The integrated reasoning section includes four question types: Each question will have several statements with opposite-answer options e. Graphics interpretation questions ask test takers to interpret a graph or graphical image. Each question has fill-in-the-blank statements with pull-down menus; test takers must choose the options that make the statements accurate. Multi-source reasoning questions are accompanied by two to three sources of information presented on tabbed pages. Test takers click on the tabs and examine all the relevant information, which may be a combination of text, charts, and tables to answer either traditional multiple-choice or opposite-answer e. Two-part analysis questions involve two components for a solution. Possible answers are given in a table format with a column for each component and rows with possible options. Test takers have to choose one response per column. Quantitative section[edit] The quantitative section of the GMAT seeks to measure the ability to reason quantitatively, solve quantitative problems, interpret graphic data, and analyze and use information given in a problem. Questions require knowledge of certain algebra, geometry, and arithmetic. There are two types of quantitative questions: The use of calculators is not allowed on the quantitative section of the GMAT. Test takers must do their math work out by hand using a wet erase pen and laminated graph paper which are given to them at the testing center. Scores range from 0 to 60, although GMAC only reports scores between 6 and Data sufficiency is a question type unique to the GMAT designed to measure the ability to understand and analyze a quantitative problem, recognize what information is relevant or irrelevant and determine at what point there is enough information to solve a problem or recognize the fact that there is insufficient information given to solve a particular problem. Each question type gives five answer options from which to select. Verbal scores range from 0 to 60; however, scores below 9 or above 44 are rare. Reading comprehension passages can be anywhere from one to several paragraphs long. From the available answer options, the test taker should select the most effective construction that best expresses the intent of the sentence. Scores are given in increments of 10 e. The algorithm used to build a score is more complicated than that. The examinee can make a mistake and answer incorrectly and the computer will recognize that item as an anomaly. If the examinee misses the first question his score will not necessarily fall in the bottom half of the range. A test taker can also cancel a score online within the 72 hours after the scheduled exam start time. The GMAT may not be taken more than once within 16 days but no more than five times in a rolling month period and no more than eight times total, even if the scores are canceled. Official GMAT exam study materials are available on the mba. All applicants are required to present valid ID when taking the test. As of July, test takers were allowed to view their score before making this decision. Other available test preparation resources include university text books, GMAT preparation books, sample tests, and free web resources.

In each question, you are expected to provide multiple answers from the choice provided. This section has four different question types: In this, you are provided with loads of information in a table format. In this type, you are given a graph or a graphical image. Here you have to gather information by clicking on the various tabs provided. The data available may be presented either as text or in the form of charts, tables. You have a question and multiple choices provided. The answers in a table form have the two components occupying the first two columns and the answer options in the third column.
