The site is quiet, not crowded and very family friendly. Watching the sunset overlooking the beautiful coast was just so memorable. The site facilities are a little basic, but perfectly suitable for our family. There are also some lovely secluded beaches to explore in the area. This site was fab, not being overcrowded at all as all campers have a pitch around the periphery of the field leaving large open space in the middle. There is access to Caerfai Bay which is just gorgeous, especially when the tide is out is all white sand and blue sea. There are good facilities with showers, toilets and washing up areas, as well as a lovely little farm shop supplying local cheese, ice-cream, yoghurt and other organic fayres. The walk into St. It is on top of a cliff, so ensure you pitch your tent well and take earplugs to block out the wind, but it is all worth it to wake up to that view. The setting is absolutely stunning, on the clifftop with views all across St Brides Bay. The fact that it is also right on the coastal path means that there are some really spectacular walks to be had without having to get in the car. St Davids is about 20 mins walk away with a few amenities including shops, pubs and cafes. The farm shop was really useful with some lovely cheese, rolls, pastries and other bits and pieces. I liked the way the kids could group together in the centre and play together. A real gem of a find. Amazing views from this site - we turned up the day we wanted to stay and got a great pitch - really well priced. Expect it to be windy - it is literally on top of the cliff. Access to beach path and Pembrookshire Coast path right on site - City of St Davids is also within walking distance with some great shops and places to eat. Friendly staff and a great site shop - selling freshly baked croissants in the morning! Only slight down side were the facilities - a little tired and dated - but did serve their purpose. Highlights were watching the cows being milked by the automatic milking machine, walks in both directions along the stunning coastal path and playing in the beautiful beach. The best pitches are those in the lower fields directly overlooking the bay. Watch out, some pitches are on quite a slope and the site does get full at peak times. There were more dogs than people on the beach at times. Booked at short notice, just a week before but had no problem getting a pitch. The pitches are HUGE, plenty of room for our 8 berth, plus porch, plus windbraked seating area and our van and room to spare. There are four main fields. Three have amazing views over St. The centre of each field is kept clear for games etc. The path down to the beach is great on the way down but a heavy slog on the way back. The bay is sheltered and spotless with lots of rockpools for exploring as well as a lovely expanse of sand. Visiting the farm shop is a must before breakfast when the delicious smell of freshly baked croissants wafts over the site. The village of St Davids is within walking distance albeit back down the narrow track to the main road so beware if you have children. The toilet blocks were basic but clean and the best time to shower is in the afternoon as the showers are solar heated. The ladies loos also had swallows nesting there; the fledglings came back each night to roost on the roof lintels. Each review counts as one entry, so get writing!
