

## LESSON 7: GOD HAS PROVIDED PROSPERITY FOR EVERY HOME pdf

Related Media Sometimes stores offer contests where the winner has a certain amount of time to run through the store and select as many items as he or she can. If you won a contest like that, before your mad dash through the store you probably would think carefully about what you wanted to get. You would go for the items that cost the most and that you needed the most. You would be focused on getting the most for your time. In a way, life is a lot like that contest. But the clock is running and we all spend our time in one way or another. The question is, when the clock stops, will we have our baskets full of the things that really matter or will we have a cart full of trivial things that are worthless in light of eternity? You rush through the daily routine. As I thought about the text, two strands emerged: You see this in Verse 27 shows the contrast, that Israel acquired property, was fruitful and became very numerous. God had promised to bless Abraham, to make him a great nation and to bless all nations through his descendants. So at the end of the chapter, we see Jacob clinging to that promise by faith as he asks Joseph to bury him in Canaan. Follow me back there! When the final buzzer sounds, what matters is God and His purpose. If we commit ourselves to Him, He will take care of the other things we need. How do I order my life to make God and His purpose prosper? You make God and His purpose prosper by being distinct unto Him So he coaches his brothers on what to say when they meet Pharaoh. He asks his brothers to give Pharaoh the same message, not to try to impress him that they are something they are not. He lets them know his purpose: Why would Joseph want to keep his family in the land of Goshen? The main reason was to keep them separate from the fast lane in Egypt. Joseph probably had a hunch that Pharaoh might offer his brothers top government jobs, since he was so favorable toward Joseph. But that could easily be the downfall of these men. While Joseph could handle the high society life in Egypt and remain pure before the Lord, his brothers probably could not. The biblical term for that is holiness. It grieves me when I hear of Christians acting the same as the world acts. When Christians use abusive speech toward their mates or children, when they are dishonest in business, when they live for selfish pursuits, when they are morally impure, the salt has lost its savor. Biblical holiness starts with the way we think, where we stand apart from our culture and live to please God according to His Word. Joseph and his family had to anticipate the scorn of the Egyptians in their commitment to live separately unto God in Goshen. You may be respected, as Joseph was. But more often than not, the world ridicules you behind your back, if not to your face, for living a holy life. But there are some benefits to making a commitment to be distinct from the world. I face the same temptations you do to bend the truth at times, to gratify the flesh, to be selfish and greedy. So the first principle of making God and His purpose prosper is to be distinct from the world. You make God and His purpose prosper by being a blessing to others Next Joseph presents his aged father to Pharaoh. In type, Israel became the savior of the Gentiles through Joseph. Jacob may have blessed Pharaoh twice, once upon entering and again as he exited. Or, verse 7 may be a summary of what follows, so that Jacob blessed Pharaoh just prior to leaving. Pharaoh asked the old patriarch his age and he responded with his self-pitying answer They point out how Jacob testified that life is a pilgrimage and that even years is short in light of eternity. He always wavered between faith and doubt. He gives a completely different and far better summary of his life in His words before Pharaoh reflect life from the human perspective. But, in spite of that, Jacob did bless Pharaoh. The exact words are not recorded, but probably it was a prayer that God would prosper Pharaoh and be gracious to him. It is significant that this old shepherd, whose occupation was despised by the Egyptians, could walk in before their leader, with all his pomp and splendor, and not be intimidated. Instead Jacob knew that he had something to offer Pharaoh, namely, a blessing from the living God. Each of us has that same blessing to offer every person we meet. It may be a wealthy and famous person, like Pharaoh. We can offer that person the good news of Jesus Christ. On one occasion a man named Peter Cartwright was about to preach when his deacons informed him that President Andrew Jackson had unexpectedly showed up. They asked him to be careful what he said. Andrew Jackson will go to hell as

