His most recent book is Whole Earth Discipline: What we do at Edge meetings is to encourage our participants to ask each other the questions they are asking themselves. Stewart is not here to talk about his book, which he was questioning himself about four years ago. An era in which humans are running way too much of the atmosphere and everything else badly. We only have the choice of terraforming well. His new book, is titled Whole Earth Discipline: He graduated in Biology from Stanford and served as an Army Infantry officer. That was 60 years ago. Because things have switched around. That would be nice. So, in light of that, some different things are green than they used to be, back when the modern environmental movement took shape in the s. Well, the thing that happened with the cities The reason is that cities are population sinks. And as we get to 80 percent of population of the world living in cities, we get into this negative, below level-keeping birthrate, and then carry right on down. Kevin Kelly is pretty persuaded that, by the second half of this century, we will have a population crisis. Because the villages of the world are emptying out. Where people are going is where the action is. Mostly squatter cities, slums. A billion people in slums now. Another billion are expected in the next few decades. And instead of being squashed by poverty, in these places, people are busy as hell getting out of poverty just as fast as they can. They are basically entrepreneurs. They operate of the informal economy. And they create their own homes, their own towns, their own economies, bit by bit. Demographers are saying, city planners are saying, that basically squatters are the major builders of cities in the world these days. They are getting out of poverty, gradually. And, they are moving toward the energy patterns of developed cities that we have here. So places like Darby, in Mumbai, soon enough are going to look like downtown London. Everybody in the global south is tired of being sweaty all the time. They are going to get air conditioners. So they need grid electricity, baseload electricity, electricity that is always on. So far, the only clean forms of electricity come from hydro and nuclear, that feed into baseload. Basically square miles for one gigawatt of electricity. Same thing with solar. In California, a whole lot of people want to put a lot of solar, quite rightly, in the Mojave Desert. Well, the Mojave Desert is a green desert. And, when you bulldoze it for solar farms, it gets pretty rough. Bill Gates makes a nice distinction between energy farms, using very dilute sources of energy, like wind, biofuels and solar, and energy factories that are very

concentrated, like coal, gas and nuclear. To a certain extent, those concentrated factories are greener than the things that are big and wide and using up too much space. And the thing that an environmentalist wants to do is compare the waste streams. So, the waste stream of But look at what happens with the coal waste, and the electrical waste from nuclear. But, one gigawatt a day from a coal-fired plant is turning 8, tons of fuel into 19, tons of carbon dioxide, plus all the slurry and mercury and all the rest of it. Environmentalists are always worried about nuclear waste. How are we going to bury it? And that salt formation is miles in circumference. It has been there for million years. The salt heels in around it and encases it. So, the nuclear waste problem that I thought was insoluble has actually been solved long ago. From the technology standpoint, which this group should be interested in, the usual reactor these days, like from Areva or Westinghouse, is 1. But there are starting to be these small modular reactors that are down around 25 megawatts, and a fraction of that. And then, Oregon has one called New Scale. These things are all modulars. The idea is, you can get one, run part of the electricity with it in your time, build on another and another and another. The makers of all of the nuclear reactors the Navy uses in the U. The Tennessee Valley Authority. This design, from Intellectual Ventures, is meant to be put in place, run for 60 years, and then just left there. It is its own varial wall. So is solar and wind and all these other things. The problem is that coal is expensive. And this is where governments come in. Basically, the governments of Europe, North America, China and India have to find a way to make coal expensive. And if they do that, then we have a shot. I especially am interested to see in Europe that GM is green, genetically modified crops. Turned out to be green. But, among the people who picked up on them, and Kevin Kelly reported this, is the Amish. The most technologically conservative farmers group in America love this, because, as many farmers have found, they are better seeds. Environmentalists, for wrong reasons, took a stance against genetic engineering at the beginning. These things turned out to be green by accident, instead of by design. They can be a lot greener than they have, but we have stood in the way of golden rice in Asia, and we have stood in the way of Africa moving ahead with much better tropical crops, designed and made by engineering. The moral issue, according to the New Field Counsel on Bioethics, is that there is a moral obligation to make GM technology available to everybody, especially in the developing world, that wants it. One of the reasons is that we first had things that are good for farmers. So, cassava, which is a staple for million people, is actually a dreadful food. All it is is starch. And so it goes.

