The people cried to God then, and He heard their cry and provided a remedy -- "the serpent lifted up. The remedy was for everyone that is bitten then. The remedy is for whoever believes today. In their remedy they received both forgiveness for sins and healing for their bodies. In Christ, we receive both forgiveness for our sins and healing for our sick bodies. We are not to look to the symptoms of our sins and diseases today, but to our remedy, Christ. There is only one condition for receiving the remedy: Surely they, through only a "type" of Christ, could not receive more blessings than we can receive today through Christ Himself. God promises protection for our bodies as well as for our spirits, if we live in Him. Ps 91 In the New Testament, John wishes "above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers. Asa died in his sickness because he "sought not the Lord, but to the physicians" 2 Chron. If Christ has borne our sicknesses, why should we bear them? Sickness is revealed as coming directly from Satan. Christ, in His earthly ministry, always treated sin, diseases, and devils the same. They were all hateful in His sight. He rebuked them all. He was manifested to destroy them all. Jesus does not want the "works of the devil" to continue in our physical bodies. He was manifested to destroy them. He does not want cancer, a plague, a curse, "the works of the devil," to exist in His own members. Sickness destroys; therefore, it is not from God. Christ came to save us Greek: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. His sicknesses are the thieves of happiness, health, money, time, and effort. Christ came to give us abundant life in our spirits and in our bodies. We are promised the life of Jesus in "our mortal flesh" 2 Cor. Bad things come from Satan. Good things come from God. Sickness is, therefore, from Satan. Health is, therefore, from God. All authority and power of all devils and diseases was given to every disciple of Christ. The right to pray and receive the answer is given to every believer, John It includes everyone who is sick. The ministry of healing was given to "the seventy," who represent the future workers of the Church. Jesus said that He would continue His same works through believers while He is with the Father. This certainly includes healing the sick. The bread is eaten "in remembrance" of His body on which were laid our diseases and the stripes by which "we are healed" 1 Cor. Jesus said that certain teachers were "making the word of God of no effect through their tradition" Mark 7: Human ideas and theories have for centuries hindered the healing part of the gospel from being proclaimed and acted upon as it was by the early Church. One tradition is that God wills some of His children to suffer sickness and that, therefore, many who are prayed for are not healed, because it is not His will to heal them. If sickness is the will of God, then every physician would be a lawbreaker, every trained nurse a defier of the Almighty, and every hospital a house of rebellion instead of a house of mercy. The gospel says "he healed them all. Christ never refused those who sought His healing.

Repeatedly, the Gospels tell us that He healed them all. Christ the healer has never changed. Only one person in the entire Bible ever asked for healing by saying, "If it be Your will. If sickness glorifies God more than healing, then any attempt to get well by natural or divine means would be an effort to rob God of the glory that we should want Him to receive. If sickness glorifies God, then we should rather be sick than well. If sickness glorifies God, Jesus robbed His Father of all the glory that He possibly could by healing everyone, and the Holy Spirit continued doing the same throughout the Acts of the Apostles. Paul says, "For ye are bought with a price: Our bodies and spirits are bought with a price. We are to glorify God in both. We do not glorify God in our spirit by remaining in sin. We do not glorify God in our body by remaining sick. If God wanted some of His children to suffer, then Jesus relieved us from bearing something which God wanted us to bear. That would mean that faith does not come by hearing the Word of God alone, but by getting a special revelation that God has favored you and wills to heal you. That means we would have to pray until He speaks directly to us about each case in particular. When we read what He promises to do, we then know what it is His will to do. This is VERY important! Faith for spiritual healing comes by hearing the gospel: We are to preach the gospel "that He bore our sicknesses" to every creature. This promise is for all. Healing is for all. Otherwise Christ should have qualified His promise when He said: Healing, therefore, is included in the whatever. This promise is made to you. Call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord: This promise is for all, including you, if you are sick. Paul tells us that God would have us "prepared to every good work" 2 Tim. A sick person cannot measure up to these scriptures. These conditions would be impossible if healing is not for all. Either healing is for all, or the Scriptures do not apply to all. His promise is that He is "plenteous in mercy to all that call on Him" Ps. That includes you, today. Christ was "made to be sin for us" 2 Cor. He was "made a curse for us" Gal. He healed them all. Traditionally some people have believed that if we are righteous, we should expect sicknesses as part of our life. They quote the scripture: It means trials, hardships, persecutions and temptations, but never sicknesses or physical disabilities. It would be a contradiction to say, "Christ has borne our sicknesses, and with His stripes we are healed," but then to add, "Many are the sicknesses of the righteous, which He requires us to bear. People quote the scripture, "Is any among you afflicted?"

