Statistics The Statistics Are Staggering: One out of two marriages ends in divorce. Sixty percent of second marriages fail, according to the U. Approximately half of all Americans are currently involved in some form of step relationship. By the year , according to the Census Bureau, more Americans will be living in step families than in nuclear families. Bumpass of the University of Wisconsin challenges the common perception that the stepfamily is defined by marriage. His research states that: Nearly half of all women, not just mothers, are likely to live in a stepfamily relationship, when we include living-together families in our definition of the stepfamily. Therefore, we have already become a nation of step-relating individuals. However, most graduate schools of psychiatry, psychology, and social work provide no specific training in dealing with these particular dynamics of stepfamilies. Often, the methods and information appropriate to the nuclear family can be destructive. It is our experience that this is one of the most difficult transitions for families to negotiate. Recognize that the stepfamily will not and can not function as does a natural family. It has its own special state of dynamics and behaviors. Once learned, these behaviors can become predictable and positive. Do not try to overlay the expectations and dynamics of the intact or natural family onto the stepfamily. Recognize the hard fact that the children are not yours and they never will be. We are stepparents, not replacement parents. We are stepparents, a step removed, yet in this position can still play a significant role in the development of the child. Discipline styles must be sorted out by the couple. What is acceptable behavior and what are the consequences when children misbehave? Generally, in the beginning, we suggest that the biological parent does the disciplining as much as is feasible. The couple together specifically works out jobs, expected behaviors and family etiquette. Establish clear job descriptions between the parent, stepparent and respective children. What specifically is the job of each one of us in this household? We need to be as detailed as we are in business. Know that unrealistic expectations beget rejections and resentments. There is no model for the step relationship except for the wicked stepchild and invariably cruel stepmother of fairy tales. Note the absence of myth around the stepfather. It is vital for the survival of the stepfather to be able to see and delineate expectations for each member of the family, especially the primary issues of upset in step: There are no ex-parents. Begin to get information on how to best handle the prior spouse. Be prepared for conflicting pulls of sexual and biological energies within the step relationship. In the intact family, the couple comes together to have a child. In step, blood and sexual ties can polarize a family in opposite energies and directions. The conflict of loyalties must be recognized right from the beginning. The conflict is particular to step and is a round robin of confused emotions. Chores must be assigned; making beds, helping with meals, keeping the bathroom clean, etc. Chaos and unpredictability creates low self-esteem in a child. Most men, even the strongest and most powerful, wimp out and turn into ninety-pound weaklings when their children visit. They endeavor to be "buddies" to their child. Create high self-esteem in your children. This is done by creating predictable expectations for your children when they come to your house. Predictable rules and regulations will make your children feel safe and secure. Money is always a problem, no matter how much there is. It is often best when children visit to give them a specific allowance for the time they will be with you. If a child needs extra

money, we advocate "extra pay for extra jobs. Build and maintain couple strength. Work together with your partner. Discussion is okay, but arguments are not. Be respectful of her reality as well as your own regarding the assignment of chores. Work this out between you, or seek the help of a Stepfamily Foundation counselor. The couple are the two pillars that hold the family together: She is the female head of the household; he is the male head of the household. The couple decides the rules of discipline. The couple decides the Rules of the House: The biological parent disciplines the child whenever possible. When necessary the stepparent says, "In this house we. Creating a structure is vital for the children. This requires extending the Rules of the House to all events. This structure makes it easy for kids to know what to do at your house. Creating a structure means creating high self-esteem. Children like themselves better when they know that they have done a good job and are part of a team. Remember that you are the father and the male head of the household. Men teach children the ways of the still dominant, male hierarchical business structure. Recognize that you have had many more years playing mother to them than lover to him. Usually you feel that you have not had enough time with your children and feel the need to catch up when you are together. Guilt may be a motivating factor. But discuss and agree about time spent with your man and time spent with your children. Try humor - for both of you.

