The woman found her peace in Jesus. I was astounded and a little jealous. How would you respond if you heard of three Japanese conversions in the space of a month, and one of the converts the evangelist barely knew? I listened skeptically until about the eighth week. Then, a seeker came to our church wanting to know how to forgive her parents. EE had taught me to respond to spiritual need with personal testimony, which I did, and this led to a presentation of the gospel. This happened with two other friends in the next month. I was stunned and then sold. James Kennedy of Florida in Through it, his church exploded from 17 to 10,, making it the largest in America at the time. The approach has been used to lead millions to Christ all over the world. Until recently, however, EE had failed in Japan. In the s, a group of Japanese pastors took the EE training in Florida and returned passionate to implement it here. However, it floundered due to inadequate translation of the materials and because the pastors used it primarily to grow their churches. When he was 16, Yamanaka tried to kill his abusive father with a knife. In the aftermath of this incident, a missionary led him to faith in Jesus. Persuaded by her to seek a better life in the US, Yamanaka stayed for 12 years in Pennsylvania, where he received a clearer understanding and assurance of his salvation through EE. On returning, he assessed the situation of EE in Japan and believed it could be improved. Yamanaka translated the materials into simpler, vernacular Japanese and shifted the vision from growing his church though it did grow to equipping lay believers to reach Japan for Christ. The results have been astounding. In , the first EE training class in Yokohama attracted 20 students, and over the course of the week training, 17 people were led to Christ. Over the ensuing 10 years, Yamanaka estimates that Japanese have been led to faith through EE. Takeshi Hattori is one inspiring example. A typical Japanese employee, Hattori worked long hours, came home late, and pretty much lived at his job. However, his boss was a Christian, and one day he invited Pastor Yamanaka to evangelize his employees. The boss told Hattori to go into a conference room, where Yamanaka sat waiting for him. Yamanaka then shared the Evangelism Explosion presentation with him, and by the end, Hattori simply believed. Today, all his family members have also come to Christ through EE. While receiving counseling from Yamanaka, he heard of the EE training program, and for some reason insisted on enrolling. Halfway through, he called Yamanaka at midnight, excited. This taste of evangelistic fruit began to fill him with confidence and hope that his life was worthwhile and could be used by God. He stopped taking medication and returned to work. He eventually went to Bible school and today is a church planter in the Philippines. For one, it offers a clear presentation of the gospel. EE will overcome this obstacle. One element of the EE course is On the Job Training, where the student first observes and then practices sharing the gospel with a non-believing friend using the EE method. Because the presentation ends with an invitation to trust in Christ, many conversions occur during these appointments. Thus, EE provides a natural and friendly way to invite friends to faith. Another way that EE can help you is its conversational, relational approach. Rather than beginning with doctrine and propositions, it starts with personal testimony, which lowers resistance. In this way, EE proceeds naturally and smoothly toward a well-rounded, biblical gospel presentation that the listener has requested to hear. A good example is the translation of the invitation to believe in Christ. But they understand the concept of a gift. However, many people we talk to here still think in traditional categories of heaven and hell, God s and the devil, and ethical right and wrong. If more of us were to learn the EE approach and train lay people to do the same, incredulity would turn to joy as new hearts are born. He and his wife, Annette, have five children. Every Christian has a mission field and God given plan for their life. The role of the five-fold ministry is to equip the Saints for the work of ministry. These outreaches can take on many forms and include street outreaches, hospital visitations and stalls in markets to name a few. If every person in a church was committed to doing every week just two hours of ministry somewhere out of work hours, in a church of members, every week we would see hours of ministry flowing out of that church. Having ministry outreach teams in a church has many advantages. The two main advantages are, that they cause people to be committed to participating in an outreach ministry once a week, and secondly, by being in a team, quiet and shy people can be given support and have greater confidence by being part of a group of Christians reaching out with gospel. Whilst the format for this training course can take on many forms, one suggested possible format is as follows: Given the days that we live in it is so important that all Christians become soul winners. What is Evangelism Explosion? Is Evangelism Explosion biblical? As with any active ministry, current events may drastically change both perceptions and interpretations. The information below is fair and accurate, to the best of our knowledge, at the time this article was written. We encourage all persons to carefully investigate any ministry prior to committing time or money to it, rather than relying on any one review by a third party. Evangelism Explosion is a program designed to teach witnessing techniques to Christian believers. Its primary goal is to equip Christians to engage others in conversations about the Bible, morality, and salvation, with a goal of leading people to saving faith. The ministry provides direct training materials, tracts, and other resources. Doctrinally, Evangelism Explosion is well within the bounds of conservative, evangelical Christianity. The organization promotes views of Scripture, God, sin, and salvation that are consistent with biblical