Marshall in sparking the California Gold Rush, the small town now known as Placerville was known as Dry Diggins after the manner in which the miners moved cartloads of dry soil to running water to separate the gold from the soil. Later in , the town earned its most common historical name, Hangtown, due to the numerous hangings that had taken place there. By , the temperance league and a few local churches had begun to request that a more friendly name be bestowed upon the town. The name was not changed until when the City of Placerville was incorporated. At its incorporation Placerville was the third largest town in California. In the county seat was then moved from Coloma to Placerville, where it remains today. The town had many services, including transportation of people and goods , lodging, banking, and had a market and general store. The track was abandoned in the s. The Camino, Placerville and Lake Tahoe Railroad now abandoned also operated an 8-mile shortline that operated between Camino, California and Placerville until June 17, As of March 29, , 52 miles of the right-of-way have been purchased by the city of Folsom, and eighteen miles of track have been restored. Plans are under consideration for a tourist excursion train along the route. Placerville is nicknamed "Old Hangtown" due to the fact that many people were hanged in the late s. Its called " The Devils Stomping Grounds" Arden - Helens Mt - On Helens Mt supposedly there was a fire and this lady was burned and they buried her there and if you go out at night and call Helen 3 times supposedly a fire ball will come flying out and do something to you. Vanderbilt died from complications from a surgery he had for appendicitis. His wife was extremely upset. So late at nights, in the Library, she would sit in front of the large marble fireplace, and talk with George. Though he was never really there. Her servants started to think she was losing her mind. To this day late at night you can still hear her voice very softly talking with George. One of his favorite rooms in the mansion. During rainy late nights, George would sit and read. A headless orange cat has been seen by numerous visitors roaming the area between the Gardens and the Bass pond. The Pool Room is also a focal point of unexplainable events. The sound of people swimming echoes throughout the entire lower floor in the dead of night. Insane laughter can be heard coming from the drain at the bottom of the pool. It is said to be haunted by a lady in black. Employees report hearing footsteps on the second floor. Odds are, there will only be 3 or 4 people touring with you. Asheville - Chicken Alley - The legendary ghost of Dr. Jamie Smith, who lived at this infamous Asheville locale known as "Chicken Alley" over a century ago. For decades, countless sightings of his ghost have been reported. The close vicinity known as Chicken Alley has been victim to his ghost for over one hundred years! You can see her and hear her late at night. Several guests and employees have had several encounters with her. She is known to tickle toes at night while visitors are attempting to sleep. She is said to be the wife of the famous writer Fitzgerald. When you get close to room , it seems to get cold. You can usually here doors slamming, laughter, and talking from rooms that are not used. Helen was so crushed by the loss she hung herself from the bridge right down the road from the castle. On Halloween night go to the bridge and try to conjure Helen. Asheville - Jackson Building - You can see a face in one of the top windows, thought to be the face of a man who committed suicide after loosing everything during the great depression. Individuals who worked the morning shift in the pantry refused to go in alone because a man who was murdered there was known to reveal himself in spirit form to employees. Asheville - Reed House - the sounds of pool being played can be heard. Asheville - Shiloh - Abandoned Forestry Compound - There is a building in the compound which has all the windows boarded up. The downstairs consists of a long dark hallway with doors alternating on either side. In one downstairs bathroom there is a toilet filled with blood. Upstairs there is a room used by a now dead prostitute. This building is nicknamed the "Whorehouse" for that reason. Even when the temperature outside is 70 degrees, it barely reaches 40 degrees inside. Strange noises are heard by people who live in the Shiloh neighborhood, and lights have been seen as well. There are other buildings in the compound, and their doors are open and closed at random. There is a length of rope hanging from the rafters in one building. Atlantic Beach - Fort Macon - There is said to believe that civil war ghosts haunt the top of the fort and watch for the union soldiers to attack. And there have been accounts on which during World War 2 the main gate was closed on it own while the guards were keeping watch on the place. Many of the students say that on the four floor at night while they are in their rooms they can hear balls bouncing. Also the security guards have reported the lights coming back on