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quickly as any other man if he does not repent! Jacob thought he was going to die soon. Notice the contrast between verse 12, which states that Joseph provided his family with food, and verse 13 which says that there was no food in the land because of the famine. Many have criticized Joseph, accusing him of being harsh and of degrading these people through slavery. But that is to read this story through the lens of our culture. If they were happy with him, who are we to criticize him? This was a life and death situation. Joseph could have done what many in his position have done, namely, to use his power to feather his own pocket and that of his cronies. He sought the best interests of Pharaoh and of the people, and everyone sensed that. But neither was it a terrible situation. Democracy was virtually unknown at this stage of world history. The slavery which Joseph instituted was not the degrading kind that was often practiced in our country. Probably Joseph moved the people to the cities for more efficient distribution of the grain. But it was no small feat for a politician to please the one over him while at the same time having his constituents thank him while he sells them into slavery and institutes a 20 percent tax hike! But Joseph did what few have done: He was truly a blessing to others. He wants you to seek the best interests of your employer and fellow employees at work. He wants you to be His channel for blessing those around your neighborhood or your fellow students and your teachers. You can only do that if you maintain your integrity through a close walk with God. You do it both through your words as Jacob did and your deeds as Joseph did. Your job reveals a lot about your character. Or, it shows that you are punctual, industrious, generous, truthful, harmonious, trustworthy, loyal, a person of principle. Christians often presume on their Christian employer for favors. He was open and up front with him about his family. Pharaoh is the one who told them to take the land of Goshen. So wherever God has you, purpose to be distinct as a Christian and to be a blessing to those around you through your godly behavior and verbal witness. You make God and His purpose prosper by keeping your priorities right when God prospers you. He had his children restored to him. His extended family prospered. God has taken care of us. It had been over years since God had promised Canaan to Abraham. But in spite of his prosperity in Egypt, Jacob kept his priorities straight. The author of Hebrews quotes this incident to make the point that Jacob did it by faith. That faith led him to worship God. The good life in Egypt can never compare to the blessings of the Promised Land. But we all face the danger of becoming enamored with the goodies of Egypt and forgetting that we are looking for that heavenly city to come. God has graciously prospered us in this world. We must remember that our purpose for being here is not to accumulate the things Egypt has to offer. The person who by faith lays up treasure in heaven is truly prosperous, as Jesus pointed out. He has something that the world cannot give or take away. Each of us has used up some of the time on the clock. I want you to look at those things in light of eternity. Are they the things that will really matter when the time is up?

Tweet At our Gospel Truth Seminars, I always take time before meetings to talk with friends and partners. They have not properly understood the balance of grace and faith and their relationship to each other. By definition, the word grace means unmerited, unearned, undeserved favor. Therefore, the good news is, grace has nothing to do with you. Grace existed before you ever came to be. Faith is defined as being a positive response to what God has already provided by grace. Therefore, faith is your part. Grace and faith work together, and they must be in balance. Not of works, lest any man should boast. In this verse, a profound truth is being declared. It says we are saved by grace through faith, not one or the other. Think of it this wayâ€”grace is what God does; faith is what we do. It takes both working together to receive salvation. Salvation is not dependent on grace alone. He has already given the gift of salvation to everyone through Jesus. It is by faith that a person receives what was done 2, years ago. In 1 John 2: And He died before you or I ever committed a single sin. Here is a radical truth that would get me kicked out of most churches: Sin is not an issue with God! The sins of the entire worldâ€”past, present, and futureâ€”have already been forgiven. Even a man like Adolf Hitler had grace extended to him! Jesus loved Hitler and paid for his sins just as He did for yours and mine. God is no respecter of persons Rom. God has already done His part; it is now up to you to receive the truth by faith and make it a reality in your life. John the Baptist said in John 1: Of sin, because they believe not on me. That is not what the Holy Spirit is here to do. He is here to convict you of the single sin of not receiving Jesus as your Savior. The only conviction is that of believing in Jesus Christ. People do not go to hell for committing adultery, stealing, or even murder. Those, like all sins, have already been paid for. This is what the Bible says in John So, stop magnifying sin in your life! The message that much of the church is preaching causes us to become conscious of sin instead of conscious of righteousness Rom. It also causes us to link our performance to all the other blessings of God. That provision is not based on whether you are reading the Bible enough, praying enough, going to church, or even paying your tithes. Before you ever had a financial need, God created the provision. Before