Projects will be evaluated on the following criteria: The Foundation does not fund university-sponsored research projects or dissertation research. Applicants must be mid-career professionals in historic preservation or related fields, including architecture, landscape architecture, architectural conservation, urban design, environmental planning, archaeology, architectural history, and the decorative arts. Applicants must be legal residents or citizens of the United States. Please email cpena@fitchfoundation.org. How to Apply Applicants are required to submit the following materials: Blinder Award; and specify the amount of grant money requested. Brief description of project, including how the final work product will be disseminated. Applicants are encouraged to be succinct and the description is not to exceed three 3 pages. Detailed work schedule and project budget, showing the grant amount requested from the Fitch Foundation and how this money will be spent. Curriculum Vita, including professional and academic background, and past and present grants received. Two 2 letters of support for the project to be included with the application. Applications must be submitted electronically, in PDF format. Recipients will be notified by email in the Spring of Projects must be completed within twelve 12 months of the grant award. All grantees will be assigned a Trustee advisor who will provide feedback and guidance throughout the project. Typically, grant awards are divided into equal payments, the first being presented upon the award of the grant. Substantial written progress reports are required for all subsequent payments. The final payment is awarded only upon completion of the project. The Foundation shall be acknowledged in all publications. The Trustees reserve the right to publish the results if the recipient does not. The grant recipient must sign a release to the Foundation permitting such publication. Proper credit will be given to the grant recipient.
