Beschreibung bei Amazon Stuart Pawson is a well known British novelist famous for writing his novels based on the mystery genre. He is particularly famous for doing the characterization of the main protagonist of the Charlie Priest series, Detective Inspector Charlie Priest. Stuart used to work as an electrical engineer in a coal mine before becoming an author. His stint as a part time officer for probation service allowed him to gain knowledge about the criminal justice system. This helped him to set the criminal plots of his novels. Stuart began to write his first thriller and mystery book around that time, having only little knowledge about the proceedings of the system. Stuart Pawson maintains a strong affinity towards the American West because of which he believes that he must have some cowboy genes in his body. He first visited the United States of America to work for at the Wyoming coal mine for about a month and since then he has visited America on a number of holiday vacations. Apart from writing novels, Stuart was also interested in song writing, although he did not have any knowledge about the tones. However, Stuart managed to write two theme songs and enjoyed very much while writing them. When not busy in writing novels, he often likes to give motivating speeches to various library groups. He enjoys the sessions very much whenever he gets a chance to do such tasks. The character description of D. Charlie Priest as is given by Stuart Pawson is as follows: Considering the fact that he cannot afford the condensed milk from the supermarket on account of his limited salary, Charlie likes to eat his peanut butter sandwiches and banana with honey. He is humorous in nature and shows great determination in solving the cases that he is asked to deal with. He shows compassion for the victims and does not have much belief in humanity. When he was appointed as an inspector, he was the youngest of all and went on to be the longest serving inspector. Charlie holds a degree in Art. He does not believe in the idea of getting a promotion by making his senior official happy and likes to work in his own style. The fact that he produces results by taking risks is the only reason that his senior officials tolerate his bohemian behavior and indiscipline. Charlie is depicted as a divorcee in the series, although he manages to have a series of relationships with a number of girlfriends. He likes to work for long hours and cooks his own meal.
