

1: Lead Me: Being a Spiritual Leader as a Husband :Doug Rogness

A spiritual leader can fill a room with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness and gentleness, even while speaking hard things. They help people see old things in new ways. Many people are stuck not in their circumstances, but in their perspectives and paradigms.

When most people think of leadership, they picture a military officer giving out orders or an employer closely supervising his employees, making sure all the work gets done. These aspects can be part of leadership, but they are not the essence of spiritual leadership. Spiritual leadership is the opposite of what most people think. Spiritual leadership is servant leadership. Jesus Christ Himself taught us, "just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" Matthew Jesus was most definitely a leader. He was the leader of the twelve disciples and a much greater group of followers beyond them Luke Jesus did not lead by giving out orders or by supervising. Jesus led by being a servant and serving alongside of His followers. Spiritual leadership involves humbling yourself and doing the tasks that no one else wants to do. Afterwards he declared, "Do you understand what I have done for you? I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. I tell you the truth, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them" John

Spiritual Leadership - What does it take? True spiritual leadership, with a spirit of humility and service, will cause people to follow you because they want to, not because they have to. Genuine humility and spiritual leadership is attractive. People want to follow a person who serves alongside them and sets an example for them. Spiritual leadership insists on humility. Humility is the attitude that puts others ahead of you, that considers others more important than yourself. It was said of Moses, the leader of over one million Israelites, "Now Moses was a very humble man, more humble than anyone else on the face of the earth" Numbers

Thinking too highly of yourself prevents you from genuinely caring for others. Humility enables you to serve others wholeheartedly and thereby set an example that others will follow. Spiritual leadership also requires integrity. People do not want to follow a person they do not respect. Speaking to servants, Ephesians 6: Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men, because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does, whether he is slave or free. People are repulsed by a person they cannot trust to tell the truth. Genuine spiritual leadership has powerful results! Jesus began His ministry with twelve disciples. Once He finished training them to be servant leaders, He set them loose on the world. On their first day of ministry, over 3,000 people believed the message about Jesus Acts 2: A few years later it was said of the disciples, "These who have turned the world upside down have come here too" Acts

How can you develop spiritual leadership in your life? First, pray to God for wisdom on how you can become a spiritual leader James 1: Second, ask God to change your heart and to develop the character qualities in you that are required for spiritual leadership 1 Corinthians 3: Third, rely on the power of God to give you the strength you need to exhibit spiritual leadership in your life. God, the Father, sent His only Son to satisfy that judgment for those who believe in Him. Jesus, the creator and eternal Son of God, who lived a sinless life, loves us so much that He died for our sins, taking the punishment that we deserve, was buried, and rose from the dead according to the Bible. Spiritual Leadership Is About Encouraging and Directing Others in a Pursuit of God Your kids need spiritual direction and parents are the ones that need to give it. If your husband isn't interested in God, then you have to step in and lead in this area, for the sake of your kids.

What Does God Require of Me? Fred Smolchuck Have you ever thought about how good and generous God is to us? He gives us life, provides our daily living, forgives our sins, heals our bodies, protects us from the devil, gives us faith and hope for an eternity with Him in heaven. And we still keep coming to Him, asking for more. He is not upset when we do. Actually, He invites us: Did it ever occur to you, that perhaps He expects something from us? As this question crossed my mind, the Holy Spirit brought me the following, and I pass it on to you for consideration. God does indeed expect from us: Parents are truly pleased when their children have learned to say, "Thank you daddy - mommy. Jesus expressed His disappointment, that out of ten lepers healed, only one returned to give thanks. Paul taught, "Give thanks always for all things unto God" Eph. How does one do this? Worship does not necessarily call for ceremonial ritualistic bowing or prostration of oneself. Jesus said, "True worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth" John 4: This calls for reverential adoration, appreciation, and honoring God from deep within our inner being. This must be done with humility, submission, and full awareness that He is God. He is the Greatest and deserves this kind of devotion. God desires His children to reflect the family image. To be holy is to be pure, to be clean, untainted, separated from sin unto God. A daily tryst with the Lord, feeding on His Word, and keeping oneself continually open to the infilling of the Holy Spirit will lead to greater holiness. Nothing pleases a parent more than an obedient child. The prophet Samuel said, "To obey is better than sacrifice" 1 Sam. Peter affirmed, "We ought to obey God rather than men" Acts 5: Among those with whom God was pleased because of their obedience: It is incumbent on us that we, "Be To love God is to direct all our emotions and desires toward Him. This calls for expressions of adoration, appreciation, willingness to sacrifice, and to do anything that would bring Him happiness. Merely to state our love verbally, but not support it with deeds is hypocritical. To be a follower of the Lord requires loyalty, "for ye serve the Lord Christ" Col. Paul said, "It is required in stewards that a man be found faithful" 1 Cor. Loyalty does not flinch in the face of humiliation, persecution or death Rev. This is why God created man in the first place. He brought children into being, so He could enjoy fellowship with them. His children are in His "image and likeness" Gen. At the Last Supper: Jesus expressed His intense desire for this fellowship: To His many hearers "Come unto Me" Mt. To all today He calls "I stand at the door, and knock: Our Heavenly Father is faithful, generous and loving. He deserves to receive joy and satisfaction from His children, and to feel as proud of them, as He did of Job "Have you considered My servant Job? He is the finest man in all the earth, a man of complete integrity. He fears God and will have nothing to do with evil" Job 1: How pleased is God with us? Have we brought joy to His heart? The Scriptures advise "Let a man examine himself" 1 Cor. The Bible tells us, "The joy of the Lord is your strength" Neh. If fulfilling His desires brings Him joy—and this "joy" simultaneously becomes our "strength," then we must make sure our responsibilities to our Heavenly Father are fulfilled. Read again, and consider the seven areas of obligation given above. Have we neglected any? Share this truth with your people.