you were sick, God, through grace, provided your healing 1 Pet. Before you ever became discouraged, God blessed you with all spiritual blessings Eph. God anticipated every need you could ever have and has met those needs through Jesus before you existed. What God provided by grace 2, years ago now becomes a reality when mixed with faith. Faith appropriates what God has already provided. Grace and faith work together, and our part is to accept what God has already done. Grace must be balanced with faith. Many Christians believe that God moves sovereignly as He wills, when He wills. That is because religion teaches that God controls everything and that nothing can happen without His permission. For instance, when my father died, I was told God needed him in heaven more than I needed him here. Even at twelve years old, I knew better than that. Why would God need my dad in heaven? That is not what the Word of God teaches. The Scripture makes it very clear that Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil Heb. Satan is the one who goes about seeking whom he may devour 1 Pet. Satan is the one who comes to steal, kill, and destroy John God is being misrepresented. I think the idea that God either causes or allows evil so that we will somehow grow spiritually is the worst heresy in the body of Christ. It renders people passive and takes away their hope. If you believe that God is trying to teach you something through sickness or poverty, why see a doctor or look for a good job? Why not suffer as much as you can and really learn the lesson? I mean, how dumb can you be and still breathe? Brothers and sisters, that is terrible doctrine. The Bible says that in the last days, people will call evil good and good evil Is. Denominations today are teaching that when you get sick or experience financial problems, God is causing it so He can teach you something or humble you. That is an example of calling evil good. God is not responsible for killing babies, for rape, violence, poverty, or sickness. Satan is the author of evil, and the Bible clearly states that we are to resist the Enemy James 4: Resist means to actively fight against something. Jesus said that not everybody will be saved Matt. And the truth is that you need to put your faith in what God has already done, not in what you do. God, by His grace, has already

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provided healing, prosperity, forgiveness for sin, and much more. However, it must be appropriated by faith. God has done His part by giving His Son, Jesus. His grace has provided everything through the sacrifice of Jesus. This is nearly too good to be true because there is absolutely nothing we can do to earn it and nothing we can do to lose it. Our part is simple: We respond to His grace by faith and appropriate what has already been accomplished. Make sure that is not you. This is foundational to your relationship with God and the reason you may not be seeing your prayers answered. Previously it was only available in hardback. Many emphasize grace and others emphasize faith. But too few emphasize balancing grace and faith. Taken individually, both are poisons and can kill you. When mixed together, they become salt, which you must have to live. But put your faith in what God has already done for you, and you have the victory that overcomes the world 1 John 5:

Lesson Six What is prosperity? Prosperity does not mean the same thing to any two persons. To the wage earner an increase of a few dollars in the weekly income may seem like wonderful prosperity, for it means an increase in the comfort and welfare of his family. The man who engages in vast enterprises reckons prosperity in larger terms, and does not consider himself prosperous unless things are coming to him in a big way. Between these extremes are many ideas of prosperity, which shows quite plainly that prosperity is not in the possession of things but in the recognition of supply and in the knowledge of free and open access to an inexhaustible storehouse of all that is good or desirable. Explain the prosperity law that Jesus gave. In the great Mind of God there is no thought of lack, and such a thought has no rightful place in your mind. It is your birthright to be prosperous, regardless of who you are or where you may be. Page 88 Jesus said to all men, "Seek ye first his kingdom, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Get into the prosperity thought and you will demonstrate prosperity. Cultivate the habit of thinking about abundance everywhere present, not only in the forms of imagination but in forms without. Jesus did not make a separation between the two as though they were at enmity. What relation has a prosperity consciousness to wealth in the outer? Realize first of all that prosperity is not wholly a matter of capital or environment but a condition brought about by certain ideas that have been allowed to rule in the consciousness. When these ideas are changed the conditions are changed in spite of environment and all appearances, which must also change to conform to the new ideas. People who come into riches suddenly without building up a consciousness of prosperity soon part from their money. Those who are born and bred to riches usually have plenty