Format[ edit ] Zombie walks are relatively common in large cities, especially in North America. Some have been established as annual traditions, though others are organized as spontaneous flash mob events or performance art. The complexity and purpose of zombie walks varies. As an advanced technique to heighten interest and realism, some zombie mobs will "eat" victims to create new zombies, in sight of onlookers. Some events are staged as spoof political rallies organized "to raise awareness of zombie rights", with participants carrying placards. Gencon [ edit ] The earliest zombie walk styled event on record was put together rather last-minute at the Gen Con gaming convention in Milwaukee in August. The event was created to poke good-natured fun at the Vampire: The Masquerade LARPerS that were taking over large portions of the convention, and disrupt their games. Michael Yates, Mark Stafford, Jacob Skowronek and several others organized the event with roughly 60 participants. The event was later recorded in the book 40 Years of Gencon [4] with photos and recollections from the organizers. While it was rumored that the organizers were arrested and thrown out of the convention for their flash mob of zombies, they were simply questioned by security before being told to disband. In subsequent years, the Toronto Zombie Walk has grown tremendously in size, with the event playing host to more than 15, participants. Documentation of zombie walks consequently began to appear more often in mainstream news media [24] and blogs. Zombie walks soon spread across North America and to cities around the globe, such as Mar del Plata, Argentina. Apart from zombie walks, ZomBcon also features panel discussions with zombie authors, actors and artists, workshops, film screenings, and other activities for zombie fans. Guinness World Records certified that people participated in the walk. The event was organized by GameCity, and the zombies did dances to zombie-related songs such as "Thriller", "Disturbia", and "Ghostbusters", and featured a performance from American singer Jonathan Coulton. The event achieved a new official Guinness World Record for largest zombie walk. Guinness World Records officially recorded 3, zombies at the Red, White and Dead zombie event, [39] though local news claimed participants. There were 4, zombie mob participants. The walk was also a charity event helping to raise awareness and money for the Brain Foundation of Australia. Volunteers collected signatures from the crowd, though the record is currently unverified by Guinness. This is considered to be a low figure, as up to one third of the total participants did not walk through the counter. The crawl took place on October 23, , in downtown Denver at the 16th Street Mall. As with previous years, the event raised money for the Brain Foundation of Australia. Guinness recorded 4, zombies at the event, though organizers, police, and fire officials estimate more than 5, zombies were in attendance. Representatives from Guinness did not attend the event. On July 23, , the Dublin Zombie Walk [51] in Dublin had an estimated 8, zombies in attendance, but confirmation is still pending from Guinness World Records. October also saw multiple attempts to break the New Jersey world record. Estimates of the entire Twin Cities crawl put the zombie event upwards of 30, zombie participates, surpassing any other gathering of its kind, official or not. The zombies limped two kilometres along the Alameda, one of the main thoroughfares in the Chilean capital. Held during the Brazilian Carnival holidays, Curitiba is known to be not much fond of the famous Brazilian festivity preferring instead to host the Psycho Carnival rock festival in which the Zombie Walk was derived off. Many people from states who also do not like samba or the carnival associated acts go to Curitiba for the Zombie Walk and rock festivals around the city. Charity events[ edit ] Charity work continues to be a common component of zombie walks across the planet. The first large-scale zombie pub crawl was held in Minneapolis on October 15, The Minneapolis "Zombie Pub Crawl" has since become an annual event and attendance has grown exponentially; each year it takes place in a different area of the city. Zombie pub crawls are now a regular occurrence in cities all over the world. An offshoot of the non-zombie summer Handlebars and Bars bicycle pub crawl, this event began with about 40 riders in its debut, and has since grown exponentially. In , the event attracted over zombie bicyclists and featured indie-rock bands from the Milwaukee-Chicago corridor

as entertainment throughout the day. Many residents see the event as disruptive to the life of the neighborhood. Lawsuits led to cancellation of the event the next year.

