Doctors later said he suffered second and third degree burns over 90 percent of his body, but he still walked off the battlefield under his own power. Cashe was able to tell his family that he was glad that at least his men had been able to say "goodbye" to their families. Three hundred and forty-three firefighters and 60 police officers gave up their lives for what they truly believed in. In responding to the screams of people who were trapped inside the burning buildings, these brave heroes ran to, and entered a building they knew they may not exit.