all their life even though they never make the effort to earn a dollar for themselves. This is because the ideas of plenty are so interwoven into their thought atmosphere that they are a very part of themselves. They have the prosperity consciousness, in which there is no idea of any condition under which the necessities of life could be lacking. What is the "sin of riches"? We are sometimes asked whether we advocate the accumulation of riches. The accumulation of riches, as has been explained, is futile unless it is the outgrowth of a rich consciousness. We advocate the accumulation rather of rich ideas, ideas that are useful, constructive, and of service to the well-being of all mankind. The outer manifestation of riches may follow or it may not, but the supply for every need will be forthcoming because the man of rich ideas has confidence in an all-providing power that never fails. He may not have an extra dollar, but his ideas have merit and he has confidence, a combination that cannot fail to attract the money to carry him forward. This is true riches, not an accumulation of money, but access to an inexhaustible resource that can be drawn on at any time to meet any righteous demand. When a person has this rich consciousness there is no necessity for laying up gold or accumulating stocks and bonds or other property to ensure future supply. Such a one may be most generous with his wealth without fear of depletion, because his rich ideas will keep him in constant touch with abundance. Those who have the thought of accumulating material wealth, a thought that is dominant in the world today, are unbalanced. They have a fear of the loss of riches Page 90 that makes their tenure insecure. Their prosperity is based on a wrong idea of the source of riches and eventually means disaster. The sin of riches is not in the possession but in the love of money, a material selfishness that leads to soul starvation. What causes crop failure and famine in some countries? It is not a crime to be rich nor a virtue to be poor, as certain reformers would have us think. The sin lies in hoarding wealth and keeping it from circulating freely to all who need it. Those who put wealth into useful work that contributes to the welfare of the masses are the salvation of the country. Fortunately, there are many in this country who have the prosperity consciousness. If we were all in a poverty consciousness, famines would be as common here as they are in India or China. Millions in those lands are held in the perpetual thought of poverty and they suffer want in all its forms from the cradle to the grave. The burden of the poverty thought reacts on the earth so that year after year it withholds its products and many people starve. Why did Jesus carry no money and own no property? Universal Mind controls all nature and is in possession

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of all its products. Puny, personal man uses all his craft to get control of the products of nature but is always defeated in the end. Only the universal man of Spirit is in undisputed possession, and to him the Father says, "All that is mine is thine. Page 91 He did not even burden Himself with a tub, as did Diogenes, and "had not where to lay his head. He took it for granted that whatever He needed was His. The fish carried His pocketbook, and the invisible ethers furnished the sideboard from which He handed out food for thousands. He was rich in every way for He had the prosperity consciousness and proved that the earth with all its fullness does belong to the Lord, whose righteous sons are heirs to and in possession of all things. The anxious thought must be eliminated and the perfect abandon of the child of nature assumed, and when to this attitude you add the realization of unlimited resources, you have fulfilled the divine law of prosperity. The imagination is a wonderful creative power. It builds all things out of the one substance. When you associate it with faith, you make things just as real as those that God makes, for man is a co-creator with God. Whatever you form in the mind and have faith in will become substantial. Then you should be on guard as regards what you put your faith in. If it is material forms, shadows that cease to be as soon as your supporting thought is withdrawn from them, you are building temporary substance that will pass away and leave you nothing. Put your faith in the real or, as Jesus told His disciples, "have faith in God. The real search of all people is for God. They may think they are looking for other things, but Page 92 they must eventually admit that it is God they seek. Having once felt His presence within them, they are keenly conscious that only God can satisfy. The place where we meet God should be made so sure and so pure that we can never mistake His voice or be hidden from His face. This place we know as the mind, the inmost recess of the soul, the kingdom of the heavens within us. Is the law of prosperity limited to thought? What else is needful? It is not sufficient however to sit down and hold thoughts of abundance without further effort. That is limiting the law to thought alone, and we want it to be fulfilled in manifestation as well. Cultivating ideas of abundance is the first step in the