They claimed the health care reform bill was being written behind closed doors without their input and that the proposals being consider fall short in reducing costs and increasing efficiency, outlining only a fraction of what will be required to achieve a product that does not add to the deficit. This piece of legislation would eventually die and never receive a vote on the House floor. House of Representatives , Ross was consistently ranked as one of the most independent and moderate Members of Congress by National Journal. When Ross left Congress in , he was ranked as the sixth most conservative Democrat in the entire U. In contrast, Dickey was seen as a controversial conservative because of his comments on stem cell research and homosexuality. Ross was the only Democrat outside of California to defeat a Republican incumbent. Ross easily defeated Dickey in a rematch, then ran unopposed in He picked up an easy victory in the election , defeating the similarly named Republican, real estate executive Joe Ross, 75 percentâ€”25 percent. During the presidential campaign, like most Arkansas Democrats, Ross endorsed former U. Arkansas gubernatorial election, On July 25, , Ross announced that he would retire from Congress at the end of As for possibly running for Governor of Arkansas in , he said: But I do know if I was re-elected to the U. I believe it would be impossible to successfully run for Governor here at home, while effectively carrying out my congressional duties in Washington. Instead, he became senior vice president for government affairs and public relations at the Little Rock -based, nonprofit Southwest Power Pool. Permits use of such payments, also, for other activities to improve the administration of elections for Federal office. Protection and Advocacy Systems - Sec. Creates an exception for a State or jurisdiction that uses a paper ballot voting system, a punch card voting system, or a central count voting system to meet such requirement by establishing a voter education program specific to that voting system that notifies each voter of the effect of casting multiple votes for an office and providing the voter with instructions on how to correct the ballot before it is cast and counted. Requires the voting system to: Declares that States that do not require voter registration for Federal elections may meet these provisional voting requirements using voter registration procedures established under applicable State law. Requires the appropriate State or local election official to perform list maintenance with respect to the computerized list on a regular basis and to provide adequate technological security measures to prevent unauthorized access to the computerized list. Requires the State election system to ensure that voter registration records in the State are accurate and are updated regularly. Requires voters who register by mail to present a current and valid photo identification when voting in person, or if voting by mail, to enclose a copy of such identification or of a current utility bill, bank statement, or government document showing name and address. Requires that mail-in voter registration forms developed under the National Voter Registration Act of include questions requiring voters to verify that they are U. Requires States to notify voters who fail to complete the question on citizenship and provide them with an opportunity to complete the form before the next Federal election. Voluntary Guidance - Sec. Provides that States without an approved plan shall be deemed to be out of compliance with the requirements. Help America Vote Foundation - Sec. Requires the Secretary, to the maximum extent practicable, to implement measures to ensure that a postmark or other official proof of mailing date is provided on each absentee ballot collected at any overseas location or vessel at sea whenever the Department of Defense is responsible for collecting mail for return shipment to the United States. Requires the Secretary to ensure that the measures implemented do not result in the delivery of absentee ballots to their final destination after the date of the Federal election. Directs the Secretary of each military department, utilizing the voting assistance officer network established for each military installation, to notify members of the armed forces stationed at that installation of the last date before a general election for which absentee ballots mailed from an installation postal facility can reasonably be expected to be timely
