A very valuable work for anyone with a serious interest in this classic period. Numerous illustrations and line drawings. Written with a deep appreciation of the ware by a practising potter, this should be a very valuable study of a justly famous ware. A masterly and comprehensive study of one of the most attractive and widely used rough stonewares, which in recent times has been much refined. Both historic and modern wares are covered. Shino and Oribe Kiln Sites Oxford, The catalogue of a very interesting exhibition of sherds from Toki City, with a useful introduction and good drawings of kilns. Well illustrated and has a useful bibliography together with three clear maps. Values of sources, dating and references should be checked. A well-presented study with easily understood technical information. The author does not settle the dating satisfactorily, but the criteria are there. The series, with contributions by various authors, presents first-rate coloured illustrations of the products of all the major kilns, each volume with a simple text introducing the ware. A general history by one of the foremost ceramics historians in Japan, who was also a potter. An up-to-date study of one of the most sensuous of ceramic wares of the Momoyama period in a good popular series.