process. The ideas that come must be used. Be alert in doing whatever comes to you to do, cheerful and competent in the doing, sure of the results, for it is the second step in the fulfilling of the law. Over what is man given dominion by his Creator? They are yours and under your control. You can direct them, coerce them, hush them, or crush them. You can dissolve one thought and put another in its stead. There is no other place in the universe where you are the absolute master. The dominion given you as your divine right is over your own thoughts only. When you fully apprehend this and begin to exercise your God-given dominion, you begin to find the way to God, the only door to God, the door of mind and thought. How can man master his fear of financial lack? If you are fearful that you will not be provided with the necessities of life for tomorrow, next week, or next year, or for your old age, or that your children Page 93 will be left in want, deny the thought. Do not allow yourself for a moment to think of something that must be outside the realm of all-careful, all-providing good. You know even from your outer experience that the universe is self-sustaining and that its equilibrium is established by law. The same law that sustains all sustains you as a part. Claim your identity under that law, your oneness with the all, and rest in the everlasting arms of Cause, which knows nothing of lack. If you are in a condition of poverty, this attitude of mind will attract to you opportunities to better your condition. Insulate your mind from the destructive thoughts of all those who labor under the belief in hard times. If your associates talk about the financial stringency, affirm all the more persistently your dependence on the abundance of God. Why are prosperity prayers sometimes unanswered? By doing this you place yourself under a divine law of demand and supply that is never influenced by the fluctuations of the market or the opinions of men. Every time you send out a thought of wholehearted faith in the I AM part of yourself, you set in motion a chain of causes that must bring the results you seek. Ask whatsoever you will in the name of the Christ, the I AM, the divine within, and your demands will be fulfilled; both heaven and earth will hasten to do your bidding. But when you have asked for something, be on the alert to receive it when it comes. People complain that their prayers are not answered when, if we knew the truth, they are not awake to receive the answer when it comes. Page 94 If you ask for money, do not look for an angel from the skies to bring it on a golden platter, but keep your eyes open for some fresh opportunity to make money, an opportunity that will come as sure as you live. These are some tangible steps along the way to the larger manifestation you desire. Then he may go in and pass out the goods freely. If the men of the world, with their selfish ideas of "mine and thine," were given the power, without a

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thorough mental cleansing, of instantly producing whatever they desire, they would undoubtedly practice still greater oppressions on their fellows, and existing conditions would not be improved. A stonecutter sees a block of marble as so many hours work, while Michelangelo sees it as an angel that it is his privilege to bring forth. This is the difference between those who see the material world as so much matter and those who look on it with the eyes of mind and the imagination that works toward perfection. One who paints a picture or makes a piece of sculpture first sees it in his mind. He first imagines or images it. If he wants a strong picture he makes force one of the elements of his image.

*Lesson 7. God Has Provided Prosperity for Every Home. I. What Is the Connecting Link Between Love and Prosperity in the Home? A. LOVE IS GOD. God is life and.*

It is right to have faith because God is reliable. It brings God onto the scene. But this problem can be solved. This salvation is to be received through repentance and faith. God expects us to change our allegiance. But as well as this change of allegiance or repentance we need to believe God and His promises with a living faith. In this lesson we will consider what it means to have faith in God. What Faith is not Faith is not religion. Many times people say "We have our faith". What they mean is this: Faith is not mental assent. It is not agreeing with your mind, "Yes, that is true. It is not a faith that can save. They know and believe that God exists James 2: They have no loving confidence in God. Faith is not a way to manipulate God. It is not a power by which we make God do what WE want when otherwise He would be unwilling to do that thing. It is not a kind of magic through which we make God into our servant! Faith is not hope, nor positive desire. Hope is good, and relates to the future. Faith, however, takes the promise as done NOW. Many people have hope and are anxiously looking for results, but they lack the settled confidence and present assurance which faith has. What Faith Is In the general sense of the word, to have faith is to believe in something or someone, to fully trust, to be so confident that you base your actions on what you believe. To have faith