Gone are the oversized spinner baits, cranks and spoons – the familiar tools of warm weather fishing – and out come the tip-ups and quick-strike rigs. The Intricacies Of Bait Dead bait is the preferred tool when chasing winter pike. They represent a large, stationary profile to a hungry fish, triggering instinctive strikes from these freshwater predators. They also provides the perfect scent and taste attributes to attract fish, leaving a magnetic trail washing in the water and arousing their senses. For choosing dead bait, a number of criteria should be considered. Smelt, herring, sardines, and suckers all make excellent choices please check local regulations before using , and can be purchased either fresh or frozen from many grocery stores or seafood markets. Suckers can also be caught from local streams or rivers, and put directly in the freezer until needed. Choose bait between 6- and 9 inches long, as this seems to be the preferred size for pike, especially during the winter months. I prefer my baits to be slightly frozen when hitting the ice, as it allows for easier rigging and manipulation of the bait. The Quick-Strike Rig A quick strike rig provides the perfect presentation when using dead bait. It allows for a single hook to be placed through the lips, while a treble hook is lightly skewered on the upper backside, toward the tail end. When a pike swims with bait, turning it around to swallow after a short run, the hooks will usually find a secure place at the front of the mouth on the ensuing hookset. Quick-strike rigs can be purchased from tackle retailers, or designed by oneself. It can actually make for a rewarding hobby leading up to the season, and is inexpensive to get into. Tip-Up Choice In order to present dead bait, a high quality tip-up is needed. Regardless of the style you choose, reliance on Dacron or tip-up line, in to pound-test strength is your best bet. I prefer a black-colored line, as it is easier to see against the snow and ice, especially when hand-lining fish in. Smooth drags are also imperative when chasing pike, due to the length of runs and the speed that they can achieve. Make sure that it can run freely, with no hesitation at all. I rely on three models of tip-ups when heading out on the ice for pike: Which of those mentioned I use depends on weather conditions, and my perceived activity of the fish. If temperatures are very cold, and the risk of holes freezing is severe, the Polar Therm gets the nod. This style will insulate your hole, alleviating any freezing issues, with the spool hidden under the water. If temperatures are warm and fish are aggressive, the Original Polar would be my choice. And lastly, if there is a slight breeze and the fish have taken on lockjaw, the Windlass provides the necessary and attractive action to trigger those strikes. Choose a tip-up style relating to the weather conditions, and the activity level of the fish. The trip mechanisms are smooth on these units, and can be adjusted for varying degrees of release, making them ideal choices when dealing with weighty dead bait. Whichever tip-up design you choose, make sure the spool is filled to capacity – especially if deeper water is part of your game plan. Where To Fish Northern pike turn on come winter, with the first ice period often bringing your best chance for steady action. Where to find them often depend on the body of water, but include shallow and deep weed lines, river mouths, break lines and flats. Pike will target these areas in one of two ways – in a patrolling, active feeding mode, or sulking near bottom while waiting for prey to stumble by. Pike are typically more aggressive when the sun is shining, and mid-morning to late afternoon will usually see them in their hungriest disposition. Cover a variety of areas with your tip-ups when beginning the day, from water as shallow as 5 feet to depths of 30 feet if applicable. What you are searching for are active fish, and once found, they will give you an idea of the precise areas to target. Fish Near Bottom Bait placement can also be paramount to your success. I prefer to suspend dead bait just off the bottom, perhaps 1- to 2 feet at most. Using electronics, such as a Vexilar, can make the positioning of bait a breeze. The rewards of dead baiting – jumbo northern pike! Before I place a dead-bait rig in the hole, I always make a few slashes in the skin of the fish with a knife. This helps in releasing juices, and adds to the attraction factor of the bait itself. Although dead bait can last a long time under the water, rigging up fresh bait periodically throughout the day has often brought quick results. Dead baiting for pike can really bring out the excitement once winter sets in. It is a simple technique that can provide ample enjoyment, with that chance for a true

