Back to top Lincoln County Courthouse and Government Records Genealogist typically overlook the significance of Lincoln County court, probate, and land files as a resource of genealogical information and facts. Buried away in Maine courthouses and archives everywhere tend to be the dreams and frustrations of many Maine inhabitants. The odds are great that your chosen forefathers have left a in-depth document of at least a number of facets of their lives in the Lincoln County court records. Even if your ancestors is not discussed in a Court case, take into account all of the other procedures that could have lead to him or her appearing in court records. The records are readily available to interested parties, barring private issues. The years pointed out below are the first known records with this county. Deeds, mortgages, tax liens, water liens, declaration of homestead and many other kinds of documents regarding the title and ownership of real estate are noted permanently in official records. All of these terms fit the description of the Probate Court. The Probate Court carries out the following procedures: Clerks respond to inquiries regarding vital records, since most have indexes available. Some of the Clerks records have been transfered to the Maine State Archives. Maine Office of Vital Records has copies of birth, marriage, divorce and death records. There is a fee for each copy requested. Please refer to the information to the Statewide Vital Records in Maine for current fees and application process. Birth, marriage, and death records are connected with central life events. Most of these genealogy links fall into 3 categories: Some have free access some require a fee. This is just a list that has been collected or submitted. I do not endorse or promote one genealogy site above another.
