You will be evaluated on your presentations when you primarily see patients, including use of dermatologic descriptors and documentation; this primarily occurs on the consult service. Going through each chapter organized by themes in conjunction with didactics has helped a lot. Each chapter is structured the same, with an intro, history, epidemiology, pathophysiology, clinical features, dermatopathology, and treatment. It still takes me a while to get through each chapter but now that I have a foundation from 1st year, reading this text has become much easier. It is structured in more of a free-form kind of way, without major subdivisions inside of the chapters. I personally find it a little harder to follow, but some of my colleagues swear by it. Marghoob is a great way to learn the basics of dermoscopy.