Christians need never be sick, any more than they need to be sinful. Why is disease such a persistent enemy? Three Million Believed The only reason those three million Israelites became well and strong was that they believed what God said: That was said to them, and they believed it. The only reason disease takes such a toll among Christians today is that many do not believe what God has spoken. They know that God said, I am the Lord who heals you. Somehow they have failed to believe that He meant what He said, which is basically what Satan said to Adam and Eve: God did not mean what he said. The greatest barrier to the faith of many seeking healing in our day is the uncertainty in their minds as to it being the will of God to heal all. Nearly everyone knows that God does heal some, but there is much in modern theology that prevents people from knowing what the Bible clearly teaches - that healing is provided for all. It

is impossible to boldly claim by faith a blessing which we are not sure God offers, because the blessings of God can be claimed only where the will of God is known, trusted, and acted upon. Suppose a lady would say, "My husband, who was very rich, has passed away. I wish I " I would say to her, "Why do you not read his will and see? Since it is His last will and testament, anything later is forgery. Jesus is not only the testator who died; but He was resurrected and is also the mediator of the will. He is our advocate, and He will not beat us out of our inheritance, as some earthly advocates might do. He is our representative at the right hand of God. Growing up in the latter half of the s, he saw his large family struggling through the depression years. In , when Osborn was six years old, his father moved the family to Skedee, Oklahoma , in search of another, more profitable farm. Osborn frequently went with Roberts to help with evangelical meetings. Roberts did most of the preaching, Osborn did everything else, including playing the accordion and the piano for the musical part of the meetings. He dropped out of high school after completing eighth grade and hit the road with E. Dillard, a traveling evangelist. Osborn was responsible for organising evangelistic meetings and was also in charge of youth services in the evening. He traveled with Dillard through three states. It was and he was only 17 when he fell instantly in love. He was 18, and she was only Shortly thereafter, they set out on a life of ministry and missionary travel, including a trip to India when Osborn was still only In time, they carried the Gospel of Christ to tens of millions of people all over the world, declaring it with faith and confidence. Their ministry lasted less than a year in India, and they returned home because of critical family sickness. In , the Osborns had their only daughter, LaDonna Osborn b. March 13 of that year; she was raised accompanying her parents on the platforms of global mass miracle evangelistic crusades. The Osborns first gained public notice shortly after returning from India, as evangelists on the Big Tent Revival circuit in the United States and Canada. There, they preached to audiences often numbering over 10,, in open-air meetings and under large tents in settings such as fairgrounds and stadiums. Allen , were also on the circuit. The Osborns emphasised the love and compassion of God, rather than the "fire and brimstone" commonly used by evangelists of the era, and they practiced supernatural healing in their meetings. By the early s, their emphasis began to shift more and more toward international missions. They held large crusades in Latin America, Asia, and Africa and crowds grew rapidly, at times exceeding , Together, Osborn and Hickey prayed for the sick and she became a guest speaker at his conferences. He was lifelong friends with her family until his death just four months after Hickey lost her husband, Wallace. Over the course of the next five decades, Osborn and his team traveled to more than 70 countries and reached millions of people. They created prolific quantities of evangelistic and training materials, some of which were translated into more than 80 languages. Thereafter, he continued to travel and conduct crusades around the world for another 15 years. Osborn died on February 14, , at the age of According to his daughter, LaDonna, he had been in good health until his body began weakening just a few days before he stopped breathing. He was interred next to his wife at the Memorial Park Cemetery in Tulsa, Oklahoma the same cemetery where Oral Roberts had been interred nearly four years earlier. Osborn was survived by his daughter, three of four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. LaDonna Osborn continues to operate the ministry founded by her parents, including leading international crusades in the developing world every year. Such things were the result of sin; personal sin, and sins committed against others. SATAN is the source of all disease. That is