

1: Fill In / Out / Up The Form

In American English, they are used interchangeably, but in British English, generally 'fill in a form' is used, the verb 'fill out' meaning 'to expand', in the sense of putting on weight, but rarely in the sense of completing a form.

I wonder if you could make a fill-in-the-blank question in an online form? Turns out, not quite so much. Most forms show questions one after another, with a title followed by a text box or dropdown to enter the answer. The best you could do in most form apps—say, in Google Forms for instance—is to split the question into two sections. I instead wanted something more like this—which is possible with a bit more work. Turns out, there are ways to build real fill-in-the-blank questions, though they often take a workaround. Then drag in the form elements your form will need. To make my form, I need 5 elements: Three text elements, a short text entry element, and a dropdown element. Drag them in one after the other and enter the correct text. I then have a second text element with the word in, followed by a dropdown to select their app and a final text element with a? The short text and dropdown elements will include a question at the top by default. Select it, then tap the gear icon to open the properties pane and select the Options tab there. Enter the options you want in the dropdown to finish it out. As you do that, one by one the elements will line up in a sentence—or almost. With 5 form elements, our sentence takes up two lines by default. Select the Styles tab, then enter a new width for your form. JotForm also includes pre-made themes—though be careful, as your fill-in-the-blank question may look different in them. The best way to make your form look just like you want is to select the Advanced Designer button at the bottom of the Designer pane. Select an element in your form, and you can then directly write CSS for it without having to figure out the element name. The text field looks like a blank in a fill-in-the-blank sentence, and the dropdown barely looks like a dropdown. With a bit of tweaking, uncovering hidden features, and coding in CSS, your new form can look like this: Normally, JotForm will show each question and answer in a table. Delete that, and instead write out your sentence, filling in the blanks with your form fields. Want to save your form responses to a spreadsheet, get notified about them in Slack, or turn them into a document in WebMerge? All you need to make one is a form that supports multiple columns—and ideally that lets you remove the question text from above text and dropdown options. Here are some options that fit the bill, at least in part: PlanSo Forms may be the next best option. Use its Paragraph element to add text, and just drag-and-drop the sections near each other to instantly turn them into a multi-column sentence. Outgrow is another great option, with a built-in template for fill-in-the-blank questions via its The Greek Quizzes template. Wufoo includes CSS Keywords , which you can use to arrange up to 3 form fields in a row for a simple fill-in-the-blank question. Gravity Forms , a form plugin for WordPress-powered sites, uses similar CSS Ready Classes to let you add up to 5 columns—which you could use to create a form like the one above. Formstack does include multiple columns, but text and dropdown fields are required to include a header—which would require some thoughtful writing make your fill-in-the-blank question look correct. Aerobatic , a static site host, also makes it easy to do the same with custom webhook-powered forms on Jekyll or other flat-file CMS based sites. Online form apps are some of the most versatile tools. You can put together a quick contact form for your site or build a prototype of your next app idea all with a drag-and-drop form editor.

To summarize: Anyone who plans to fill out the FAFSA form should create an FSA ID as soon as possible. If you are required to provide parent information on your FAFSA form, your parent should create an FSA ID too.

Surname at birth Former Family Name Write the name you had at your birth if different than the one indicated in section 1.

First Name s Write your first name s as indicated on your passport.

Date of Birth Write your date of birth in day-month-year order.

Place of Birth Write your place of birth as indicated on your passport.

Country of Birth Add the name of the country, even if it is not specified on the passport.

Gender Check the box corresponding to your gender Male or Female.

Civil Status Check the box corresponding to your legal marital status.

Minors Write the full name, address, and nationality of the person holding parental authority or legal guardianship.

National Identity Number Write your national identity number, if applicable.

Travel Document Type Specify the type of travel document.

Travel Document Number Write the number as indicated in your passport or in your travel document.

Issue Date Write the date your passport was issued Please do not put the extension date.

Expiration Date Write the date as indicated in your passport, taking into account any extension. Specify the authority that issued the passport and the place of issue. Write your email address and as well as your landline and mobile telephone numbers in your country of residence and, where appropriate, in the country where you are submitting your visa application.

Residence in Another Country Specify whether you live in a country other than your current nationality, stating, if you answer yes, the number of your residence permit and its expiration date.

Current Occupation In principle, write the occupation indicated on the passport; if you indicate a different occupation, please write a short explanation, for example: Employer or Educational Institution Write the name of the organization firm, public service, educational institution where you work and its contact information.

Destination Member State Write the name of the country you will be residing in for most of the traveling days, referred to as the main destination.

Number of Entries Requested Check the box corresponding to your desired number of entries.

Length of Stay Write the duration corresponding to your desired length of stay.

Schengen Visas Issued during the Last 3 Years Specify the number of visas that you have obtained to enter the Schengen area during the last 3 years.

Fingerprints Check the corresponding box. If your fingerprints have already been taken for a visa application, indicate the date.

Entry Permit for Your Final Destination Country, If Applicable Write the number and validity dates for your visa at your final destination, if this country is outside the Schengen area.

Arrival Date Write your expected arrival date in the Schengen area.

Departure Date Write your departure date from the Schengen area. Check the appropriate box you may check several boxes.

Personal Information Regarding a Family Member who is a European Union, EEA, or Swiss National Write the full name, date of birth, nationality, passport number, and relationship only if you are the dependent spouse, child, father, or mother of a person who is a citizen of another State of the European Union.

Date and Location Write the place and date where you are filling-in the form, even if this date is different than the day you are going to the visa service.

Signature The Visa application form should be completely filled and signed by Visa applicant and not another person. If the visa applicant is a minor under 18 , the application must be signed by a person having parental authority and their relationship should be included in parentheses father, mother, guardian. If the visa applicant cannot sign, a cross may be used.
