He missed a few days with a pulled thigh muscle after that but, when he returned, Droppo was released and Gentile had the job all to himself. After a so-so June in which he still managed to maintain the major league lead in RBI, Gentile went absolutely nuts in July. It started on the first of the month when he logged the first four-hit game of his career against the Tigers at Memorial Stadium. The next day, he hammered his third grand slam of the season. Gentile stepped up as a pinch-hitter in a tie game with Kansas City in town, and clobbered a pitch feet to help the Orioles go on the victory. He smiled broadly as he crossed the plate, and Chuck Estrada rolled to another victory. The first of two All-Star games that summer took place in Candlestick Park, and Gentile fulfilled a dream by performing in a big league uniform in his hometown for the first time. After the break, he completed a monstrous July in which he batted. Arguably, he was even better in August, blasting 15 homers and driving in 30 while batting. The Orioles slugger did have one more magical moment, blasting his fifth grand slam off former Oriole Don Larsen in Chicago on September 22 to help make a winner of -who else- Estrada. Gentile finished the year with 46 homers, RBI and a. He got a big raise and bought a home in Timonium but, after his numbers declined for two straight years, the Orioles traded him to Kansas City. Now 73, Gentile resides in Edmond, Oklahoma.

In the offseason of 1971, and then again in 1972, he attended two winter semesters at Little Rock University, majoring in business. He went into the army in 1973, [15] joining the Arkansas National Guard right before he was to be drafted into the United States Army. He went 2-for-4 with an RBI, singling in the 4th off Chuck Stobbs for his first hit while driving in a run on a single in the eighth inning in the win. Robinson made his final batting appearance on August 5, at Anaheim Stadium, pinch hitting for Mark Belanger in the top of the eighth inning. He lined out in his one appearance before being replaced by Kiko Garcia. He entered as a pinch hitter for Al Bumbry, only to be pinch hit for Tony Muser. When Robinson refused to cross the picket line, WMAR management reopened the negotiations and the strike ended the next day. Honors[edit] At the conclusion of his final season in 1977, his jersey number 5 was retired by the Orioles. When the Orioles played their last game there on October 6, 1982, Robinson and Uinitas were invited to throw out the ceremonial first balls. Uinitas threw a football. After the conclusion of the game, former Oriole players took the field in the uniforms of their time and stood at their old positions on the field. Robinson was chosen to be the first player to come out. On December 5, he was recognized for his accomplishments on and off of the field when he received the Bobby Bragan Youth Foundation Lifetime Achievement Award. On October 22, 1982, a statue was unveiled on Washington Boulevard in downtown Baltimore depicting Robinson preparing to throw out a runner at first base. Robinson was present for the unveiling of the statue and commented that it "gave him more hair than he deserved".