### 2: StinkFest | event

This is our first real meeting, as we have only ever talked over the phone. I had been researching animal rescues around the country and she invited me to Cleveland for her annual fundraiser, Skunk Fest. Deb has been rescuing skunks in Ohio for 15 years and has been hosting the festival for just as many years. After her first skunk, Daisy became ill, she was given the opportunity to rescue a few skunks from a pet store. After gaining the correct permits, Deb and local veterinarian, Doctor Frank Krupka started drawing blood from the skunks to help determine why Daisy was sick. They published a few different case studies, which helped the breed blossom. I often look to buy the older ones at the auctions so I can bring them here to let them live out their lives. Deb Cipriani When I arrive at her home, Deb greets me outside and mentions that I just missed a group of wild turkeys walking through her front yard. She briefs me on the quiriness of her home, which doubles as the headquarters of her rescue group, Skunk Haven. As she walks me through her home, her passion for skunks is very evident. In every corner there are pictures of skunks that have passed, figurines and t-shirts but mostly, just real live skunks. Most of the skunks here have been rescued from homes or owners unable to care for them. As we tour the house, Deb describes her daily routine when it comes to caring for the skunks. It takes her about two hours not including preparation, twice a day, to feed them all and clean their bedding. They eat raw vegetables mixed with dog food and an occasional cheese treat. The night before Skunk Fest, I find a handful of skunks and their owners at my hotel participating in an early weigh in for the competition tomorrow. As everyone scurries around, longtime Skunk Fest attendee, Steve Yunecah, brings over his white raccoon, Taz. Many owners live within only a few hours of Cleveland, but some have traveled from states like Florida and Indiana. Domestic skunks are only legal in 18 states, and many have very strict regulations regarding them. Skunk Fest judges, Rick and Sheryl Hoeneise, drove from Michigan but left their pets behind because it is illegal to take a domestic skunk across the border of their home state. Michael is a truck driver based out of Iowa and often brings his skunks on the road for company. But I think everyone remembers me because of my skunk. The crowd is sparse at first as I walk through tents of vendors: Many attendees are parents and children who are there purely out of curiosity, while some enthusiasts are fully decked out in skunk attire and costumes. While owners finish up grooming and primping their pets, the judges prepare for the competition. The 20 or so skunks will be competing for prince and princess under one year of age and king and queen. Many skunk owners were exposed to the animal when they were younger. Longtime skunk memorabilia collector, Nina Berry drove from Indianapolis to get her annual fill of skunks. While most skunks just stand around or even went the wrong direction, the winner of the yard race clocks in at an impressive six seconds. As the afternoon rain approaches and vendors begin to tear down their tents, the results for the much anticipated overall competition are in. Ruben, an 8-year-old skunk owned by Robin Peterson from Jacksonville, Florida, is crowned king and 1-year-old Gidget, owned by Skunk Fest organizer Deb Cipriani, is crowned queen. As the downpour begins, the show ends. Members of Skunk Haven head back to the official hotel for a party and annual meeting complete with Jell-O shots, pizza and, of course, their skunks.

It is between 14 and 17 mm long, roughly the size of a U. Its abdominal edges and last two antennal segments have alternating broad light and dark bands. From May through August, adult females lay clusters of light green or yellow, elliptical-shaped eggs on the undersides of leaves figure 2. They usually produce one or two generations per year in cooler climates but can lay up to five generations per year in warmer climates. Newly hatched nymphs have dark red eyes and the abdomen is yellowish, mottled with black and red. Older nymphs figure 3 are darker with black and white bands on the legs and antennae. Similar to other stink bug species, all nymphs lack wings. Agricultural Significance The brown marmorated stink bug can be a serious agricultural pest and has been observed feeding successfully on numerous fruit, vegetable, and field crops including apples, apricots, Asian pears, cherries, corn field and sweet , grapes, lima beans, nectarines and peaches, peppers, tomatoes and soybeans. Physical damage to fruit includes pitting and scarring, sometimes leading to a mealy texture. This injury makes the fruit unmarketable as a fresh product and in severe cases can even render the crop unusable for processed products. In addition to physical damage, wounds caused by feeding can provide an entryway for disease to attack the host fruit or plant. In field crops, damage caused by brown marmorated stink bug is not usually evident immediately upon visual inspection. For instance, in corn the stink bugs feed through the husk, piercing kernels and sucking out the juice resulting in shriveled kernels. Stink bug feeding in soybeans is similar to corn, where the bugs pierce the pods and suck juices out of the seeds. Managing this pest species is challenging because there are currently few effective pesticides that are labeled for use against them. Researchers are looking into additional ways to effectively control this stink bug species. If you suspect you have seen brown marmorated stink bugs, contact your State Department of Agriculture, University Diagnostic Laboratory or Cooperative Extension Service for further advice on effective treatment and control recommendations. Top of Page Nuisance in Homes and Businesses In early autumn, adult brown marmorated stink bugs look for wintering sites. During this time of year, they can often be found on the outsides of buildings or inside near doors, windows, and other entry points. They can also be found in leaf litter and vegetation outdoors. In areas where they are established, they can enter structures by the hundreds or thousands. Once inside, they may congregate almost anywhere, including bookcases; under beds and sofas; in cracks under or behind baseboards, window and door trim; and in attics. These pests will not cause structural damage or reproduce in homes. They do not bite people or pets and they are not known to transmit disease or cause physical harm. However, some people may be sensitive to allergens given off by the stink bugs. Adult brown marmorated stink bugs, like other pests, can enter homes through cracks and crevices. A few simple tips to help keep them from entering homes are: Caulk windows inside and out. Inspect for and seal foundation cracks to block a potential point of entry. When insulating exposed plumbing pipes around the foundation or the crawlspace of your home, caulk small gaps and fill larger ones with steel wool. If your home has a fireplace, cap or screen the top of the chimney to keep out pests. For more information, see Choosing a Pest Control Company. Both live and dead brown marmorated stink bugs can be removed from interior areas by using a vacuum cleaner; however, the vacuum may smell of stink bugs for a period of time. Also, traps made using a metal pan filled with soapy water and a light source are attractive to stink bugs, but additional tactics must be used for complete control of brown marmorated stink bugs. Aerosol and fogger type insecticides labeled for use against domestic stink bugs will kill these pests in living areas, but they will not prevent more of the insects from emerging from cracks after they dry. Use of these insecticides is not a solution for long-term management of stink bugs. In addition to being a nuisance in homes, brown marmorated stink bugs are also problematic for businesses, especially businesses that ship products overseas. The cost of these measures, which are intended to prevent introductions of brown marmorated stink bugs to new countries, can be significant.