is to be fully convinced of the truthfulness and reliability of that in which you believe. The NIV translation says, "Faith is being sure of what we hope for, and certain of what we do not see. Faith is a spiritual substance. When you have this spiritual substance in you, it communicates to you a certain inner knowing that the thing you are hoping for is certainly established, even before you see any material evidence that it has happened. Faith is a spiritual force. Jesus said in Mark Faith in God must be from the heart. It is not merely intellectual. Hope is a condition for faith. Hope is "a positive unwavering expectation of good". Hope is for the mind 1 Thessalonians 5: It keeps us in the place where we can believe, but it is not in itself "faith". Yet, without hope there are no "things hoped for", and therefore there cannot be faith. Through faith we can know we have the answer to our prayer before we see anything change in the natural order 1 John 5: Jesus said, "Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. We must believe that the response is immediately sent WHEN we pray. Faith is like the confirmation slip in our hearts that the goods are on the way. We have that confirmation slip instantly from God. We sense it in our hearts. The manifestation of those goods, the answer received, comes later as long as we are patient and do not throw away our confidence. All you have to do is hold on to the cheque, go to the bank to present it and you can confidently expect the money to appear in your account after a certain time. If you throw the cheque away the money will not be put in your account. God is trustworthy and always has resources to back his promises. Living faith always has corresponding actions. We talk what we really believe, and we act according to what we really believe. The heroes of faith like Abraham were considered men of faith because they acted on what God showed them. They acted on their faith. To live in faith means to do and say what you believe is right, without doubting. Faith is a rest. It is compatible with inner peace. It is not "trying to believe". The man who is "trying to believe" may be sincere, but he does not have faith in that area yet. Remember that He is everywhere and sees all things. Only when we have confidence in God and His Word can we please Him. Lack of faith leads to lack of obedience. Such lack of obedience dishonors God and surely deserves to be punished. We must live by faith in order to be considered by God "right" and "correct". Otherwise we stand condemned. God is not impressed. It is very possible to believe what the devil says without even believing that he exists! Satan is speaking through so many philosophies and religions without openly declaring himself. Not too many actually know they are trusting the words of Satan and his demons. God is therefore righteous in expecting us to believe in Him and what He says. Who is better qualified to tell us the truth and help us to find answers for life and eternity? The Bible teaches us that genuine faith is "more precious than gold that perishes" 1 Peter 1: Indeed such faith is going to be "tested by fire". You can expect difficulties and persecutions in your life of faith, as well as blessings. Therefore to encourage you to hold onto and develop your faith, we will consider some of

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the benefits of faith. Whosoever believes in Him has eternal life. The just shall live by faith. Faith brings answers to prayer. Since God tells us to pray for our daily bread Matthew 6: Faith brings all the benefits of salvation into our lives Ephesians 2: This includes healing, prosperity, peace, love, joy 1 Peter 1: Faith is a spiritual force through which our ministry for Christ becomes effective. Faith is a major key to ministry success. In particular, faith is the major key for an effective healing and deliverance ministry. Jesus Christ "the same yesterday, today and forever" lives in the Christian Hebrews In this way, our evangelism concerning the Kingdom of God will not be in talk, but in power 1 Corinthians 4: How to Develop Faith We see how important faith is. Yet faith comes Romans You can choose to be a person of faith! Here are some keys to developing faith. Listen to the Word of God as much as possible. Constant attention to the Word of God produces faith, especially if we attend to it with an open heart and mind. The book of Proverbs encourages us to constantly keep the Word in our hearts and to keep our attention on it Proverbs 4: Health is one of the benefits promised. What we listen to affects what we believe. If we listen to the TV more than to the Word, we will believe the lies of the world more than we will believe what God says. Constant attention to lies produces deception. Eventually the mind will accept something if that thing is heard often enough and persuasively enough. That is why we should keep hearing the Word of God, through preaching, Christian tapes, confession of the Word, daily fellowship with godly Christians. This will cause us eventually to believe the truth from our hearts. Realize that every believer has been given a measure of faith by God. We just have to use and develop what God has given. We must put it into action.

