Teachout and Wu have long histories of being really in touch with the internet generation, and being true anti-corruption reformers. In ancient China there was none of that. The social status of women was low. They were not allowed to do what men were doing and not allowed to interfere with what men were doing, especially politically. It was their duty was to obey men and please men. Although in some particular families the husband might listen to the wife or might even be henpecked, that was hardly the prevailing trend. By tradition, a woman who did not bear any sons daughters did not count for the husband could be divorced for that reason alone. The parents could not refuse to take their daughter back. But they were not obliged to welcome her warmly Under such circumstances, it was not easy for a woman to climb all the way up to the throne. Yet one woman did it. Eventually known as Empress Wu Zetian the Great, she became the only female sovereign to rule in her own name in Chinese history. The Chinese government boasts that China has an even longer history, going back five thousand years, but the first dynasty they include may be legendary. No archeological evidence has ever been found; there are only references to it in 1 Empress Wu the Great later written records. While readers may be more familiar with Greek, Roman, Egyptian or Indian history, a brief outline of Chinese history may help to set this story in context. The major dynasties in Chinese history were: Many bronze utensils have been dated to this period. In writing this volume I have relied primarily on the most authoritative ancient Chinese record, Zizhitongjian, the foundational historical reference written by a prime minister in the Song Dynasty, Sima Guang, who was a great scholar. He began his chronicles with the late period of the Zhou Dynasty and went up to AD , a total of volumes. Since he was writing shortly after the Tang Dynasty, the facts as he stated them are fairly reliable. But Sima Guang was a conservative man and abhorred anything that flew in the face of tradition; and he was certainly no less biased than any other writer of histories. Whenever an important person is introduced, a brief biography follows. In accordance with Chinese usage, surnames are presented before given names in this book. He had two elder brothers, Wu Shiling and Wu Shiyi. The family business was to make and sell bean curd or tofu. They made the bean curd early every morning. Then the father took it out for sale. As their bean curd was of good quality, it sold well. So they made money. He loved to travel and had an extra palace built wherever he would go. This created a large demand for lumber. But in feudal China, wealth did not equal status, and merchants were not held in esteem. There were four social classes or castes in feudal China. Peasants belonged to the second class because they produced grain to feed the people. The third class consisted of workers and craftsmen, who provided people with other necessities of life. The merchants were of the lowest class because they produced nothing and it was considered that they made money from the efforts of other people. Wu joined the army as a lowranking officer. As he served well, he was promoted to staff officer in charge of arms keeping. He came to know Li Yuan personally. Several times when Li Yuan was commanded by the emperor to quench the fire of peasant revolts here and there and passed Wenshui Town, he would stay in the Wu residence. Their relationship developed cordially. At that time more and more peasants in more and more places were taking up arms against the corruption of the Sui Dynasty. They were loyal to the emperor and suspected Li Yuan of betrayal. Shall we arrest and interrogate them? Li Yuan told Wu Shiyue to set an ambush at the eastern gate of the palace in case of any surprise attack. A soldier learned of this and wanted to report to vice prefect Wang Wei, but Wu Shiyue stopped him, and gave him an incentive to keep quiet. In the fifth moon of the same year, Li Yuan killed both the vice prefects on some pretext and then in the seventh moon raised his banner against the Sui Dynasty. He appointed Wu Shiyue as his staff officer responsible for arms and materiel. At that time the army of the Sui Dynasty was struggling to fight the rebellious peasants. Li Yuan grasped the chance to besiege city after city, and he occupied them one by one. He was called Emperor Gong, and he designated the present Emperor Yang an ex-emperor. Li Yuan announced himself as general prime minister with the appellation Prince Tang. His grandfather had been Duke of TangGuo in a previous dynasty; hence, he was already drawing up a heritage for what he aimed to make the

Tang Dynasty. Li Yuan granted Wu Shiyue a large manor house, three million coins, and five thousand scrolls of silk. He also gave Wu two hundred blood horses and two thousand bushels of grain. Then Li Yuan forced the young Emperor Gong to abdicate and declared himself emperor of a new dynasty, the Tang Dynasty. After a feast to celebrate the victory, the participants were rewarded in accordance with their service. Wu Shiyue was appointed a general and given an additional three hundred acres of arable land, three hundred slaves of both sexes, five hundred catties of gold and twenty thousand pieces of colored cloth. He even received a metal certificate of exemption from a death sentence in case he once committed a crime worthy of the death penalty. There were six ministries in the Tang Dynasty: Wu again proved his competence and the emperor was so delighted that he conferred on Wu another title, Duke Yingguo. Anyway, he had risen from bean curd dealer and lumber merchant to nobleman in ChangAn City. He was satisfied and did not want to overreach. He had four sons. However, during the time he was marching with the troops, two of his sons died of disease. A year later, his wife also died of disease. He never had a chance to see them for one last time or to say goodbye. He mourned for them in his heart and kept on working with singleminded determination. When the emperor Li Yuan learned of the situation, he was further impressed and gave Wu Shiyue great praise for his loyalty to his duties. The woman the emperor had in mind was a middle-aged spinster from a noble family. Since her father died, she had stayed single, praying for his soul every day before a statuette of Buddha in a special room at home. So by marrying her Wu Shiyue would become a distant relative of the imperial Li family. The woman was then forty-four years old and Wu was forty-six. The wedding expenses were all covered by the emperor. The second daughter would grow up to be our chief character, Empress Wu. On the twenty-third day of the first moon in AD , the young Miss Wu was born in ChangAn City the present XiAn, meaning west safety , the capital of the Tang Dynasty, when her father was working there as the minister of the Construction Ministry supposedly based on his having been a lumber merchant. Her father was by then forty-eight and her mother forty-six. As noted, she had two stepbrothers and an elder sister, still a child. He took his wife and two daughters with him, leaving his two sons behind as they were already adults. Yangchow City is situated to the north side of the Yangtze River, on the lower reaches, close to Nanking meaning South Capital City across the river. Back in AD , Emperor Yang of the Sui Dynasty had escaped to Yangchow City since revolts after revolts broke out almost everywhere in his empire, and when he was killed in AD by his general Yuwen Huaji, the city was occupied by this general. In AD , a riotous army of the peasants took over the city. Then another peasant army conquered it. The city changed hands between peasant armies during the next several years. Generally after war the government was expected to do something to restore agricultural activities, but the nephew turned his attention to his own merrymaking and enjoyment. Therefore, the situation was just as bad as before. Then rumors spread that Prince Li Xiaogong was planning a mutiny. The emperor summoned him to the capital and imprisoned him. Prince Shenfu was appointed the governor of Yangchow City. According to the regulations at the beginning of the Tang Dynasty, the position of gov8 Chapter 1. Origins of a Future Sovereign error should be given only to princes, but generally the princes only took the positions in name. They did not even go to live there, and so an administrator would be appointed at the same time to actually take charge of everything in the city and the surrounding area, generally the province of which the city was capital. Thus the position of Wu Shiyue was to be the administrator in Yangchow City. Any courtier could be appointed a governor. The reason was that he was a pretty arrogant fellow, and once when Prince Qin had sent a messenger to him, he had beaten him for no reason at all. Now that Prince Qin was crowned to be the second emperor, he was afraid that the emperor would kill him. He lied that he had received a secret imperial edict to lead his army to the capital. On his way there, he reached Youchow You meaning secluded. The magistrate Zhao Cihao came out to meet him. General Li Yi occupied Youchow. When Zhao Cihao knew that the government army would come, he planned to attack General Li Yi, assisted by a junior general Yang Ji, who camped outside Youchow.
