensemble, voice and solo instruments. These utilised both direct quotation and parody of ethnic music from the hinterland of the African continent, namely Congo, Chad and Ethiopia. The Malta Suite was written when he was only fifteen years old, while holidaying in Gozo. This suite was featured in the album Malta: After majoring in composition at the University of Toronto in Canada, he returned to Europe. Camilleri is recognized as one of the major composers of his generation. His piano piece Cantilena, is currently part of the Grade 5 Trinity Guildhall piano syllabus. Writing in July to Turkish producer Ates Orga, then a member of the BBC Music Division, Camilleri expressed that at its best moments, music, for me, is a means to understand the complexity of man and the simplicity of God. Music is a way to reach the Supreme Being. Commenting on the event, music critic Albert G. Storaice lauded that the blending of folk musical themes emphasized its Melitensian nature. Straight-forward, uncomplicated music be it for solo voices, chorus or both combined, complementary to the text and deeply evocative in parts where climatic points in the story are reached. The publication focused on the different models of Maltese folksinging and a brief introduction to Maltese nursery rhymes, street cries and traditional folk instruments. Christopher Palmer had, in written a critical biography of the composer, through The music of Charles Camilleri: Camilleri died on 3 January at the age of His funeral took place two days later at Naxxar, his long-time town of residence. Flags across Malta were flown at half-mast in a national tribute to him.