The Stepfamily Differences There are key differences between first-time families and stepfamilies, and knowing these distinctions is important for the success of your family. First-time families have a built-in bond, as well as bonds that have developed over time. Fortunately, there are specific ways you and your family can overcome these challenges. The Stuck Insider Outsider In a first-time family, children tend to feel closer to mom or dad at different times during their development, which is painful enough for parents, Papernow said. In a stepfamily, though, the roles are stuck. The stepparent is the stuck outsider, and the parent is the stuck insider, she said. This can cause stepparents to feel disconnected from both their spouses and stepkids. For instance, any time kids have a problem, they naturally move toward the parent. Even if the couple is having a serious talk over lunch, when the child bursts through the door crying, the parent will naturally switch attention from stepparent to child. This can leave stepparents feeling abandoned and can cause a rift in the relationship. How to overcome it: People often wonder who comes first: But she said that the very question cultivates a competitive environment, where members of the stepfamily are working against each other. Instead, Papernow recommended having an agreement between the couples that stepparents will simply do their own thing like going for a walk or calling a friend while the parents and kids talk. Seven Steps to a Healthy Family Specializing in stepfamily therapy and education for over a decade has taught me one thing: Be sure to open your eyes well before a decision to marry has been made. Eyes Wide Open The following list represents key challenges every single-parent or those dating a single-parent should know before deciding to remarry. Wait years following divorce or the death of your spouse before seriously dating. Most people need a few years to fully heal from an ending of a previous relationship. In addition, your children will need at least this much time to heal and find stability in their visitation schedule. Date two years before deciding to marry; then date their children before the wedding. Dating two years gives you time to really get to know one another. Too many relationships are formed on the rebound when both persons lack godly discernment about their fit with a new person. Give yourself plenty of time to get to know them thoroughly. Even if everything feels right, dramatic psychological and emotional shifts often take place for children, parents, and stepparents right after the wedding. What seems like smooth sailing can become a rocky storm in a hurry. Know how to cook a stepfamily. Most people think the way to cook a stepfamily is with a blender "blended family", microwave, pressure cooker, or food processor. Nothing could be further from the truth. All of these "cooking styles" attempt to combine the family ingredients in a rapid fashion. Unfortunately, resentment and frustration are the only results. The way to cook a stepfamily is with a crock-pot. Once thrown into the pot, it will take time and low-heat to bring ingredients together, requiring that adults step into a new marriage with determination and patience. The average stepfamily takes years to combine; some take longer. There are no quick recipes, only dedicated journeyman. Read more about how to cook a stepfamily here. Realize that the "honeymoon" comes at the end of the journey for remarried couples, not the beginning. Couples need to understand that the rewards of stepfamily life e. Just as the Israelites traveled a long time before entering the Promise Land, so will it be for your stepfamily. Think about the kids: In fact, your remarriage is another. It sabotages their fantasy that mom and dad can reconcile, or that a deceased parent will always hold their place in the home. Manage and be sensitive to loyalties. Even in the best of circumstances children feel torn between their biological parents and likely feel that enjoying your dating partner will please you but betray their other parent. Give them your permission to love and respect new people in the other home and let them warm up to your new spouse in their own time. When looking at your daughter, you will see a sixteen-year-old who brought you mud pies when they were four and showered you with hugs each night after work. Expect to have different opinions and to disagree on parenting decisions. Realize that remarriage has unique barriers. Are you more committed to your children or your marriage? Making a covenant does not mean neglecting your kids, but it does mean that they are taught which relationship is your ultimate priority. A marriage that is not the priority will be mediocre at best. Another unique barrier involves the ghost of marriage past. Individuals can be haunted by the negative experiences of previous relationships and not even recognize how it is impacting the new marriage. Work to not interpret the present in light of the past, or you might be destined to repeat it. Parent as a team; get your plan ready. No single challenge is more predictive of stepfamily success than the ability of the couple to parent as a team. Stepparents must find their role, know their limits in authority, and borrow power from the biological parent in order