principles. In particular, the ministry teaches that Christ was virgin-born, sinless, crucified for our sin, and resurrected, and it teaches that faith in Christ is the sole means of salvation. Evangelism Explosion also holds the Bible to be inspired, inerrant, and authoritative. While the ministry is exclusively focused on evangelism training, it seems to hold biblically sound positions on those social issues that intersect evangelistic efforts. Evangelism Explosion was originally developed by D. James Kennedy in the early s. Today, it claims to train tens of thousands of people each year, resulting in millions of decisions to trust in Christ. It is one of the more commonly used, frequently cited versions of evangelistic training. As with any structured program, there are benefits and drawbacks to the system, and individuals have varied opinions about how effective it is. The program has remained popular for more than thirty years, with many churches crediting their success to its influence. Of course, a strident, impersonal message can harden people against further attempts at evangelism. To their credit, the leaders of Evangelism Explosion took such criticisms to heart, and in the late s revised the training program for a simpler approach and to place more emphasis on relationship-building. At the same time, the ministry stated that diluting the gospel message was not an option, regardless of how it was perceived. Every evangelistic encounter is different, because every person is different. Programs like Evangelism Explosion can be a great way to learn witnessing techniques, so long as one remembers the uniqueness of every situation. As training programs go, Evangelism Explosion seems to be a biblically sound approach. Training, practice, and knowledge are invaluable when spreading the gospel.

## 4: The History of Evangelism Explosion(EE) - Evangelism Explosion Uganda(EEU)

Two millennia later, the church is still hard at work fulfilling the greatest undertaking in history. Over that time, several methods developed to engage the culture. These can be divided into three categories: Of course within these three categories, there are more specific methods. Each method has inherent advantages and disadvantages. No one comes to the Father except through me John Paul reaffirms this in Romans 5: For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved ESV. The Advantages The advantage of using this method is that it systematically presents and explains the love of God for humanity, the need for repentance, the exclusivity of Christ being the only way for reconciliation to God, and the personal nature it expresses in individually and sincerely accepting Christ as Savior. Another advantage is that one can sit down with someone and go through these points in a short period of time. The chief advantage is that it relies solely upon Scripture to speak for itself. Therefore if someone is serious about coming to Christ, they are able to read, pray and ponder on these Scripture verses afterward. The next disadvantage is that most people involved in a pseudo-Christian cult may simply disregard these verses as something they already affirm. It is a natural yet subtle way of witnessing to the lost. In this day and age where self-absorption and blatant narcissism are rampant, the shock value of someone disregarding themselves for others is noteworthy and sure to prompt further discussion. Without love, this method will ultimately fail. The Advantages The first is that it opens the door to share the gospel. The easiest way to share the gospel is by being a living example. This inevitably leads to conversations about knowing Jesus. This will likely compound and lead to even more witnessing opportunities. The final and prime advantage of Servant Evangelism is that it glorifies God by modeling oneself after Christ Himself, as seen in Philippians 2: One can hardly think of a better example than God incarnate. In this manner, we display a full submission to God for His service and purposes. The Disadvantages One disadvantage is that it could take quite some time to impact a life enough toward salvation in Christ. Unless there is frequent exposure to a particular person, it proves difficult. Therefore time is a major factor in this method. The other disadvantage is that it takes a great deal of discernment. Unfortunately some people are prone to take advantage of those who are willing to forgo their own needs to serve others. If one is not careful, discouragement or even bitterness can seep in after such an encounter. Evangelism Explosion Evangelism Explosion is a ministry that started by Dr. James Kennedy in His purpose was to train people how to share their faith and to bring nonbelievers to Christ. What is unique about this system is that it seeks to exponentially evangelize by leading people to Christ, and then trains them to lead even more people to Christ. Another advantage is that it systematically trains up believers to share the faith, which undoubtedly includes discipleship, then sent out under supervision into the field to witness to unbelievers. With a sound foundation of knowledge coupled with practical application under the umbrella of discipleship, the effectiveness is clearly evident. The disadvantage of this method is simply that one may not have the time or resources to undertake this training. And that is for a few important reasons. The first reason is that this method is the most personable of the three methods. The second reason is that I struggle a great deal with the sin of pride, so this method forces me to humble myself in Christ to serve others and count them as better than myself Philippians 2: The final reason is that it is the most effective method in reaching the people in my life. I think Servant Evangelism, coupled with a strong apologetic program, is the best method for reaching these target groups. Both groups know where I stand, and yet some still speak with me and hear my reasons for my belief in Christ. Although it is a work in progress, I have the most affection for these two groups. And I pray that the Lord continues to use me to reach them.