by themselves after they have been turned off. Students also say that they have come into their rooms to find their clothes thrown everywhere. The ghost is a little girl named Emily who died of an illness while in the hospital. She also haunts the library on campus. Belwood - Kadesh Church - For years people have been hearing organ music coming from inside the church when no one is inside. Bentonville - Bentonville Battleground - Gunfire and shouting can be heard on the battleground and around the trenches at night, and there are countless stories of the plantation house being haunted by those who died there - including a little girl who died of tuberculosis and is said to still haunt one of the upstairs rooms. Bessemmer City - Tryon Elementary School - Sights of boys reflection in 4th and 5th Grade bathroom mirror beside one of the girls. She has also been reported seen walking on the 3rd floor. I have walked on the 3rd floor and just get shivers up my back. You can feel something in the air. Student assistants have reported being followed by unknown footsteps when on their rounds after midnight. People have also claimed that the lights will suddenly turn off in halls and you can feel someone brush against you. You can also hear whispering voices in the hallway. Also assorted residents have reported seeing a girl dressed in white in their rooms and others have had small items in their rooms rearranged daily. Boone - Perkinsville Dr. The road is Perkinsville drive, follow the road to the last house on the left, you have to look hard. The house is hidden by trees and over growth. Supposedly a man died due to un-natural causes and haunts that house. Mostly footsteps are heard, a strong feeling of non-welcome, and an angry banging on the up stairs floor. Has burnt down Boone - Tiwanna Fatz Restaurant - Tiwanna Fatz restaurant was active with people for some time before it partially burnt down, there was a little girl who died in the fire. The part of the restaurant was rebuilt. Brown Mountain near Grandfather Mountain - The Brown Mountain lights appear along the ridge of the mountain, moving erratically. They are best seen from a distance; they disappear as you climb the mountain. No one knows what they are, but the sightings have gone on for so long that the Cherokees who inhabited the area have stories about them. Brown Mountain - Blue Ridge Parkway - At two different places on the blue ridge parkway you can see the brown mountain lights. There are two stories to this one. At night when it was safe the women would go out and look for there husbands with big bright torches but they were killed to so now they keep looking forever. Brunswick - Leland - Mt. Misery Road - Mt. Back in the time when people owned slaves. The slave ships would dock at the river and march the slaves up Mt. Misery 90 miles to Fayetteville, many died of heat exhaustion. It is said now late at night you can hear the sound of chains and moans as the slave marched. Brunswick County - Brunswick Inn Southport - There a ghost named Tony who was a riverboat musician in life is said to roam the halls of the inn. Burlington - Williams High School - It is said that a girl was stood up on prom night, and she got to the top of the school and jumped. When you drive down the road between the football field and the back of the school, the top sign at the end of the street bleeds. Cabarrus County - Mt. Camp Lejuene Marine Base - It is said that if you are driving through the back gate of the marine base at night, you will see a woman in white walking along the road. The guards in the guard shack have heard many strange noises. It is believed that the woman was killed in a car accident. It disappeared when the Marine turned on the light. The Marine had a bruise the next morning. Caroleen - Caroleen Bridge - When you drive by the bridge on rainy nights you can see two elderly sisters trying to walk home. These two sisters where killed in an auto accident when they where nearing the bridge and ran over the side. When you stop to pick them up they will get into your car and disappear once you cross the bridge as if they where never even there.