to contribute to parental leadership. Managing these roles will not be easy; get a plan and stick together. Know what to tell the kids. You need to find someone safe to talk to about all this. You belong to two homes with different rules, routines, and relationships. Find your place and contribute good things in each. I love you and will always have enough room in my heart for you. There are three main reasons: Unrealistic Expectations Single parents that remarry often have some unrealistic expectations about how the newly formed family will integrate. Stepfamily Expectations Realistic My children and spouse will instantly love each other. Stepparents and stepchildren develop a relationship gradually. Love may never grow. We will be just like a biological family. Stepfamilies function differently from biological familiesâ€”not better, not worse. They are born out of past losses and the children are members of at least two households. Parenting is done with a biological parent who lives in a different household. Lots of flexibility, sensitivity, and patience are required from both the adults involved and the children. My new spouse should help me discipline our kids, right away. Stepparents need about 18 months to establish a relationship with the stepchildren before they can participate in the discipline. Also the children need some time to develop trust that the stepparent is committed to the family and is not going to abandon them at the sight of conflict. My spouse should not discipline my kids. Biological parents need to be the main disciplinarians. My ex will be happy for me and our children. My new spouse will erase or compensate for my past hurt. You and only you can bring about the desired healing and peace you need, By completing your emotional divorce through resolving the grieving process. They go through a similar process of grief as people who mourn the death of a loved one. The main stages of the grieving process are: Only after grieving can one be emotionally available for a new relationship. Unresolved emotional divorce is incomplete grief. Resolution is a prerequisite for your emotional and mental wellness. In their anxiety and insecurity, they forbid their children to develop a relationship with their stepparent. Additionally they demand that the children dislike the stepparent. Children may resultantly resist developing a relationship with their stepparents. September 21, Amazon revamped its Echo lineup in a surprise event in Seattle on Thursday, Sept. A summary of the event has been added to the top of the story. For the audiophiles, Amazon debuted an Echo subwoofer , an amp and a receiver , along with software that will let you sync your Echo speakers in a stereo pair. For the smart-home crowd, Amazon debuted a smart plug , a smart microwave and even an Alexa-enabled clock. Check out everything Amazon announced here. The Amazon Echo is the biggest tech breakout in recent memory -- a voice-activated, internet-connected "smart speaker" with a built-in virtual assistant named Alexa that can answer your questions, follow your instructions and control your smart home devices. As Amazon likes to put it, the Echo is a Star Trek computer for your home. Now approaching its fourth year, the Echo and its multiple offshoots, including the mini-sized Echo Dot and the touchscreen-equipped Echo Show , have found their way into millions of homes around the world. Amazon introduced the Echo smart speaker at the end of . Once the speaker hears the wake word, the ring around the top will light up blue to indicate that Alexa is actively listening for your question and command. Those servers translate the audio into text, then figure out the best way for Alexa to answer. That info gets sent back to your Echo speaker, where Alexa translates the text back into a spoken response. All of this happens in about a second. Press the mute button on the top of the Echo and Alexa will stop listening for the wake word. The Echo is always listening for the wake word, but it only starts recording and transmitting audio once it thinks it hears it. Echo devices indicate this with that blue ring of light -- when it lights up, that means Alexa is recording and uploading what it hears in order to figure out how to respond. Amazon uses encryption to protect those audio snippets whenever Alexa uploads them, and it stores them in the Amazon servers so that you can play them back in the Alexa app to hear what Alexa heard and see what she thinks you asked. So what all can Alexa do? There are countless ways to put Alexa to use, but here are the main ones: From kitchen conversions to celebrity birthdays to sports statistics, Alexa is awfully handy at pulling up a quick fact. The Echo is great for streaming music, audiobooks, and podcasts. If you want, you can connect the Echo with your existing speakers via auxiliary cable or Bluetooth. Alexa can play songs, artists, albums, playlists, genres or podcasts on request. You can choose either Amazon Music or Spotify as your default music library, and you can choose between Amazon Music, iHeartRadio and Pandora as your default station service. Alexa also supports audiobooks via Kindle Unlimited and Audible, and you can also ask for live radio broadcasts through TuneIn, including premium access sporting events and newscasts for a monthly fee.