There are many small lakes and rivers which can rival any of the above mentioned waters. Perch are typically a schooling fish, which move from place to place seeking food sources. When found, they like to thrive in the bottom portion of the water column, especially at or near the bottom of the lake or river. Their natural diet consists of small fish, fish eggs, insects, crayfish, snails, leeches and worms. They are very active daytime feeders for most of the year, but tend to feed in short spurts. Moving often is suggested every 30 minutes or so, especially during ice fishing, until you locate an active school of fish. Focusing on transition areas within the lake rock to mud, sand to rock etc. Good electronics will also make this task easier. However, remember that these little critters are always on the move as they are a migrating fish. A minor repositioning of a boat on a favorite location may just be enough to make your day successful. These fish are naturally very curious. Many times in the Winnebago system, they follow the sturgeon around the lake. The sturgeons tend to stir the bottom content, exposing easy meals for the perch such as red worms. Using this bit of information to your advantage, fishermen can emulate this natural occurrence by one of two ways. Many experienced perch fishermen will pound the bottom of the lake under the boat with a stick or rod. The perch will see the commotion and be naturally attracted to the disturbance. This will expose natural food sources and your bait to the school of fish. A second version is to pull the anchor of the boat along the bottom. You can then fish the rut which has been created. Once the action slows down, repeat the procedure. Perch are also very attracted by color and flash. If using a slip bobber setup or dead sticking, add a small colored bead just above the bait on the main line. The bead acts as a beacon to find the natural bait. This will increase catch rates greatly, especially in stained water. The current will wave the flag to attract the school of fish. Equipment should be focused on light-weight gear. Nothing more than six-pound test line and in most cases a four-lb mono can be ideal. A light rod or ultra light is preferred to detect light bites. A stiffer composite rod can help set the hook. I prefer a Kahle offset hook while fishing perch as it has a higher hook-up percentage than a standard hook. Remember when fishing perch, use the lightest weight rod, hook, sinker, and line as conditions allow. The best perch rig I have used consists of a pass-through egg sinker. After the egg sinker is placed on the line, add a small swivel to prevent the sinker from sliding down to the hook followed by a two-foot mono or fluorocarbon lead, colored bead and Kahle hook. The egg sinker will sit on the bottom, and the bait will be presented in the strike zone. When the perch takes the bait, it will not feel the sinker attached as the line passes through the sinker. Watch the line as it tightens, and then set the hook. This method is deadly tactic in the summer for walleye also. Using these techniques can enhance your day on the water. Perch fishing is a finesse presentation and the little things make a huge difference.

Castillo states, Trance phenomena result from the behavior of intense focusing of attention, which is the key psychological mechanism of trance induction. Spiritualism generally attracted female adherents, many who had strong interests in social justice. Rarely did the assistant record the responding words of the sitter and other attendants. This type of mediumship is claimed to involve perceptible manifestations, such as loud raps and noises, voices, materialized objects, apports, materialized spirit bodies, or body parts such as hands, legs and feet. The role of the medium is to make the connection between the physical and spirit worlds. Trumpets are often utilised to amplify the signal, and directed voice mediums are sometimes known as "trumpet mediums". Leslie Flint was one of the best known exponents of this form of mediumship. One type involved clairaudience or sensitives who hear spirit, and then relay what they hear to their clients. The rhythm and the intonation of the voice may also change completely. A widely known channeler of this variety is J. Knight , who claims to channel the spirit of Ramtha , a 30 thousand-year-old man. Others purport to channel spirits from "future dimensions", ascended masters, [32] or, in the case of the trance mediums of the Brahma Kumaris , God. A medium is said to have psychic abilities but not all psychics function as mediums. The term clairvoyance, for instance, may include seeing spirit and visions instilled by the spirit world. The Parapsychological Association defines "clairvoyance" as information derived directly from an external physical source. Some mediums say that this is their normal vision state. Others say that they must train their minds with such practices as meditation in order to achieve this ability, and that assistance from spiritual helpers is often necessary. Some clairvoyant mediums can see a spirit as though the spirit has a physical body. They see the bodily form as if it were physically present. Clairaudience or "clear hearing", is usually defined as the ability to hear the voices or thoughts of spirits. Some mediums hear as though they are listening to a person talking to them on the outside of their head, as though the Spirit is next to or near to the medium, and other mediums hear the voices in their minds as a verbal thought. Clairsentience or "clear sensing", is the ability to have an impression of what a spirit wants to communicate, or to feel sensations instilled by a spirit. Clairsentience or "clear feeling" is a condition in which the medium takes on the ailments of a spirit, feeling the same physical problem which the spirit person had before death. Clairience or "clear smelling" is the ability to smell a spirit. For example, a medium may smell the pipe tobacco of a person who smoked during life. Clairgustance or "clear tasting" is the ability to receive taste impressions from a spirit. Claircognizance or "clear knowing", is the ability to know something without receiving it through normal or psychic senses. It is a feeling of "just knowing". Often, a

