And lead us not into temptation, But deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. O ALMIGHTY God, creator of mankind, who only art the well-spring of life; Bestow upon these thy servants, if it be thy will, the gift and heritage of children; and grant that they may see their children brought up in thy faith and fear, to the honour and glory of thy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. O GOD, who hast so consecrated the state of Matrimony that in it is represented the spiritual marriage and unity betwixt Christ and his Church; Look mercifully upon these thy servants, that they may love, honour, and cherish each other, and so live together in faithfulness and patience, in wisdom and true godliness, that their home may be a haven of blessing and of peace; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord, who liveth and reigneth with thee and the Holy Spirit ever, one God, world without end. GOD the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Ghost, bless, preserve, and keep you; the Lord mercifully with his favour look upon you, and fill you with all spiritual benediction and grace; that ye may so live together in this life, that in the world to come ye may have life everlasting. The foster Parents shall stand before him, with two Witnesses, one of whom shall hold the Child to be adopted. All shall stand throughout the Service. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. OUR Father, by whose Name All fatherhood is known, Who dost in love proclaim Each family thine own, Bless thou all parents, guarding well, With constant love as sentinel, The homes in which thy people dwell. O Christ, thyself a child Within an earthly home, Thou didst to manhood come; Our children bless, in every place, That they may all behold thy face, And knowing thee may grow in grace. O Spirit, who dost bind Our hearts in unity, Who teachest us to find The love from self set free, In all our hearts such love increase, That every home, by this release, May be the dwelling place of peace. LET the righteous be glad and rejoice before God; Let them also be merry and joyful. He is the Father of the fatherless, and defendeth the cause of the widows; Even God in his holy habitation. He setteth the solitary in families; The Congregation shall dwell therein. Praised be the Lord daily, Even the God that helpeth us, and poureth his benefits upon us. Thy God hath sent forth strength in thee; Stablish the thing, O God, that thou hast wrought in us. Glory be to thee, O Lord. Will you love, honour, and help your Father and Mother? Thou wilt be a Father unto us; And we shall be thy sons and daughters. The Lord be with you; And with thy spirit. O GOD our Father, who makest us thy children by adoption and grace; Give thy blessing, we humbly beseech thee, to this family, who have now bound themselves one to another in thee, that dwelling together in holiness, they may be made perfect in love; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honour and glory, world without

end. MAY God the Father, who hath adopted you as his children, grant you his grace; May God the Son, who dwelt in the home of Nazareth, fill you with his love; May God the Holy Ghost, who hath united you in one family, keep you in his peace; And may the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, be with you, and remain with you always. Touching the duty of women set apart to this office and ministry, the Canons of the Church affirm that it is to assist the Ministry in the care of the poor and sick, in the religious training of the young and others, and in the work of moral reformation. That they may be duly appointed to such service, have these women come hither. Nevertheless, if there be any who can allege aught on account of which it is inexpedient that these persons be so set apart, let protest be now made openly and before all men. O BE joyful in the Lord, all ye lands: As the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters; And as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; Even so our eyes wait upon thee, O Lord; Until thou have mercy upon us. O Lord, have mercy upon us. Have mercy upon us. O Lord, let thy mercy lighten upon us; As our trust is in thee. Protect them in the way wherein they go, and grant that in singleness of purpose and with a willing mind they may worthily accomplish the task committed to them, to thy glory and to the praise of thy Christ, to whom with thee, O Father, and thee, O Holy Ghost, be glory and worship for ever and ever. I have so considered it, and will do so, by the help of God. Will you be obedient to those who are over you in the Lord, cheerfully and faithfully performing the service that shall be appointed to you? I will, by the help of God. Inasmuch as this office is not to be lightly undertaken, is it your desire to give yourself to the work of the Lord as a Deaconess in singleness of heart? I desire to do so, by the help of God. O GOD, who didst teach the hearts of thy faithful people, by sending to them the light of thy Holy Spirit; Grant unto this thy servant by the same Spirit to perceive and know what things she ought to do, and to have grace and strength evermore to do the same; direct her in all times of doubt and perplexity; strengthen her to bear the trial of her faith and patience; comfort her in times of sorrow; cheer her when faint and weary in the way. May thy love, abounding towards her more and more, stir up her heart to greater deeds of love to thee, and to all who need her service. Make them to know and feel their oneness in the mystical Body of thy dear Son, so that their fellowship here in works of love may prove to them a blessed discipline, and thus prepare them at last for the society of thy redeemed in heaven; through Jesus Christ our most blessed Lord and Saviour. O GOD, who in thy holy Word dost commend above all goodly apparel the ornament of a quiet spirit; Adorn, we beseech thee, these thy servants with the meekness and the gentleness of Christ, that in all humility and singleness of heart they may run the way of thy Commandments; through Jesus Christ our Lord. THE God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through our Lord Jesus Christ. The Warden shall close the Door, and wait inside to open it. The Bishop, standing outside with his attendants, shall knock on the Door three times, saying, OPEN me the gates of righteousness, that I may go into them, and give thanks unto the Lord. As he enters trumpets may be sounded or bells may be rung. Then he shall make his Petition,, as follows. But that all men may know that we do act according to the Canons of the Church, we require that the Certificate of Election be read in your presence, and in the presence of this Congregation. After which the Warden shall conduct the Bishop to the Chancel Gate. Meanwhile a Hymn may be sung. Meanwhile the Cantor shall say responsively with the People the following Antiphon and Psalm. He shall feed me in a green pasture; And lead me forth beside the waters of comfort. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff comfort me. Thou shalt prepare a table before me in the presence of them that trouble me; Thou hast anointed my head with oil, and my cup shall be full. Surely thy loving-kindness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever. Hear the words of the Apostle Peter The Lesson. And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away. Meanwhile the following Anthem may be sung or said. Nought remains but to thank God upon the occasion, and to petition the Divine Majesty: O Lord, save thy servant; Who putteth his trust in thee. Send him help from thy holy place; And evermore mightily defend him. Be unto him a strong tower; From the face of the enemy. Lord, hear our prayer; And let our cry come unto thee. O GOD, great in power, unsearchable in understanding, wondrous in counsels towards the children of men; Do thou fill with the gift of the Holy Spirit him whom thou hast willed to undertake this Ministry; that he may be worthy to stand before thy holy Altar unblameably, to announce the Gospel of thy

Kingdom, to administer the Word of thy truth, to offer gifts and spiritual sacrifices unto thee, and to renew thy people in the font of Regeneration; that, at the second coming of thine only-begotten Son, he may go forth to meet him, and by the multitude of thy mercies receive his reward; through the same thy Son Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honour and glory, world without end. May the people honour thee. May God be thy Father, and the Angels of God protect thee. May the Church be thy Mother, and the Apostles thine examples. The Lord confirm and strengthen thee in righteousness and true holiness. And may the Blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, come down upon thee from above and remain with thee always. O LORD, attend our supplications; and graciously hearken unto me, who am the first to need thy mercy; and as thou hast made me the Minister of this work, not by choosing me on account of merit, but by the gift of thy grace, so give me confidence to perform thine office; and do thou thyself, by our ministration, fulfil the purpose of thine own loving-kindness; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Otherwise, the Bishop, standing, shall say the following. O LORD, we beseech thee, graciously to cast thy light upon thy Church; that thy flock may everywhere go on and prosper, and its pastors, by thy governance, may become acceptable to thy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom, with thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honour and glory, world without end.
