

## 1: Lake Francis Case | Revolv

*Lake Francis Case and Fort Randall Dam are located within the rolling plain of the Missouri Plateau in southern central South Dakota, and bordered by rugged bluffs, broken by a complex of eroded canyons and ravines and has become one of the most popular recreation spots in the Great Plains.*

Fort Randall Dam lies within view of the military post from which it takes its name. The name of the original fort honored Colonel Daniel W. Randall, one-time deputy paymaster of the Army. The earliest inhabitants to migrate to the Fort Randall area were probably Archaic Period hunters who arrived in the region about 6, B. About 1, years later, other groups of Native Americans, moving out of the central plains of Nebraska and western Iowa, settled in permanent villages along the Missouri River. These early farmers were probably ancestors of the historic Mandan and Arikara tribes. Sometime after A. Using buffalo and horses as their mainstays for survival, the Sioux adapted well to northern plains living. Exploration, fur trading and establishment of military outposts were soon followed by homesteading pioneers. From the explorations of Lewis and Clark in the early s until the railroads steamed across the plains in the s, trading posts, explorer camps, Indian agencies, military posts and steamboat landings dotted the basin. The Fort Randall Military Post, built in on the south side of the river just below the present site of the dam, was established to keep peace on the frontier and served as a major navigation link on the Missouri River. The Fort Randall Military Post, located on the south side of the river just below the present site of the dam, was named for Colonel Daniel Randall, a career Army officer who also served as Deputy Paymaster General of the Army. The site was selected in by General William S. Harney, Commander of the Sioux Expedition. In , soldiers of the Fort conceived the idea of building a combination church and Odd Fellows meeting hall in an effort to stem rampant alcoholism and provide some social, spiritual and intellectual stimulation at the isolated post. The Fort Randall Post Cemetery is located on the south side of the river just below the present site of the dam. When the fort was officially abandoned in , the grave cemetery was left to the elements. Lake Francis Case attracts more than 1 million visitors each year to its shores. Recreation opportunities around the lake include camping, fishing, hunting, boating, sailing, swimming, skiing, bird-watching and photography. Amenities include electricity, potable water, modern bathrooms, playground equipment, trailer dump stations and boat ramps. A select few campgrounds also have camping cabins available. Great year-round fishing opportunities attract thousands of anglers to the lake. Fishing is a very popular activity on Lake Francis Case. Walleye is the primary sport fish although bass, crappie, pike and catfish are also fished on the lake.

Stretching miles from the community of Pickstown to Big Bend Dam near Fort Thompson, South Dakota, Lake Francis Case offers a wide verity of recreational actives from fishing, camping, swimming, boating, bird watching, water-skiing, and hunting. The purpose of the dam was to provide flood control as well as hydroelectric power, navigation support, irrigation, municipal water supply, fish and wildlife management, and recreation. Fort Randall Dam takes its name from an old military post. The fort itself was named after Colonel Daniel W. Randall who was a deputy paymaster of the Army. Lake Francis Case, bordered by rugged bluffs, travels through grassy prairie and rolling plains. Two national wildlife refuges are nearby, Lake Andes and Karl E. Mundt National Wildlife Refuge. In the winter bald eagles roost in the cottonwood trees and can be viewed. Other animals to be spotted at the two wild life refuges are beaver, white-tailed deer, and a great diversity of birds. Although walleye is the most sought after fish in Lake Francis Case, northern pike, perch, and smallmouth bass are also available for catching. Hunters can enjoy hunting many types of birds such as pheasant, sharp-tailed grouse, prairie chickens, turkeys and geese. Big-game animals such as white-tailed deer, mule deer, and antelope, can also be hunted. Hunting is permitted on all public lands around the Lake Francis Case except for developed recreation areas. There visitors will find exhibits demonstrating the dam construction, cultural history, early exploration and natural history of the area, and more. Adjacent to the parking area of the visitor center are the Lewis and Clark wayside exhibits. They educate visitors about the travels of the Lewis and Clark Expedition. Over 1 million visitors each year travel to Lake Francis Case. Campgrounds are managed by the State of South Dakota and have many amenities such as electricity, potable water, modern bathrooms, and boat ramps. Cabins are available at some of the campsites and are wheelchair assessable. With 22 recreation areas located around the reservoir, the Lake Frcis Case offers something for everyone.