Lights flicker, strange sounds, presences felt, etc. Reports of little girl crying and sobbing I do not know the Culmerville Hotel history: Allentown - Cedar Crest College - Butz hall - many times students claim there is a ghost they have named "Wanda. Many students living in the dorm complain about being locked out of their rooms, alarm clocks going off for no reason. It is said that if you see her, she has no facial features. Allentown - Constitution Drive - Reports of an apparition of a man that walks with 2 dogs that have red glowing eyes. Believed to be the owner of the dogs, he was run over by a train losing a leg and bleeding to death. Allentown - Good Shepherd Home - elevators open and close, and spirits come by dressed in clothes of the person religion who has just recently died, it is also said the Ghost of Mother Raker haunts the hallways, because the place use to be an orphanage. She stands late at night with a vacant look in her eyes. One student took a picture of the tree and a face of an old man appeared in the image. Allentown - King George Inn - Believed to be haunted by a ghost named Charlie, who likes to bother people working in the kitchen, drops utensils and moves things around. Allentown - King George Inn - Several ghosts reportedly haunt this place. A woman and young child can be seen in the basement, along with a man wearing Revolutionary War type clothing. Allentown - Mosser Elementary School - there are complaints of a shadow to walk up and down the stairwells mostly on the second floor stairways! There are noises and screams that students here mostly on the third floor! People say a girl jumped out of the third floor window and haunts the school ever since! Feelings of being watched. Altoona - Baker Mansion - This mansion is said to be haunted by the matriarch of the family. Tours are given and during the Halloween season, midnight tours. Some say they have seen the woman that roams the house. Altoona - horseshoe curve- in the tunnel if you flash your lights three times and shut everything off you can hear people laughing and shadows of people walking beside your car. Altoona - Lakemont park - At the completion of the roller coaster a Maintenance worker was killed by a coaster car during a test run. To this day people say they see him working on the track while they are riding the roller coaster. Altoona - Sinking valley - Fort Roberdeau - Legend says a guard was guarding the fort when an Indian attacked and killed him they also found the body of a young boy and the boys dog. This is a reconstructed fort of the original. Road to fort there are 2 fields on each side of the raod on the right side of the road there are telephone poles sit at the 3rd pole at dark and look straight ahead there a guard of the fort was killed and he still patrols to this day. The guard is a black shadow. The dog is a white ball of fog that appears out of no where. Altoona - Wapsonnock Mountain - Beulah Road - This legend is a cross between the spectral hitchhiker stories you have heard before and the sort of "Resurrection Mary" type tales familiar to the Chicago area. For historical background there used to be a hotel at the top of the Wopsonnock Mountain that was a fairly common getaway for people in Altoona. The Wopsonnock hotel and famous lookout burned in the early part of the 20th century and was never rebuilt. In fact, at one time it was serviced by a narrow gauge railroad know as the "Alley Popper" although that has nothing to do with this tale. The road heading up to the Wopsy Lookout as it is known hereabouts is now Juniata Gap road in Altoona. Apparently in the early part of the century a couple was married and was heading

to the hotel at the lookout for their honeymoon. I know nothing of the father chasing them which is related to the Ebensburg tale you have given. Both were apparently killed but the body of the husband was never recovered. Since then travelers on this road have encountered the specter of a woman in white, sometimes seen to be carrying a candle, who apparently is looking for something. Apparently this spirit has also been seen on the road leading up the mountain where the lookout can be accessed from the other direction, Buckhorn Mountain, and she is also known as the "White Lady of the Buckhorn" as well as the "White Lady of Wopsononock". She apparently got into the car and he could not see her in the rear view mirror but could see her when he turned around. Much like Resurrection Mary, it is a difficult tale to dispute since it has occurred so often to so many people over such a long stretch of time. Although the historical details are sketchy! No one knows who she was or when the accident actually took place. If you ever get a chance