Unlike the other Dead Sea Scrolls, this one details the locations of 64 separate treasures of gold and silver. Archaeologists believe that the scroll was created between and 30 BCE, and that the treasures referred to in the text were from a Jewish temple. These were likely hidden away from Roman warriors who took control of the area around that time. The descriptions of locations on the scroll are imprecise, as if meant to be read by someone very familiar with the history of the area.
