Nations as ancient, primordial entities vs. Nationalism as the doctrine that nations are entitled to self-determination. Nation-states and multinational states. Ideology as a system of ideas offering and propagating an explicit account of human nature, the state and society, and the position of the individual. The decay of ideology. Left and right as opposed positions on an ideological dimension. The left favours equality, human rights and reform. The right supports tradition, authority and the nation. Content of these containers varies over time.