to get to this area take a trip on either road and you may get a chance to run into her. There were a few horrifying events that took place here. An unexplained explosion killed many that haunt the place. A ghost of a woman that was beaten to death by her husband stands at the top of the second floor stairs, and is reported to not like men. Legend has it that an old settler, who had gambled away all of his money, came home one night and could not feed his dogs. He took them off on a wild chase in which he led them to the iron furnace. He then burned them alive. On a clear fall night, one can hear the squealing of dogs by the furnace. Barton Brook - Benson home - There are several hauntings at this location. One ghost is of someone who has ethnic features, somewhat of a servant looking, perhaps a black servant, not sure. The living residents of a house heard a party going on downstairs. Wishing to investigate, they head down stairs. This house had a sealed up staircase it had its own room. When they got to the door, they could hear people talking and smell coffee. As they opened the door, the smell and sound disappeared. It reappeared when they returned to their beds. The desk was also said to contain a spirit which opened and closed drawers. A small animal is said to have darted out of the woods, spooking the horses and causing the buggy to roll off the road and into the creek. The bride died from a broken neck and the groom was pinned under a horse who had become lame and slowly died next to his new bride. It is said by many locals that on very dark nights a fog creeps up onto the road which is more of a dirt lane and you can hear a horse drawn buggy fast approaching behind you, but before it comes upon you there is a crash, a scream, then all is silent and the fog vanishes. Beaverdale - Heathers Pool Hall - not too long ago a girl was raped and murdered on the steps of the pool hall because of drugs and if you walk up those steps you will get a cold chill and you will walk away high. Late at night on a rainy night if you go down on the train tracks where her car landed and stand there in the darkness, you can see her walking down the train tracks in a white dress. Bedford - Bedford Springs Hotel - on taking photographs of this historic site, various forms of ghostly images appear throughout the hotel. Bedford - Jean Bonnet Inn - Reports of cold spots, strange lights, anomalies showing up on film, and apparitions. It was there that he supposedly had a French spy hanged. This was then used as a frontier courtroom where several people were hanged. These restless spirits are responsible for a multitude of supernatural activities at the inn. Furst died in a fire in his barn, while trying to save his animals. Furst enjoyed smoking cigars and staff at the restaurant say that when most of the customers are gone you can smell cigar smoke, or chairs will move on their own. One of the waitresses has even said once she had locked the door, and had gone over and it was unlocked. Benango County - Pittsville - When you are camping there, you can here voices in your pillow and you can here girls and babies screaming or crying all around you and no one will be around your campsite. You can also see and hear things getting thrown and things disappear until you leave. Sometimes when you are trying to sleep you will hear or see things moving shadows and also sometimes hear them getting into your cars. Story goes that he tested his kite here a few times. Sightings have been seen of Ben flying his kite. Also in the woods is a trench from a war. If you go back in the trench late at night you can hear battle noises. Bensalem - Strayer College - formerly Eastern State School and Hospital - Rumored to be haunted due to unfair treatment and killing of patients. If you go into patients rooms the doors will slam shut and trap you in. When you walk down the halls you can sometimes see a figure following you of a man. Mysterious 4th floor said to be life threatening and extremely haunted. If you go into the morgue its very cold and feels like theres a fan on you with no windows in site. Bensalem - Target Neshaminy - The electronics stockroom is rumored to be haunted by an old indian burial ground beneath its floor. Employees

have seen boxes move on their own, felt freezing cold air, and disturbing presences when left alone inside the room overnight. Bentleyville - Bentworth Elementary Center - When the school was being built two years ago a roofer fell off the roof and died. Some students have reported seeing a strange man walking along the roof. The night janitors have reported hearing someone walking on the second floor and the roof. People reported many happenings, noises, lights turning of etc.

