### 2: Miss Forestry Pageant® Home of the GA Forestry State Scholarship Pageant® -Since

*Georgia has won the Miss America crown twice - Neva Jane Langley of Lakeland, Florida who won the Miss America title, and in , when Betty Cantrell of Warner Robins was named Miss America , making her the first native-born Miss Georgia to hold the Miss America title.*

Ed Johnson, President of the Columbus Jaycees in , was a judge for a beauty contest held in Atlanta in connection with the Southern Fair Association. Lenora Slaughter, the Executive Director of the Miss America Pageant, was also there and at the time there was a general swing away from awarding franchises to state fairs in favor of Jaycee groups. She asked if Columbus could handle the show. She looked at her watch and said: Can you handle it? But here he was, Mrs. He told her that the Jaycees would do the show and signed the agreement. This all happened on Friday and on Monday a special Meeting of the Columbus Jaycees Board of Directors was called the Johnson laid it on the line for them. Since an agreement had been made, the board approved it. Jaycees started similar local pageants in Albany, Thomasville, Atlanta, etc. By , there were contestants from about fifteen towns. By , the pageants were really big time. The Miss America Pageant informed the Columbus Jaycees that they would lose the Miss Georgia franchise unless they formed a separate corporation. The reason for this was, they felt that the Jaycees were using the pageant as a training field, and they wanted more experienced people running the pageant. The Jaycees were not too happy about this at first. They even considered a franchise with the Miss Universe Pageant, but they liked the Miss America program and decided to do as suggested. So, a small group of Jaycees, who had worked with the pageant several years and loved all the hard work that goes with it, formed the Miss Georgia Corporation in . It has grown into one of the top pageants in the Miss America program. This corporation was formed with the full approval of the Columbus Jaycees Board of Directors. If it had not been handled this way, a Miss Georgia organization would have been formed by someone else and the group would have lost the franchise anyway. The Board of Trustees of the Miss Georgia Pageant Corporation consists of past and present Jaycees and interested members of the community maximum number: Since the corporation was formed, the Jaycees have been called on to help with the manpower needed to produce the annual events. After Miss Georgia is crowned, the rest of the year is aimed at booking appearances for her and helping with local pageants for the next year. Miss Georgia makes three to five appearances per week and her fees are available upon request. The Miss Georgia Organization has been on the move and has bettered itself each year. The scholarship program, which has been incorporated, is one of the largest in the country and the production has blossomed from a single performance at Memorial Stadium to a four night event at the Three Arts Theatre. The outstanding scholarship program has added many college franchises and almost every contestant is a college student. In , the organization formed Miss Teen Georgia America for high school students across the state. Miss Georgias have made many exciting appearances.

## 3: Mrs. Georgia Contestants | Georgia International Pageants

*This can be any Sunday best, formal or pageant attire. Contestants are judged on First impression, facial beauty, overall appearance and stage presence. We will conduct a group line up in the beauty competition, then compete in the individual competition.*

Are we a natural or glitz pageant? We are for the most part a natural pageant system Also, please not in most all our pageant venues we will use full stage lighting. Thus, we believe light makeup is fine on younger contestants. What should we wear? We do not have rules by age division for long or short dresses. My suggestion is to wear what you like! This can be a pageant dress, bridesmaid dress, flower girl dress, etc. We also do not have rules for or against glitzy verses more plain dresses. Just wear what you like. This is anything you think is fun! We use this in lue of Swim Wear. We do understand that some contestants are not comfortable competing in a pageant with swim wear. We are one of the only pageants that offers Summer Wear, which can consist of anything summery. This is any attire with a holiday theme. Typically we do this at our annual Christmas pageant. What is the cost to participate in a pageant? The registration cost may vary from pageant to pageant. Many factors are taken into consideration when deciding the registration fee for a pageant. What kind of photo do we need? Each contestant should bring a photo to the pageant. It can be from wallet size up to an 8x10 size. My recommendation would be atleast a 5x7 or larger. Black and white or color photos are fine. Typically head shots do better in the photogenic competition. Contestants may enter more than one photo if they choose. Information for that is on each pageant paperwork. The Photogenic award is a side award given in each age division. Judges are looking for several things when judging the photographs. They are looking for a good quality photo, a photo that shows the contestants facial features well, and a contestant that photographs well. Is there an admission fee to watch the pageant? Yes, there is an admission fee to all except the contestant in the pageant. What is the judging criteria? In most all of our pageant the Formal Wear judging criteria is broken down into three categories with 1 - 10 points available in each category. Contestants may receive a total of 30 points. We do ask our judges for comments if time will permit, as we believe this will help contestants strive to improve in needed areas. How are contestants put in line up? Contestants are put into line up by the date we receive the registration form and payment is received. First entry received will be last in line and last received will be first in line. What are your age divisions? Most of our pageants age divisions will be as follows: This is at the discretion of the director.
