I have been a licensed marriage and family therapist in private practice for 27 years. My personal life has also been a great teacher.. I was married 23 years and had four children when I was divorced and I was single mother several years when I met my second husband. This marriage lasted 3 years when he told me he needed to live alone and I must leave. How could thisâ€”two divorces-- happen to me, a marriage counselor, mother of 4 nice kids, granddaughter of a respected Methodist minister? Out of my anguish I determined to write something for people like meâ€”and my clients. I had read the textbooks and the research. This writing was meant to take complicated ideas and make them easy to understand. During the time of researching and writing the book I met the love of my life, Fred Schlaepfer, also a therapist. Together we have created the kind of relationship I always knew was possible. In the 20 years since we met we have worked together as co-therapists. We specialize with couples and teach classes for singles and couples from the curriculum I wrote to accompany the book. I have taught at university, adult school and professional settings. I have talked about the book on radio and TVâ€”sometimes with Fred. This is the second and up-dated version of the book. The first focused on how we choose partners. This later version focuses on current relationships as well as information for divorced or single people. The first half of the book contains 8 exercises enlightening each individual, whether in a couple or single, about the underlying dynamics of relationship for each. The exercises are easy and down to earth and allow readers to understand self and other in new ways. The book came out of my own determination to create a healthy and happy relationship. I hope it serves you as well as it has many others. Readers have told me this book changed their lives! The eight simple to administer exercises are augmented by charts and extra materials not printed in "Fishing by Moonlight". The important but seldom focused on history of earlier relationships and family is a part of these experiential exercises. Communication skills are taught and participants are encouraged to use these skills with other members of the class. There are opportunities to share with partners or paired singles. The curriculum is set forth as 6 weekly 2-hour classes total of 12 hours but can also be given as a week-end class or any other time frame that is suitable. Therapists can give it for clients or as a way of attracting clients. It is very adaptable to religious settings as a valuable aid to members of a congregation. It is formulated in such a way as to be appropriate for singles and couples in the same class as each individual does the work alone and it may be shared. It would be excellent as a follow-up class for divorced or widowed people following a period of time for grieving. Whether creating a new relationship or improving an existing one, two people with more understanding of self and other are better prepared for happiness together. The curriculum spells out exactly how to teach the class. Participants should be asked to read a chapter in the book for each class. It is an excellent adjunct to therapy and would be easy for a therapist to teach. In my experience people enjoy the class and learn from each other as part of the group. Would you like to do them in your own personal workbook containing all of them in one place? They could be for your eyes only or shared with a special someone. The pages are, of course, larger and more writer friendly than they are in the book.

By that time the beaches, which are normally packed with tourists throughout the day, were largely empty. The tourist set had spent most of the day surfing, swimming, and tanning under the hot June sun but by evening they crowded into the bars, shops, and restaurants situated along the shoreline. A band played classic rock covers on a patio overlooking the water to a crowd of sun-reddened tourists with beers and margaritas in hand. Across the bay an enormous cruise ship had just docked and passengers were exiting after a week-long tour of the Caribbean. My family and I were headed down to the marina where one captain was cleaning a boat and loading supplies. We shook hands and I stepped on board. Florida welcomed roughly million tourists last year, most of whom travel here for the beaches. But one thing is clearâ€”Florida is home to a bunch of hungry sharks. The sharks, Garren said, would come cruising into the shallows eight to ten feet from deeper water in search of food. The receding tide meant there would be more prey in the water. I checked the depth finder. We were in eight feet of water. Suddenly line began hissing off the reel. My sister-in-law Heather hauled the rod free of the holder and tucked it under her arm, lifting the tip and reeling down against the weight of the fish. The most commonly caught shark species on the Space Coast are spinners, Atlantic blacktip and blacknose, requiem sharks in the three to four-foot range. Sometimes, however, you catch something much, much larger. Hammerheads, bull, lemon and nurse sharks are all found here, and some of them attain very impressive lengths and weights. Heather would gain line on the shark, lifting until we were certain that the fish would break the surface, and then the shark would make a hard run and peel line off into the darkening water. Each time she lifted the tip of the rod it was as though she were pulling against a submerged stump. After some time she handed the rod off to her father John. The comparison to hooking a stump seemed accurate when John finally pulled the shark to the surface, for the huge barrel body that we saw rise from the water on the side of the boat was the same color as fresh dirt. As darkness fell we took turns hauling in sharks one by one. When one of the reels would begin losing line the next person would step in and begin fighting. Jason Smith caught a very nice Blacknose shark, and my wife Bethany caught a spinner and a blacktip. Garren guessed that the one I caught weighed in the neighborhood of pounds and measured six feet long. The first nurse shark had been thirty percent larger. Sharks are one of the most overlooked game fish in the sea, viewed more as a menace than a target species. But guys like Greg Rapp and Garren Malin are changing that, and more and more anglers are taking advantage of these abundant, hard-fighting fish.
