I have spoken to social workers who need to pass this exam to hold onto their jobs. That is a lot of pressure. And in this economy, I hear that and feel that. No matter your situation in getting licensed, you must find a way to relax your mind and slow your racing heart, so you can focus on the exam. But what works best for me is taking seven why seven? I have no idea long deep breaths and exhaling slowly. Whenever I am anxious in any setting , doing this relaxes me. Find a study partner. I am usually a loner when it comes to doing something I need to focus my energy on. But the main thing that helped me with this process was finding a study partner I could trust and rely on. Meeting with my friend held me accountableâ€”and without that, I could have easily put this off longer. I owe so much to having her be a partner in this with me. Register and schedule your exam. When you set an exam date, it really helps you focus. Consider what helps you with recall. I made flash cards, and seldom used them, but the mere act of writing down the various stages of development or what the side effects of MAOIs are helped me retain this knowledge for the long run. The test is tricky, yes, but you must know your content. Trust me, I was a CO student. I took core classes on human behavior in the social environment and a casework class, but I did not necessarily apply these subject areas into my direct work. Are there questions on clinical diagnosis and medication use? Do these outweigh direct practice questions? So if you are not a clinical social worker like me , you can still pass this exam. Review your content and know the basics. Take a review course to help you know what you need to know. You get a study guide with material to focus in on, and practice questions at the end, to test your recall, as well as the full NASW Code of Ethics. As an alum, I took the test prep offered by Hunter, which was also helpful. I got some great tips there and used those in my exam, four years later. Either way, take a review courseâ€”even if you know your content, you may not be completely prepared for what is ahead. We all should know this, but you definitely need to know this for the exam. Review it and understand it. Know what you are legally being held to, as a professional social worker. Find supplemental study materials. A few weeks before the exam, I found an array of resources online for free. Singer, a great resource for social workers in general, not only for the exam. There are also podcasts from Dr. The main purpose in this was to give an idea of what it will feel like to take the exam. Please keep in mind that the test you take online is a replica of the actual exam and the questions may not reflect those that will actually be on the exam. If you think that might help with your anxiety, do it. You even get a breakdown of the content areas in the end. I found it valuable, even if I had to pay extra for it. I know you may be under a lot of pressure to get this license; remember, give yourself some time to breathe, find other stress-reducing activities, and keep a positive energy

around this exam. I used some visualization techniques that truly helped with my anxiety. Silly me took this exam two weeks before my wedding! Do not let the exam rule you—you must rule the exam. And with enough preparation, you will! More often than not, our first instincts are always correct. Do not second guess yourself. If you flag questions on the exam and review them, remember what made you choose the answer in the first place.

4: NYS Social Work:LMSW License Requirements

The ASWB social work licensing exams are changing in From to , the Association of Social Work Boards conducted its sixth analysis of the practice of social work to update the content and weighting of the blueprints for the social work licensure exams.

You must file an Application for Licensure Form 1 and the other forms indicated, along with the appropriate fee, to the Office of the Professions at the address specified on each form. It is your responsibility to follow up with anyone you have asked to send us material. You should also read the general licensing information applicable for all professions. Fees are subject to change. The fee due is the one in law when your application is received unless fees are increased retroactively. You will be billed for the difference if fees have been increased. Do not send cash. Your cancelled check is your receipt. Mail your application and fee to: Payment submitted from outside the United States should be made by check or draft on a United States bank and in United States currency; payments submitted in any other form will not be accepted and will be returned.

Partial Refunds Individuals who withdraw their licensure application may be entitled to a partial refund. For the procedure to withdraw your application, contact the Social Work Unit by e-mailing opunit5@nysed.gov. The State Education Department is not responsible for any fees paid to an outside testing or credentials verification agency. If you withdraw your application, obtain a refund, and then decide to seek New York State licensure at a later date, you will be considered a new applicant, and you will be required to pay the licensure fee and meet the licensure requirements in place at the time you reapply.

Education Requirements To meet the professional education requirement for licensure as an LMSW, you must present satisfactory evidence of having received a masters degree in social work M. For education to be determined substantially equivalent, the applicant must present satisfactory evidence of having received a masters degree, or its equivalent, in social work through completion of a satisfactory graduate program in social work which includes two years of full-time study at least 60 semester hours, or the equivalent , of graduate study. No more than half of the total semester hours for the program may be advanced standing credit granted for social work study at the baccalaureate level. The graduate program must include curricular content in the following areas: In addition to the professional education requirement, every applicant for LMSW licensure or a limited permit must complete coursework or training in the identification and reporting of child abuse in accordance with Section 3 a of the Education Law. See additional information and a list of approved providers for this training.

Examination Requirement s Note: Applicants for licensure will not be approved to take the examination prior to receipt of the M. To qualify to take the ASWB examination: Information and the Candidate Handbook for the examination are available on the Web at www.aswb.org. We will not accept examination scores from third-parties, including the candidate or other jurisdictions. If your application for a reasonable accommodation is denied, or you have any complaints about your accommodations, please contact the New York State Board for Social Work see contact information. New York State will not accept an examination given under non-standard conditions such as the use of a dictionary or extra time for applicants whose primary language is other than English. A candidate will be required to retake the examination under standard conditions. Endorsement, often referred to as reciprocity, is not available in New York State. However, you may be eligible for licensure in New York State if you: Full documentation of compliance with all New York State licensure requirements, including professional education, must be submitted directly to the Department by the appropriate entity, not by the applicant. To be eligible for a limited permit, you must: You may apply for a limited permit Form 5 at the same time as or any time after you submit your Application for Licensure Form 1. If you are a new applicant for licensure in New York State, a private practice that you own or operate would not be an acceptable setting for a limited permit holder. The setting must be legally authorized to provide licensed master social work services such as: Section 9 of chapter of the laws of , as amended by section 1 of chapter of the laws of provides: A limited permit holder may not practice clinical social work, including diagnosis and psychotherapy, under the supervision of an LMSW. Limited permits are valid for a period of one year and are not renewable. A limited permit cannot be issued until the Department has determined that you have satisfied

all requirements for licensure except the licensing examination. Limited permits are not issued to applicants for employment in public schools. Such applicants should apply for a provisional school social worker credential through the Office of Teaching Initiatives. See more information on teaching certificates at usny. In accordance with Section Practice of Licensed Master Social Work Effective September 1, , the practice of licensed master social work, as defined in Article of the Education Law, is restricted to individuals who are licensed, under a limited permit, or authorized under the law. A licensed master social worker may only practice clinical social work, including diagnosis and psychotherapy, under the supervision of a Licensed Clinical Social Worker LCSW , licensed psychologist or psychiatrist in an acceptable setting.