the bad news. But the Good News is: Through Christ, God has already provided the total cure Often, in His dealings with a diseased person, Jesus simply cast out a spirit, and they were healed. Every disease has a life, a germ. Its source is Satan because it destroys. Jesus said, The thief Satan comes to steal, and kill, and destroy. When that germ, or life, leaves our body, then our body will die. It decays and returns to dust. Likewise, when the spirit of a disease leaves, the disease dies, and it will decay and disappear. It must obey us. When it leaves, the disease dies, and the effects vanish. For example, a cancer has life in it. That life is evil, of the devil, because it destroys and kills. Then the cancer is dead. It will decay, and be removed, and the sick person recovers. A tip to help your faith: Farmers cut a deep groove around a tree to kill it. Though its leaves do not wither instantly, it is bound to die. So it is with disease. Jesus gave believers power to rebuke all evil spirits, and they will die. Perhaps some symptoms, like the leaves, may not go immediately, but when we have rebuked the life of the disease in faith, we know that the sickness has been destroyed from the root, and all symptoms will disappear. The surest way to receive health for your body, is to accept the Healer into your heart. After you receive Christ as Saviour, you can receive His healing for your body. He wants to forgive your sins AND heal your body Some people pray for healing, but refuse to accept Christ as Saviour, and get nothing. However, others whilst thanking Christ for saving them, are healed in their bodies before they even ask! Who forgives all your sins, and heals all your diseases. You may need healing for your body, but have never had a definite experience of receiving Jesus Christ into your life, of being born again, saved. If so, now is the time to be saved. To Be Born Again: Admit you have sinned, and fallen short of the glory of God. Be willing to repent, because your sins have come between you and God. Receive Him as Saviour, and He will cleanse you from all unrighteous unrighteousness. Jesus said, You must be born again. Christ enters your heart and makes you a new creature because He lives within you. Accept Him, He is a person, not a religion. He is a reality, not a philosophy or a doctrine. He became a minister in a small Pentecostal Church of God and after a discouraging year in India as a missionary he returned sick and disappointed and settled into a small local church in McMinnville, Oregon, in The spark that lit the fire In the summer of William Branham held a campaign in Portland, Oregon. She convinced her husband that he should attend the next evening meeting. As I watched Brother Branham minister to the sick, I was especially captivated by the deliverance of a little deaf-mute girl over whom he prayed thus: When I witnessed this, there seemed to be a thousand voices speaking to me at once, all in one accord saying over and over, "You can do that. Early ministry Gordon Lindsay saw that Osborn was unusually gifted so provided the encouragement, finance and publicity to help him launch his own independent ministry the next spring. This meeting made history in that area. Enough funds were raised in the campaign to purchase the tent that had been used for the meeting. From that time on this evangelist had large audiences wherever he went in America. Overseas missions But his major ministry was overseas, where he increasingly turned his attention, working alongside Pentecostal missionaries. From the beginning of his ministry Osborn saw tremendous successes in foreign campaigns. In his first five years he conducted crusades in eleven countries and preached to millions. Early in his ministry he experienced revival in Cuba where over 50, professed conversion to Christ. In Chile, as many as , persons packed the stadium to attend a single service. Osborn wrote that he was moved by the "alarming challenge of the heathen masses everywhere dying without Christ" and felt "compelled by the Spirit" to "bear a miraculous gospel" to all the world. He partnered with many Pentecostal groups in this venture who valued his expertise and financial support. In , he began to publish his own magazine, Faith Digest and the Osborn ministry included seventeen workers, a modest building in Tulsa, and an impressive program of foreign mission work. Two years later, the ministry reported astonishing growth. Faith Digest, which had begun with a circulation of 12,, was being printed at a rate of , copies per month. Often amidst huge crowds numbering many tens of thousands Osborn developed the technique described as "praying for the sick en masse, thus eliminating the long healing lines and human limitations. Osborn still held overseas campaigns which often drew crowds of 10, to , persons. Osborn estimated that 14 invested in literature could save a soul and his organization was providing millions of pieces throughout the world.