Related Media General Introduction to the Psalms The Psalms have a wonderful capacity to capture the reality of our human experience. They express the emotions, personal feelings, attitudes, gratitude, and interests of the average individual. One reason people love the Psalms is that we can each usually identify the Psalms with our own experiences. Unlike English poetry, which emphasizes rhyme and meter, Hebrew poetry relies on other characteristics for its impact like parallelism and figures of speech. Parallelism English verse manipulates sound, and emphasizes rhyme and meter. Hebrew poetry repeats and rearranges thoughts rather than sounds. There are several types of parallel arrangement of thoughts, with the first three listed below being the most basic. Figures of Speech Like the Hebrew language itself, Hebrew poetry uses vivid images, similes, and metaphors to communicate thoughts and feelings. Types of Psalms While praise and prayer characterize the Psalms as a whole, they may be categorized as: Praise 33, , , Historical 68, 78, , , Relational 8, 16, 20, 23, 55 , Imprecatory 35, 69, , , Penitential 6, 32, 51, , , , and Messianic 2, 8, 16, 22, 40, 45, 69, 72, 89, , Introduction to Psalm 1 This first Psalm stands as a kind of introduction to the rest of the Psalms. Its subject matter is very general and basic, but it touches on two subjects that continually occur throughout the Psalms. It declares the blessedness of the righteous and the misery and future of the wicked. Above all else, it summarizes all that is to follow in the rest of the Psalms, and, for that matter, in the rest of Scripture. It presents two ways of life: Two great thrusts flow out of this: Note how this Psalm drives home its truth by the use of contrasts. Here is a contrast between character and destiny. Psalm one is a wisdom Psalm. There are praise Psalms, lament Psalms, and enthronement Psalms and all contain wisdom, of course, but as an introduction and door to the rest of the Psalms, this Psalm declares in just a few words some of the most basic but profound truths and propositions of the Bible. In essence, God says there are two ways of life open to us: The choice is ours. Blessedness is a choice, but to be blessed, one must by faith obey the conditions; he must pursue the way of blessedness as described in this Psalm. The Way of the Godly 1: Blessing comes from growth in the plan of God through fellowship with Him and through the Word of God. While believers have a heavenly position and an eternal inheritance secured by the work of Jesus Christ, the experience of their blessings, the increase of their capacity to appreciate the Lord, and their capacity for happiness is directly proportional to their knowledge and application of the Word. This must not be understood in the sense of legalistic obedience to a set of rules and principles, like a prescription or a formula, but in the sense of an obedience of faith that such a life brings to the one who believes the concepts of this passage. This is a beatitude. A beatitude pronounces blessing upon a certain group of people. It is not, however, an unconditional pronouncement, nor a pronouncement of bliss or a life without problems. It is conditional and this is strongly stressed. Blessing is pronounced, but only on those who comply with certain divine demands or spiritual qualities. But what are these in general? The passage is not speaking about complying with a system of works or self-righteous pharisaism, nor complying with a special formula so one may then experience blessedness. Instead, a beatitude promises blessing to those whose lives are characterized by certain qualities as the outcome of faith and relationship with God. The principle is that certain things corrupt, they tear down and destroy. Other things build, develop, make fruitful, and give the capacity and means for happiness through trust and fellowship with God. This is the message of this Psalm. Now, what are those things? Things to Avoid 1: We never stand still! It warns us how man is prone to turn aside little by little and become more and more entangled in the web of sin. He is easily influenced by the way of the world in its attitudes and actions, for actions follow attitudes. This is the kind of counsel that we must avoid. First, it means to be loose with reference to morals. It means immoral and without godly restraint or controls. It also means ungodly, godless, or negative toward God, loose from God, without Him as an anchor or controlling factor. It refers to those who are guided and controlled by their own desires, emotions, impulses of the mind and flesh rather than by the Word and the Holy Spirit. It connotes movement toward the formation of habits or patterns. Here we see