Let me emphasize again that it is the inner circle that makes the leadership spiritual. All genuine leadership begins in a sense of desperation – knowledge that we are helpless sinners in need of a great Savior.

While the Bible clearly affirms the equality of men and women see Galatians 3: Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them" Colossians 3: Naturally, there is a great deal of controversy in the church today surrounding the precise meaning of these words. Some husbands wonder, "What am I supposed to do – act like a preacher? The buck has to stop somewhere if the household is to function smoothly and efficiently. After all, the Lord has created her to be his best earthly resource. Christians have varying opinions concerning the practical mechanics of spiritual leadership in the home. Generally speaking, if a husband and wife have a healthy relationship, they make decisions together as equals, looking to Christ as the ultimate Head of the household. They compare their individual aptitudes and assume tasks based on their individual strengths. In some areas of service they share tasks. But they also recognize that, in the final analysis, the husband carries the greater responsibility for leadership. If we are looking to Jesus Christ as our model, this can only mean one thing: Jesus put it this way: Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave – just as the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give His life a ransom for many" Matthew The role of a spiritual servant-leader A spiritual servant-leader, then, imitates Christ. He looks for ways to help its members grow in their relationship with God. He provides physical support, grace, and encouragement. He is ready to protect, help and defend. In hard times and good times, in season and out of season, he is ready to lay down his life for those who have been entrusted to his care. What kinds of qualities are required in a husband who desires to fulfill this high and holy calling? In the first place, he must have a strong connection with his Heavenly Father, finding his happiness in Christ first, realizing that he can lead effectively only if he maintains an intimate relationship with the Lord. He must be balanced in his commitments and nurturing in his concern for the mental and emotional needs of each family member. He must be proactive, spotting potential challenges to the welfare of his wife and children and coming up with workable solutions to problems. And he must be characterized by integrity, seeking to be the safest, wisest and most respected man his family has ever known. Much more could be said on this subject. 4: What is a spiritual leader?

The Bible describes a spiritual leader as one who possesses the spiritual gift of leadership, the ability to lead others as a direct result of the gifting received from, and performed by the power of, the Holy Spirit.