Instructions to the Twelve Tribes Key Scriptures: Deuteronomy 31, Matthew If your classroom is normally set up in a certain way, undo as much of it as you can. You may also want to leave the lights off â€" whatever you can do to make the room uncomfortable for class. Come to class five minutes later than the bulk of your students. Ask students what they thought when they entered the room. Have them explain the choices they made for getting or not getting the room ready for class. When you think of synonyms for someone who is a self-starter, you may think of words like doer, dynamo, active, hard worker, busy. Notice they are all very active words. In fact someone who is a self-starter is like a spark plug. They may have instructions for what they need to do or just notice something that needs to be done. Instead of waiting to be told and reminded to do it, they just start to work. They may even spark others to get involved, like the spark plugs in a car get it going. A self-starter initiates action. A Christian self-starter initiates godly actions, but how does God let us know in what areas He wants us to be self-starters? What are some things Joshua and the people are told God wants them to do? God says He will be with them, but does it seem like He expects them to get started on doing what He is outlining here without be reminded multiple times first? What makes you say that? Before Jesus went back to Heaven after the Resurrection, he gave instructions to his disciples â€" and us. What were those instructions? Do you think Jesus expected us to wait until he reminded us over and over again to start doing what he asked us to do? Why or why not? Being a Christian who is a self-starter has two parts to it. The first is to go ahead and start doing the specific things God has asked us to do. So what are some of the specific things God has asked us to do? Of course, the list within each category could be longer, but focusing on these basic areas can help you be a self-starting Christian in doing the things God has asked us to do. Why is it important to be a self-starter in our belief? Why is it important to be a self-starter in our repentance? Why is our doing both of them important to God? Why is it important for us to be self-starters in confession? Why is it important for us to be self-starters regarding our own baptism and teaching others about baptism? Do good works and share our faith with others. Why is it important to be a self-starter in doing good works and sharing our faith? How can we become better at noticing when God is giving us an opportunity to serve Him? What can we do to be more of a self-starter in this area? The book of Acts is full of stories of self-starters â€" the early Christians. Some were Apostles, some were just followers of Jesus who were serving God in various ways. At times, the Holy Spirit gave them pretty direct instructions, but often those people in Acts had to do what we do â€" notice the opportunities God gives us. Have students flip through Acts and find a few examples where people took advantage of opportunities God gave them to serve others and share their faith. How do you think the people in Acts were able to notice all of these opportunities? Do you think we have similar opportunities today? Do we always take advantage of them? Why is it hard for some Christians to be self-starters in serving others and sharing their faith? What can you do to become more aware of the opportunities God gives you and more of a self-starter in taking advantage of them? Review the main points of the lesson. Explain that while every area of a Christian life benefits from being a self-starter, the Church would be larger, stronger and healthier if we were all better at being self-starters in noticing the opportunities God gives us to serve Him and taking advantage of them. Depending upon your space and your students, you may wish to take your students outside of the classroom for this activity. It may be easier for them to participate if they are seeing actual needs or things that will spark ideas in their minds and hearts. Explain that God gives each of us different opportunities to serve Him. Some of us will have the some of the same opportunities and some of us will have very unique opportunities. The hard part is often even noticing them when God gives them to us. They can work silently for awhile or you can discuss things as you walk. What

you want to do is get them to start noticing needs that God may want them to fill. Make sure they notice the little things as well as the big things. Brainstorm ways they can be self-starters in meeting some of these needs. Challenge them to notice an opportunity God gives them to serve Him this week and take advantage of it â€" become a self-starter. You may wish to have some students share their experiences during your next class. Read some of the stories in the book of Acts. How were the people in the story self-starters? Did someone have to pester them to do what God wanted them to do in the situation? Look around you carefully for the next few days. What opportunities is God giving you? Are you being a self-starter in taking advantage of them? What do you need to do to be more aware of these opportunities from God and to take advantage of them?
