What if what we get in the coming seasons are anthologized stories within the same general world. Specifically, a world crafted by Shirley Jackson. And with Mike Flanagan as a singular voice driving the stories, we could see wildly original development, clever crossovers, and loyal nods to one of the early masters of horror fiction. Just stick with me long enough to consider the source material: There is plenty of room for Flanagan to play. And he would have numerous creative ways to connect the two worlds. Although there are fewer supernatural elements, there is more than enough base material to shift from family drama into the more intimate troubled mind of a single person. There are ghosts and murder and family drama. In fact, the only knock on this one is that it may actually be too similar to the version of The Haunting of Hill House Flanagan created. One could even claim Flanagan was already pulling from The Sundial for added influences in season one. If there is any truth to that, then this whole idea gets much, much less crazy. But there are other sources of material here. Most people read it as the story of a boy who invents a persona to absorb tales of his own misbehavior at school. Will any of these ideas come to pass? Series synopsis[edit] King of the Hill is set in the fictional small town of Arlen, Texas. The show centers around the Hill family, whose head is the ever-responsible, hard-working, loyal, disciplined, and honest Hank Hill voiced by Mike Judge. Hank is employed as an assistant manager at Strickland Propane, selling "propane and propane accessories". He is very traditional and moral, and he takes exceptionally good care of his dog, Ladybird, which he treats, more often than not, as a member of the family and as a human. Together, Cotton and Didi have a son, "G. As a result of his paranoia, he does not trust the government or "the system". Dale is married to Nancy Hicks-Gribble voiced by Ashley Gardner , a weather girl and later anchor woman for the Channel 84 news. Their affair is obvious to everyone except Dale and Peggy, who suspects nothing, idealizing his philandering wife and considering John Redcorn one of his best friends. Only once does Nancy break it off with John Redcorn, after which her hair starts to fall out, and when she learns that a satisfying extra-marital relationship is the only way to reverse it, she immediately resumes the affair. Dale is so utterly oblivious that when someone finally tells him the truth, he denies it. He decides instead that the reason Joseph looks so very un-Dale-like is because aliens genetically modified the sperm which they had stolen from him in order to secretly impregnate Nancy. Whenever he has a problem, he seeks advice from his best friend, Bobby, and together they get into trouble as a result of their combined enthusiasm and naivety Living across from the Hills is Bill Dauterive voiced by Stephen Root , an overweight, divorced, and clinically depressed man. Bill is unlucky in love, though he finds near-success with several women, including former Texas Governor Ann Richards. Throughout the series, he often expresses an unrequited attraction to Peggy, which she occasionally uses to rope him into her schemes. Despite his popularity in high school, he is now seen as a loser. Bill is a Sergeant in the United States Army , where he gives haircuts to soldiers. Boomhauer is a slim womanizer whose mutterings are hard to understand to the audience, but easily understood by his friends and most other characters. Despite his gibberish speech, he can sing clearly; he can also speak fluent Spanish and French. The series finale reveals that he is a Texas Ranger. His given name, "Jeff", was not revealed until the 13th and final season. Early in the series, the Souphanousinphones, an upper-middle class Laotian family, move in next-door to the Hills. The family consists of the materialistic Kahn voiced by Toby Huss , his social-climber wife Minh voiced by Lauren Tom , and their teenage daughter, Kahn, Jr. Kahn who fled poverty in Laos to become a successful businessman in America is often at odds with his neighbors, believing them to be hillbillies and rednecks due to their lower socioeconomic status. Minh often becomes involved in activities with Peggy and Nancy, whom she looks down on as uncivilized and ignorant, despite still considering them her best friends. She develops a relationship with Bobby that blossoms into romance over the first half of the series before the two decide to remain friends. Connie often accompanies Bobby and Joseph on their misadventures as a neglected voice of reason.