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patterns forming and becoming entrenched. From thinking like the world we begin to act like the world. Sin is the transgression of the Law. It is whatever misses the will of God for man doctrinally or morally. We are all sinners. We all miss the mark, and none of us are perfect nor will we ever be perfect in this life. This is why Christ had to die for our sin so we might have His righteousness. Past Gallop poles which compared the church and unchurched showed there was basically no difference in the way they lived their lives. Many people in the church today are comfortable with their religion; they are merely playing at church. They are not advancing in their life with Christ, but are materialistic, earthly-oriented, living as earthdwellers and not sojourners. You are viewed as in a confederacy with them. It refers to one who is actively engaged in putting down the things of God and His Word. But please note that scoffing can occur by declaration of words or by declaration of a way of life that scorns the moral absolutes of Scripture and its way of life. From this retrogressive process, it is easy to see that people simply do not remain passive about God. Passivity toward God and His Word leads to activity in sin and finally to overt activity against God. That is a law of life. How do people scoff at the Word of God? But there are other ways. We think we have better things to do with our time. In essence we scoff at the Word when we fail to obey it and order our lives accordingly cf. These verses pose a warning to us. They teach us how little by little we can step out of the place of blessedness and into the place of misery and cursing with horrible consequences. First, we can begin to think with the viewpoint of the wicked. Compare Lot in Genesis He chose according to the viewpoint of the wicked. Then we can quite naturally begin to behave like sinners, acting more and more like the world. Again compare Lot in Genesis Note how these three verses in Ephesians parallel Psalm 1: Nor sit in the seat of scoffers! So, how can we avoid this? I would emphasize how remarkable this is. Psalm 1 is an introductory Psalm, a kind of gateway to the rest, where all kinds of qualities are mentioned. Yet, this is the one quality which is of single importance. Because here is the root, everything else is the fruit, i. This emphasis is borne out throughout Scripture cf. The church is not a social club, a welfare organization, a religious or a ritualistic institution. According to Scripture, everything in the church is to flow from and around this emphasis and activity. Its organization, its fellowship, its works, testimony, witness, and giving. This does not deny the ministry and work of the Holy Spirit or other valid functions of the church like music, but central to everything is the Word Jam. The Key to Blessedness 1: But it may also be taken as a strong contrast, i. The Theological Word Book of the Old Testament points out this word may be used for that which a person wishes strongly to do or have. The Hebrew verb form of this noun is used several times of a man taking pleasure or finding delight in the woman he loves. The law, of course, refers to the Word of God. This draws our attention to the doctrine of bibliology or the doctrines of revelation, inspiration, preservation, collection and canonization of the Bible, and illumination 2 Tim. If you are interested there is a thorough study on this subject entitled, Bibliology: One of the reasons Scripture is a delight, like honey in the honey comb, is because it is truth. It is accurate, reliable and actively powerful Ps. It is on his mind and in his heart at all times in every situation and area of life 2 Cor. It involves thinking about what Scripture means and how, when, and where it should be applied.

What is a "tithe," and how was tithing started? What benefits accrue to the tither, according to the promises of the Bible? In what way is giving a divine grace? What was the practical plan that Paul suggested to the Corinthians? What effect does a willing and cheerful spirit have on the giver, the gift, and the receiver? How can faith be exercised in giving? How should wisdom be employed in giving? How can one who is puzzled about giving--as regards how much, when, and where--be helped by the decision to tithe? What should tithing mean to the farmer? How does tithing help fulfill "the first and greatest commandment" about loving God and the neighbor? Aside from Bible promises, do we have direct evidence that tithing increases prosperity? Should the tithe have a definite place in the personal or family budget? Should we keep a record of our giving, as we do of other disbursements? Why is the regular tithe, though it may be small, better than the occasional giving of a larger gift in a lump sum? What is the psychological basis and effect of tithing? What attitude should one assume toward a seemingly delayed demonstration? Should we look for our good to come through the channel of those to whom we give or serve? Why is it better to give without thought or expectation of return? What must we do about receiving what God has and desires for us? Discuss giving as a form of affirmation. In what ways is the religion of Jesus applicable to the problems of daily living? State briefly the law of giving and receiving that Jesus taught. Why has the teaching of Jesus not been more effective in changing conditions in the world and in individual life? Why is economic reform so much needed at the present time?