In , the fort was designated a national park and was re-designated as a National Monument and Historic Shrine in . Many witnesses have claimed to see the apparitions of soldiers in uniform. The home was added to the U. National Register of Historic Places in November of and was opened to the public as a historic house museum in . Stories say that the home is haunted, possibly by two different families. One being The Hammonds, who lived in the home in the s, and The Downins, who resided there during the Civil War-era. Haunting reports at the museum include voices, disembodied footsteps and lights that turn off by themselves. Some say the Downin children are to blame for a doll that moves around, and the reason why cameras tend to not work properly inside the home. The Burr arch bridge was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in and is a popular hot spot for paranormal activity. The ghosts that are said to linger here are believed to be Civil War soldiers or slaves and witnesses have claimed to see their bodies hanging from the rafters when you enter the bridge. A ghostly woman has also been spotted walking along the bridge wearing old-fashioned clothing. More than , people visit the park each year, and many witnesses have claimed the area is haunted. Due to its history, ghostly soldiers are known to linger here in spirit and there have been reports of phantom gunfire and shouts, drum beats and war songs that have been heard playing. The two-story brick building was designed by Joseph Horatio Anderson, a noted architect of his time, and is believed to be full of ghostly spirits. Witnesses have claimed to see a Revolutionary soldier wandering around the grounds, as well as a man who hangs out on the dome, believed to be a worker who fell to his death. There have been a number of haunting reports at the restaurant, and Only In Your State wrote an article on the location, calling it the most haunted restaurant in Maryland. Reports include the sound of broken clocks chiming, disembodied footsteps throughout the building and apparitions. Some say the place is haunted because it was once a brothel that was a violent place, and stories of murder and suicide have floated around as well. It first opened in September of and was deactivated in . It has been known to be associated with paranormal activity and has been featured on a number of television shows due to its haunting claims. Many believe the hauntings stem from shipwrecks and bodies that have been found washed ashore. Some of the ghosts here include that of a Confederate soldier who runs across the road at dusk, an elderly woman who is search of her grave, and a lighthouse keeper that likes to sing at night. It was the largest private home in American when its construction was completed in and considered to be one of the finest examples of Georgian architecture in the U. The home was added to the National Register of Historic Places in and is said to be haunted by more than just one ghost. Her apparition has been seen throughout the home, along with the ghost of Cygney Swann, a resident of the home in the s, and daughter of Governor Swann. Her spirit is also known to play the harpsichord in her room. Tom is another ghost of the Hampton Mansion, believed to be a former butler. Other spirits are said to reside here, but their identities are unknown. The room home sits on nine acres of land was added to the National Register of Historic Places in October of . Many believe that the hauntings that occur at the home are linked to Clara herself, and that she still lingers the home in spirit. Its goal was to help preserve and illustrate the history of Baltimore County for the benefit of present and future generations of Marylanders. Legend has it that almost years ago, a brother and his seven sisters were living in the hills outside the city. For reasons no one has ever known, one night the brother came home palm-twitching mad, poisonous thoughts swirling through his mind. Slipping deeper and deeper into psychosis, the darkness finally overtook him, and unimaginably, he dragged each one of his innocent sisters to a separate hilltop and hung them all. The story goes that one night, a jogger was out on a solo run on Riverdale Road, which leads to a popular hilltop overlook with a great view of the city lights. Out of the quiet night came a speeding car, careening into the jogger, who was left to die alone in the darkness on the side of the road. Forever restless and angry at his fate, they say the jogger haunts this back road, looking for his killer in every passing car. If you find yourself an hour north of Chicago, driving past White Cemetery, maybe keep driving. The spirits there have been known to wander outside the gates since the s. Hazy figures lingering beside the trees and near the perimeter of the cemetery are a common occurrence out there too. Described as a six feet tall, bearded, red-headed man, with dark lifeless eyes, he matches the description of a victim who years ago died in a terrible crash on that stretch of road. One woman talks about her encounter with the red-headed hitchhiker, remembering that when she stopped for him, as he reached for her door handle he suddenly evaporated and then her car engine died. Many folks in town will tell you to never, under any circumstances, drive Route 44 with anything less than a full car because one of the most common ways to see this phantom hitchhiker is in your rearview mirror as he appears in the backseat. Just as you look up and see him staring at you, he disappears, but then all by itself your car radio will start scanning stations so fast and loud that your car will begin to shake. Anyone up for a little New England road trip? Stretching 84 feet across Elk Creek, the Gudgeonville Bridge claimed its first life a little over years ago. Legend says that a farmer named Obadiah Will was delivering a mule to a nearby farm when the animal suddenly began acting strange. It led Obadiah down the road to the entrance of the covered bridge, but stopped short, unwilling to cross. Frustrated, the farmer snapped the reins a few times to get the mule moving, but to no avail. The balking mule refused to take another step. Unable to turn around on the narrow bridge or to go forward, Obadiah grew more and more enraged, flogging the poor beast until he literally beat him to death.