It is crucial for us to understand and implement the biblical requirements for spiritual leadership in our churches. God may call some of you young men into pastoral ministry. You should be diligent to develop these qualities in your lives now. It is vitally important that every Christian know what to look for in a pastor. Apart from the matter of moral purity, there are many men in pastoral ministry who do not meet the biblical requirements for spiritual leadership. If you place yourself and your family under such leadership, it could be spiritually devastating. People join churches for flimsy reasons. Sometimes they join a church because they like the feeling they get when they attend there. They find the music entertaining and uplifting. Or they like the youth activities that are available. Often, they join because their best friends go there. But strangely, they never consider what the pastor is teaching or where he is leading them spiritually. These verses were aimed at the spiritually lax priests. In the church age, Jesus has fulfilled and superceded the Levitical priesthood. He is our High Priest and all believers are priests under Him Heb. God now has entrusted leadership in the local church to elders who are to shepherd His flock. To sum up, the prophet shows us: Our text is an Old Testament treatment of 1 Timothy 4: A spiritual leader must honor God by walking with Him. The primary requirement for a pastor-teacher is not that a man be a gifted communicator, but rather that he walks closely with the Lord. John Calvin said that it would be better for the preacher to break his neck going into the pulpit, if he does not take pains to be the first to follow God cited by J. To walk with God implies close, intimate fellowship with God and obedience to His commandments or ways Mal. Walking with God is connected with honoring Him. Our text reveals five aspects of walking with God: Walking with God is based on a covenant relationship with God in life and peace. When Malachi mentions Levi, he is not referring to the man, but to the line of priests that descended from him. Although there is no specific text where God instituted a covenant with the Levitical priests Mal. God chose the tribe of Levi for ministry in the sanctuary and thus put them in a special covenant relationship with Him. Just as the nation was bowing in repentance, an Israelite man brazenly took a Midianite woman into his tent in the sight of all the people. Applied to New Testament church leaders, a man who leads in the church must be in a genuine covenant of life and peace with God. With that new life is relationship of peace with God through the blood of Christ Rom. This New Covenant relationship of life and peace with God is foundational to walking with God. Walking with God implies close communion with Him. This is implicit in the term. The select men of whom this term is used Enoch, Noah, and Abraham knew God closely, as friend to friend. There is a vast difference between knowledge about God and knowing God personally. There is a huge difference between a religious man, who keeps all sorts of rules and rituals, and a man who walks closely with the living God. Walking with God results in a growing reverence for Him. There is an appropriate place for humor in the pulpit, but there is never an appropriate time to make light of sin or to joke about God. A spiritual leader must be sober in all things 2 Tim. While that does not mean that he should be devoid of a sense of humor, it does mean that he should convey a dead seriousness when it comes to the eternal destiny of souls. God is not to be trifled with! Walking with God produces a passion to honor His name above all else. God exhorts these priests to take it to heart to give honor to His name 2: As we saw last week, they were despising God by offering blemished sacrifices on the altar. God is worthy of all honor and glory since He is the most weighty, awesome Being in the universe. Our aim as His people should be to make His glory known to all people. Thus walking with God is based on a covenant relationship with Him in life and peace. It implies close communion with Him. It results in a growing reverence for Him and a passion to honor His name. Walking

with God means listening to Him and obeying Him from the heart. God warns these priests that they need to listen and take it to heart to give honor to His name. To drive it home, He repeats the warning about not taking it to heart 2: Our sin causes us to ignore His warnings and go on doing what we want to do, even though it will ultimately cause us much grief and sorrow. Honor God by walking with Him. But also he told Timothy to pay close attention to his teaching. A spiritual leader must honor God by teaching His truth. Sound teaching must flow out of a godly life. Thomas [Banner of Truth], p. God drives home to these disobedient priests that He expected them to give true instruction and turn many back from iniquity 2: And, he should not show partiality in his teaching 2: God tells us with authority how we should live, and we violate His commandments to our own peril. The job of the messenger was to relay accurately and clearly what the king wanted to be said. Although I strongly disagree with some of his theology, I have long admired what I read about the famous theologian, Karl Barth. Sadly, many professing Christians in Germany agreed with Hitler against the Jews. One Sunday, Barth was preaching on John 3: He made the point that Jesus was a Jew, that He had died for all the world, and that the Jews were of the world. Thus anyone who loves Christ would not participate in the widespread ill treatment of the Jews. One wrote a scathing letter denouncing his sermon. Did it come out of the text of Scripture? I always try to tell you when there is room to differ over a difficult text or a doctrine where godly men differ. But it is also important in our day, when only one in five Protestants read their Bibles daily. After sleeping and working, the thing that Americans do most is to watch TV! If a pastor does not teach the knowledge of God and His ways through the Word, you should find another pastor. Our major problem is our sinful rebellion against the Lord of hosts. Any pastor who does not help people deal biblically with their sin is not honoring God by teaching His truth. For example, to alert you about upcoming attractions, in Malachi we will deal next week with the sin of marrying unbelievers and then with the sin of divorce. That is one reason that I purpose not to know who gives what in this church. Not to do so would be unfaithful to God. God tells these priests that He will send a curse on them, by cursing their blessing 2: By cursing their blessings, the Lord is referring either to taking away their material blessings, such as food, covering, and possessions; or, to making these otherwise good things to be a curse. If you are obedient to the Lord, possessions, health, and a peaceful life are blessings from God to be enjoyed thankfully. But if you disregard God, those same things can be a curse because they become the source of your contentment, rather than God Himself. Cursing their offspring lit. If he had loved them, he would have honored God by confronting their sins. God gets pretty graphic by saying that He will spread refuse or dung on the faces of the priests and cause them to be despised and abased in front of all the people. These proud priests were trying to keep up their image as important and influential men. But God will expose them for what they are, defiled and unclean. God is exposing in public what has been going on behind the scenes for a long time. Save me from the error of judging a church by its size, its popularity or the amount of its yearly offering. That is the essence of spiritual leadership, to honor God by walking with Him and teaching His truth. What are the most important biblical criteria in looking for a church?