medium will claim to have the feeling that a message or situation is "right" or "wrong". The idea of mediumship being explained by telepathy was later merged into the "super-ESP" hypothesis of mediumship which is currently advocated by some parapsychologists. Critical Thinking for a New Age, authors Theodore Schick and Lewis Vaughn have noted that the spiritualist and ESP hypothesis of mediumship "has yielded no novel predictions, assumes unknown entities or forces, and conflicts with available scientific evidence. Research from psychology for over a hundred years suggests that where there is not fraud, mediumship and Spiritualist practices can be explained by hypnotism, magical thinking and suggestion. Cold reading also explains why psychics have consistently failed scientific tests of their powers. By isolating them from their clients, psychics are unable to pick up information from the way those clients dress or behave. As a result, the type of highly successful hit rate that psychics enjoy on a daily basis comes crashing down and the truth emerges – their success depends on a fascinating application of psychology and not the existence of paranormal abilities. From its earliest beginnings to contemporary times, mediumship practices have had many instances of fraud and trickery. Physical mediumship that has been investigated by scientists has been discovered to be the result of deception and trickery. A very large part is played by fraud in spiritualistic practices, both in the physical and psychical, or automatic, phenomena, but especially in the former. The frequency with which mediums have been convicted of fraud has, indeed, induced many people to abandon the study of psychical research, judging the whole bulk of the phenomena to be fraudulently produced. In Britain, the Society for Psychical Research has investigated mediumship phenomena. Critical SPR investigations into purported mediums and the exposure of fake mediums has led to a number of resignations by Spiritualist members. No doubt a great importance in the paranormal field is the problem of fraud. The field of psychic research and spiritualism has been so notoriously full of charlatans, such as the Fox sisters and Eusapia Palladino – individuals who claim to have special power and gifts but who are actually conjurers who have hoodwinked scientists and the public as well – that we have to be especially cautious about claims made on their behalf. Rose Mackenberg, a private investigator who worked with Houdini during the 1890s, was among the most prominent debunkers of psychic fraud during the mid-nineteenth century. Browning seized the "materialization" and discovered it to be the bare foot of Home. To make the deception worse, Browning had never lost a son in infancy. Hall exposed the "levitation" of Home as nothing more than his moving across a connecting ledge between two iron balconies. Fay later confessed to her fraud and revealed the tricks she had used. The magician Chung Ling Soo revealed how Slade had performed the trick. The British medium Francis Ward Monck was investigated by psychical researchers and discovered to be a fraud. Monck ran from the room, locked himself in another room and escaped out of a window. A pair of stuffed gloves was found in his room, as well as cheesecloth, reaching rods and other fraudulent devices in his luggage. Rita, were detected in trickery at Amsterdam. Her Indian spirit control "Pocka" was found to be the medium on her knees, covered in muslin. Keeler and Henry Slade. Margaret Fox revealed that she and her sister had produced the "spirit" rappings by cracking their toe joints. You take little Jack down to the river for a fishing lesson, and this serves as your introduction to the system. The first step is to select your Fishing Rod from the Items menu. Next, you must attach bait to it, and this is divided into two categories: Bobber and Lure more on that later. With a lure, you have to reel in until you feel a bite. If you see a fish, cast beyond it and reel in the lure so the fish sees it coming by. Be sure to wait until you feel a strong bite before "striking"--with a bobber or a lure--as fish will often nibble a few times before biting down the hook. Wait until the fish becomes tired before reeling in; trying to reel as a fish is tugging will cause your line to break. With a fish on the line, push the left stick in the opposite direction the fishing is moving to tire it out faster. You can also click in the right stick and push it in any direction to prevent the fish from taking more line out. However, you must be careful with this approach as you can snap your line very easily. You will also snap your line if a fish pulls away and gets behind a rock or other object. You reel in by rotating the right stick counter clockwise. Pushing the left stick down as you reel in speeds up the process because it brings the fish directly in towards you. I found it was helpful, if not a little embarrassing, to use my thumb and index finger at the same time to reel in even faster. The amount of fight a fish puts in is directly related to its size and type. But catching larger fish, like Sturgeon and Sockeye Salmon, can entail fights that take multiple minutes to complete. Just like in real life, selecting the right bait is critically important if you want to reel in a big one. You can purchase basic bait types like bread, corn, and cheese, or spend more money on worms and crayfish that help you land bigger fish.
