Not just in helping someone, but to have the opportunity to engage with someone over 10, miles away because of their dedication to the arts, and their confidence to reach out. Sometimes, I really do love the power of the internet. We had been discussing the varied relationships that fashion films have to both the fashion industry and the film industry as two separate entities. It is certainly not an essay, nor does it flow in a way to create a running narrative or piece of prose or critical work. It is merely the conversation with the gaps filled in. There was a time when they [Fashion Films vs. However, it is important to understand that some fashion photographers were making fashion films, as we understand them today, many years before they fell into a mainstream market. Guy Bourdin was one of the most prominent that comes to mind. Today, many advertisement campaigns – like the ones we see on the internet or TV, such as for perfume, actually form part of a larger narrative. This is normally the original longer version- a fashion film. The advertisement is merely a proportion of that. Like a film trailer. It is still not massively recognised by the film industry as such, and part of that is due to more commercial elements, but there are some crossovers. The list is far more extensive, but these three examples show great moves from traditional cinematic work, into something more experimental. The audience may often be quite different than their usual demographic, as can be the end result. As always, you have to mention the pioneering work of ShowStudio – because without the pivotal work of founder Nick Knight and his expanding team, we would be missing out on the greatness that fashion film has been providing to its many and expanding following. What I would say also, is that fashion films are still very much ground within the fashion industry. So as much as any one brand or filmmaker may try, how the audience equates their cinematic experience to certain brand values may not always translate in the same fashion. This helps it lean more towards the traditional film industry. Other times, the story may not represent the brand so simply, but may either merely feature the products, or have a more abstract link.