Next When I was writing my dissertation last year and earlier this year I had to read over different books and articles about leadership. One of the authors I encountered again and again was Dr. Warren Bennis, who teaches at leadership USC. One of the more interesting books by Dr. In that book, Dr. This conspiracy is one reason why, according to Bennis, American society is producing so few genuine, authentic leaders. This crisis in leadership is also evident in the Christian church. Many futurists are predicting a major clergy crisis in the next several years which will force most smaller churches with less than people to either close their doors or share a pastor with one or more other small churches. Many pastors and church leaders complain about frustration in the area of leadership. Churches can be very resistant to leadership, especially when leadership means changing. Now let me give you a disclaimer today: I feel very uncomfortable addressing this topic with you. A pastor who speaks to his congregation about honoring church leaders seems about as tacky as congress voting themselves a raise. Talking about this subject feels a bit like how I feel when I watch the academy awards, with the entire entertainment industry congratulating themselves. But please check up on everything I say today against the biblical text, just in case my ego gets in the way and distorts my words in some way. Authentic community takes place in the context of the Christian Church, and leadership is essential for authentic community in the Church to occur. What connects this section to the previous 16 verses in chapter 5 is the idea of "honor. Here Paul continues talking about honor as it relates to our spiritual leaders. Paul focuses his attention here on church elders. Elders were the primary church leaders in the first century Christian church. Each local church had a group of elders who guided that congregation forward in spiritual growth and ministry. To become an elder, a person had to meet certain standards. We looked at some of those standards back in 1 Timothy chapter 3, and we saw that most of the biblical standards focus on character rather than abilities. Leadership skills are important to eldership, but not nearly as important as integrity. And no amount of leadership ability can compensate for a lack of integrity. Here we learn that there were different kinds of elders in the New Testament church. There were some elders who were volunteer, or what we call "lay elders" here at LBF Church. The majority were "lay elders," working full-time jobs to support their families and then overseeing the church as volunteers. Currently we have two lay elders as well as three apprentice lay elders in training.

7: How to Encourage Your Husband as a Spiritual Leader

In this short essay, John Piper answers these questions by explaining the true marks of a spiritual leader. Saturated in Scripture, and loaded with practical illustrations, this booklet will be instructive and challenging for anyone in a position of Christian leadership, as well as for anyone aspiring to lead spiritually.

Would you like him to be? Unfortunately, however, not all men automatically step up to that role on their own. This article assumes that your husband is, in fact, a Christian. What are you actually wanting or expecting him to DO? Do you want him to: Lead your family in daily devotions? Pray out loud before meals? Read Bible stories with the children at bedtime? Share his struggles and spiritual insights with you on a regular basis? Attend church with your family every week? Are your expectations reasonable – taking his personality, strengths, and schedule into account? Does he guide them with love and care? In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. Does he provide for you and keep you safe? Recognize His Current Efforts as a Spiritual Leader Okay, so since spiritual leadership encompasses SO much more than just reading the Bible or praying, chances are your husband is already taking steps to lead your family – you just may not have recognized or fully appreciated them. For example, does your husband: He may not sit down with me and lead me through the Bible, but he absolutely leads me to the Lord. But in order to get it – you have to tell him what you want! In other words, do NOT say: I wish you were more of a spiritual leader in our family. I would love it if our family could [do this particular thing] – What would you think about it? You never know unless you ask. This happens when we refuse to follow his direction, undermine his authority, nag him to change, or insist on doing things our own way. After all – how difficult must it be for our husbands to lead when we refuse to follow or when we constantly criticize their leadership? Okay, lots of occasions – 6. Acknowledge and Encourage His Leadership Often Even if your conversation with your husband goes incredibly well, chances are that leadership is still a position that he will have to grow into over a period of time. There will be a learning curve as he learns to step up and develops the confidence to do so, while you learn to step down and develop the trust to do so. In the meantime, look for as MANY chances as you can find to verbally acknowledge and appreciate all the things he is doing. Tell him how much you enjoy the new things he is trying, and do your best not to correct him when things go wrong. Find things to praise him for and look for situations where you can step down and defer to his leadership. Not in a patronizing way, of course, but in an encouraging, supportive way. Is your husband the spiritual leader in your family? How does he lead your family? What do you do to encourage him as a leader?
